ILLINOIS TOP TIMES INVITATIONAL

On Saturday, March 23rd, Seniors Billy Blaser and Colton Pischke traveled to Illinois Wesleyan University's Shirk Center in Bloomington, Illinois to participate in the annual Illinois Top Times Invitational. The meet serves as the State of Illinois "Unofficial" State Indoor Track & Field

Championship. Not every school in the State participates but the fields are ELITE in EVERY event.

Colton got things rolling by qualifying for the 8-Man final (24 athletes qualified in the sprints.) Colton ran a sparkling time of 8.53. He improved on that time in the Finals where he placed 6th in 8.52. Great Job, Colton! Colton's barely missed his lifetime best of 8.51. To throw down two races within 2/100 of that time is amazing and demonstrates how consistent of an athlete that he is. Colton came back later in the day in the 400 Meter Dash. Colton ran a gutsy time of 54.84 to place 21st and gain additional "Big Meet" experience.

Meanwhile, Senior Thrower, Billy Blaser, was enjoying quite a day himself. Billy threw a LIFETIME best of 48' 07 1/2" on his 5th throw to grab 8th place and a coveted medal. Billy had a GREAT series of throws that saw him exceed 47 Feet in FOUR of his six throws. That is an impressive series of throws. Billy was one of the few athletes that landed ALL six of his throws legally for official measurement. Congratulations also to 1st Year Maple Leaf Throws Coach, John Davis.

Blaser and Pischke finish in the top 10 at the Top Times

A little mistake can drastically change an athlete's fate in the hurdles and the shot put.

Geneseo's Billy Blaser and Colton Pischke showed they belong among some of the state's best at the Class 2A Illinois Top Times competition on March 23.

During the Illinois Top Times Invite, which serves as the unofficial indoor state track meet, the Maple Leafs' Pischke saved his best performance for last.

A senior, Pischke has qualified for the prestigious invite the past two seasons but never reached the 60-meter hurdles finals.

This season, Pischke wouldn't be denied finishing

sixth in the hurdles in 8.52.

Pischke had another solid performance in the 400 dash finishing in 54.84.

A senior, Blaser earned eighth by setting a new personal record with a distance of 48'7.5" in the shot put.

Blaser's throw was an inch and a half over the sectional state qualifying standard for Class 2A this season.

QC athletes shine indoors

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After winning individual Class 1A state titles in Charleston late last spring, Erie-Prophetstown's Kyle Kruthoff and Fulton's Chloe Lindeman picked up where they left off.

Competing at the Illinois Top Times meet this past weekend at Illinois Wesleyan's Shirk Center in Bloomington, the duo captured first-place medals in their respective indoor events.

Reigning Class 1A pole vault champion Kruthoff struck gold in the boys' competition with an effort of 15-feet, 6-inches, well outdistancing runner-up Tim Moore of Altamont (14-feet). On the girls' side, Lindeman threw 46-8½ to win the shot put title by more than four feet.

Lindeman was not the only Steamer to have a golden weekend in Bloomington. Fellow senior Daekota Knott leaped 36-9 to win the triple jump title, edging reigning 1A state champ Danielle Taets of Orion by an inch.

Taets, who also won the 100 high hurdles' outdoor state title last May, added a fourth-place finish in the 60 meter hurdles, posting a time of 9.39 seconds.

Also enjoying a strong weekend in the girls' competition was Aleman sophomore Tori Thomas. She cleared 11-feet, 9-inches to bring home second in the pole vault, finishing just seven inches

behind Downs Tri-Valley's Windsor Roberts. Thomas also took third in the 200 meter dash with a 26.46 clocking.

Fellow Pioneer Alexandra Cagigal (11:51.82) scored a bronze medal in the 3200 and fellow senior Kiah O'Neal took fourth in the high jump (5-3).

Rockridge's 4x400 relay of Keely Parker, Carlie Ruckey, Ellie Ruckey and Kira Nelson also scored bronze, posting a time of 4:15.82. The Ruckeys and Parker teamed with Mia Freyermuth for 10th-place in the 4x200 relay (1:53.32).

Also scoring top 10 finishes were Riverdale's