## LEAFS QUALIFY IN 5 EVENTS FOR SATURDAY'S FINALS

On Friday, May 25th, eight Leafs competed in 7 events in the 2A Preliminary Round of the I.H.S.A. State Track & Field Championships held on the campus of Eastern Illinois University in Charleston, Illinois. We were lucky that the 3A followed the 2A competition as the daytime high reached 96°. The state meet includes the "best of the best" and individuals and relay teams all have the same goal. Get to Saturday. That goal is certainly easier said than achieved.

The team set up a team camp inside Lantz Fieldhouse. A special shout out goes to Gary Vanderheyden for wheeling in a ginormous cooler stocked with a ton of iced water and sports drinks. He also had other "goodies" for the guys to "graze on". The fieldhouse was extremely warm but at least it was out of the intense sun.

All of the Geneseo's qualifiers were on "the track" (no field event qualifiers.) The 3200 Meter Relay Team got things started at 9:00 a.m. competing in heat one of three heats. The top 12 teams would qualify for Saturday's Final. The team just missed their season best and barely missed qualifying for Saturday's Final by only 3 places. They ended up 15th overall. Not bad for 4 men who were making their debuts in the I.H.S.A. State Meet. Job well done! Sophomore

Spencer Lindstrom got the Leafs out nicely with a 2:03.74cr. Junior Kaden Rink grabbed the baton next and threw down the team's fastest split time with a solid 2:03.44cr. Up next was Sophomore Neo Colter who ran with a lot of guys (when doesn't he) splitting 2:10.64cr. Senior Blake Duncan brought team home in 5th place with a split time of 2:03.94cr.

Up next was Senior Reed Vanderheyden in the 110 Meter High Hurdles that started at 10:33 a.m. Reed wasn't "seeded" to make the final. NEVER count this young man out. Reed ran in the 2nd of 3 heats and man was he ready to roll. Reed exploded from the starting blocks and ran a monster season best time of 14.77, placing 3rd in his heat, to secure his spot in Saturday's Final. Reed's race was very inspirational and certainly helped get his teammates FIRED-UP!!!

Up next was Senior Nick Swartzendruber in the 800 Meter Run which started at 10:33 a.m. Nick ran in heat one and had us a bit nervous as he (and the leaders) rolled through the 400 in 60 seconds. Our worries ended there when he and Hayden Wimberly from Salem threw-down a 56 second 2nd lap as each man ran in the 1:56's. Nick's official time of 1:56.86 was his 2nd fastest time ever and easily qualified for Saturday's Final. It was also excellent strategy, saving as much energy as he could for the 400 Meter Dash.

Speaking of which was up next at 11:03 a.m. The 800/400 double is very rare. Adding the 1600 Meter Relay is almost across the line for me. We allowed Nick to decide but I'll admit that I was worried that it would prove to be too difficult at this HIGH level of competition. Nick responded by cruising to first place in the 2nd heat in a new school record time of 49.11. The heat winners and the next fastest 6 runners made it to the finals. Well done, "Nasty"

Back on the track was Reed "Vanderhurdle" Vanderheyden. The 300 Meter Intermediate Hurdles began at 11:15 a.m. Reed took care of business early by sprinting to first place in heat one. He stopped the clock at 39.13 and won by over 3/4 of a second. He was also able to save some fuel for the upcoming 1600 Meter Relay.

Senior Blake Duncan "Toed da Line" in the 1600 Meter Run next for the Leafs. Heat one took off at 11:31 a.m. with Blake running in heat two of two. He ran a solid race, despite the oppressive hot conditions. Blake ran his 4th fastest time of his career despite the heat. Blake placed 9th in his heat and ended up 16th in the 24 man field. He came back later in the evening along with Neo and Rafe to compete in the 1K steeplechase in the Friday Night Under the Light's Races. Spencer also competed in the 1600 Meter Run.

Last up for the Leafs was the 1600 Meter Relay that took off just after noon. It was extremely warm to say the least. The easily qualified for Saturday's final with a team time of 3:25.31 to place 2nd in the 3rd and final heat. Reed Vanderheyden got the Leafs out nicely with an opening split of 52.44cr. Junior Kaden Rink was up next and ran an impressive split of 52.14cr. Fellow Junior Colton Pischke took the baton 3rd and rolled to a split of 52.94cr. Nick "Nasty" Swartzendruber finished things up with a ROAR by splitting 48.64cr. Job Well Done Men!!!

## Leafs well represented in 2A finals

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CHARLESTON—Geneseo has four individual events and one relay competing in today's IHSA state track and field final competition at Eastern Illinois University's O'Brien Stadium.

Geneseo senior Nick Swartzendruber qualified in prelims for both of his individual events and the 4x400 relay, which also included junior Kaden Rink, senior Reed Vanderheyden and junior Colton Pischke (3:25.31).

In the 400, with a prelim clocking of 49.11, Swartzendruber is seeded first for finals. Competing in the 800, he beat his sectional time by more than four seconds.

"This season, I pretty much ran by myself every single race," Swartzendruber said. "Down here, there's tons of people I know I can compete with, so it just helps you a lot."

Swartzendruber said making it to finals in the 800 gave him "a boost of confidence" in his other races.

"My coaches told me to just to sit and kick because I had a pretty good kick, so I just tried to outkick everyone," he said.

Taking the lead in the 300 hurdles, Vanderheyden got first in his heat with a time of 39.13.

"I feel like I definitely could have gone harder in the 300; I just wish I had a little more competition,"

Vanderheyden said. "What was going through my mind was coming around the curb, I gotta go harder. My first 200 of it was pretty good, but it's about me finishing and everything that matters."

He also qualified in the 110 hurdles, crossing the finish line at 14.77.

Coming in from sectionals seeded 11th in the 110, Vanderheyden was able to move up several spots to be seeded seventh going into finals.

Geneseo's 4x800 relay team, made up of Rink, senior Blake Duncan and sophomores Spencer Lindstrom and Neo Colter, got its second-best time of the year of 8:21.17, but did not qualify for finals.

"I'm happy with our time. We've been waking up early each week every day this week to try and prepare,"

Rink said. "This was the first time this season we've done morning practice and

everything."

Being an alternate his freshman year, this is the first time Rink's been at Charleston competing at state.

"It makes me nervous, the bigger crowds, bigger platform we're put on," Rink said. "(But) when I look back on it, I'm going to be happy I came."

Another area qualifier, Alleman senior Spencer Smith, took off in the lead during the 1600, falling behind only a couple of times before finally crossing the finish line to take first place in his heat, and top seed for finals.

Smith's time of 4:19.92 is more than eight seconds faster than his time at sectionals. Though he did not feel like he went all out near the beginning of the race, Smith said this was more of a strategic move, and is hoping

for even more improvement on Saturday.

"I'm just really happy to make it out (to finals). I'm going to bring my A-game tomorrow and we'll see what happens," Smith said. "I was just trying to make sure I got the automatic bid to the finals in case the second heat was really fast. I ended up beating it. I just wanted to be safe. Luckily, I was able to get that done."

Senior Brennan Wilson is the only other athlete representing Alleman on Saturday, qualifying for finals with a throw of 50-05.25.

All season, Geneseo Coach Don Fredericks kept referring to Nick Swartzendruber and Reed Vanderheyden as the dynamic duo.

The senior duo displayed all of their super powers leading Geneseo to a fifth-place finish at the IHSA Class 2A State Finals on May 26.

The duo nearly won two state titles in back-to-back events at O'Brien Field, in Charleston.

"That type of competitive spirit is rare," Fredericks said. "That type of physical gift and God-given talent is rare. That type of work ethic is rare. They are once in a career type athletes and to have both of them on the same team — it was awesome watching them experience that level of success."

Swartzendruber won the state title in the 400-meter dash pulling ahead of defending state champion VanHarvey Vance from Rich Central in the final 10 meters.

Swartzendruber shattered the school record in the 400 finishing in 48.49.

During Swartzendruber and Vanderheyden's four years, Geneseo has finished in 11th place, second place, fourth place and fifth place as a team.

"It changed the culture of Geneseo track," Swartzendruber said. "Before, teams around the state didn't know who Geneseo was, these last four years we have put Geneseo onto teams' radar. Every single team knows who we are."

Before the dynamic duo, Geneseo had finished higher than 15th just once at state in 1893 when Forrest Lowes placed third as a team with just his points alone.

Swartzendruber finished fourth in the 800 setting a new school record in 1:54.66.

After getting boxed in early in the 800, Swartzendruber closed hard on the leaders in the final 150-meters and nearly ran down third place.

Swartzendruber earned the nickname nasty after a juke move he made during football his sophomore year.

While nickname has faded, it stuck with Fredericks who is the last person keeping the nasty nickname alive.

"It's an oxymoron because he's such a gentle soul," Fredericks said. "Except when he gets into the competitive arena. Then he's an intense competitor."

Vanderheyden performed a superhero type dive to the finish line in the 300 hurdles.

Vanderheyden finished runner-up (38.28) separated from champion Steven Migut (38.20) of Tolono by just .08 seconds.

A Mississippi State recruit, Vanderheyden had to navigate through traffic to just be in position for a final charge at the finish line.

"He was fouled," Fredericks

said. "Not flagrantly, but he was fouled. Another athlete crashed next to him and went partially into his lane which affected him a little bit. "He dove, he gave it everything he had. I could not be any prouder of the effort these athletes put forth."

Vanderheyden raced to a ninth-place finish in the 110 hurdles in 15.24 to earn a deciding point for Geneseo's team score.

Geneseo's 4x400 relay team of Vanderheyden, Kaden Rink, Colton Pischke and Swartzendruber earned a fifth place in 3:26.58.

With the top 12 teams reaching the finals, Geneseo's 4x800 relay team of Spencer Lindstrom, Rink, Neo Colter and Blake Duncan finished just three spots shy of qualifying for state with a time of 8:21.17.

A senior, Duncan finished 16th in the 1600 in 4:40.63 with the fourth fastest time of his career.

## **"DYNAMIC DUO" LEAD LEAFS TO 5th IN STATE FINALS**

On Saturday, May 26th, the Leafs participated in the final day of the I.H.S.A. STATE Track and Field Championships. The team was challenged with unseasonably warm weather with a daytime high 97° accompanied with an extremely high dew point level in the 70's. Simply put, it was HOT!!! The Leafs entered the day with 5 "Chips" still in the game. Not a single publication even mentioned Geneseo as a potential Top 10 Team. Not so fast, my friend. Never underestimate Geneseo's "Dynamic Duo" of Seniors Nick Swartzendruber and Reed Vanderheyden, along with a little help from Juniors Colton Pischke and Kaden Rink.

First up for the Leafs was the 110 Meter High Hurdles where Maple Leaf Senior Reed Vanderheyden upset the "Form Chart" by qualifying for the Final. Reed got out nicely, but then hammered the 1st hurdle which threw off his timing. He hit all 10 hurdles, but somehow, managed to stay on his feet, crossing the finish line in 9th place putting the Leafs on the scoreboard with one point.

Next up was Nick Swartzendruber in the 800 Meter Run Final. Nick got out nicely and rolled through the 400 looking great in 57 seconds. He "got boxed in" on the backstretch and wasn't able to move until the final 150 Meters. He sprinted home in 4th place in 1:54.66 taking down the 35 Year Old School Record of Tim Renihan of 1:55.53 set in the State Finals back in 1983. Nick has been chasing that mark for a long time and what a wonderful place to accomplish it at!!! Add 6 more points to the Maple Leafs' Team Score.

Next up was Nick Swartzendruber coming back in the 400 Meter Dash Final. This was an extremely difficult assignment (Nick CHOSE it) due to the fact that the 800 Meter Run and the 400 Meter Dash are separated by only ONE event (the 800 Meter Relay.) Nick got out nicely and was in great shape as he entered the final 100 Meters as he and the defending State Champion VanHarvey Vance from Rich Central separated themselves from the rest of the field as they were "Flat Out" racing for the finish line and the STATE CHAMPIONSHIP. Nick slowly pulled away in the final 10 meters to win .31 seconds in a time of 48.49 seconds. He simply destroyed his own school record, set yesterday in the prelim, of 49.11 seconds. Add 10 more points to the Maple Leafs' Team Total.

Next up was Reed Vanderheyden in the 300 Meter Intermediate Hurdles. Both of the top two finishers from last year were unfortunately unable to qualify for the final due to hamstringing injuries, leaving the race wide open. Reed took advantage of that and was literally on a mission from the moment the gun "cracked". He ran an inspiring race in which he was accidentally hit in the chest 3 times during the race. He fought on anyway and "Toe to Toe" with Steven Migut from Tolono Unity during the final 75 meters. They left the rest of the field as they frantically sprinted towards the finish line. Reed dove and came up .08 seconds short of winning the whole thing. It was one of the gutsiest races I have ever witnessed. Add 8 more points to the Maple Leafs' total. When the team scores were announced, the Leafs found themselves in 3rd Place.

Last up for the Leafs was the 1600 Meter Relay team. Most of the athletes for each team were "bouncing back" after having already competed. Simply put, there were some tired men on the track. Add to that, the extreme heat had taken its toll on everyone. Reed Vanderheyden got things rolling with a split of 52.64cr, giving it everything he had left. Kaden Rink was up next and ran a highly spirited race that saw him "split" 52.34cr. The Leafs then threw Colton Pischke into the action and he "threw down" a 53.44cr to put the Leafs in 6th Place. The top six teams were "out of striking distance" for the Leafs' anchorman Nick Swartzendruber who ended his high school career with an outstanding split of 48.94cr to easily hold onto 6th place and close the gap on the leaders. After a race review, Morgan Park was disqualified moving the Leafs up one spot to 5th. Add 5 more points to the Leafs' Team Total.

When the points were all counted, the Leafs had placed 5th overall totaling 30 points. Aurora (Marmion Academy) won the State Title with 44 points. Second place went to Mahomet-Seymour with 40 points. The 3rd place trophy went home with Normal University who totaled 36 points. Rich Central just missed a team trophy with 34 points. .

The Maple Leaf's "Dynamic Duo" of Seniors Nick Swartzendruber and Reed Vanderheyden closed the book on their amazing high school careers in fine fashion as they each earned "All-State Honors" in 3 events each to raise their School Record Total to 9 All-State Medals EACH!!! To put

"things" into perspective. In the history of Geneseo Boys Track and Field, the team had placed in the Top 15 ONE time in school history before this year's senior class entered high school. In 1893 Forrest Lowes placed 3rd as a team all by himself. That is 3 years before the first Olympic Games. It is also well before automobiles.
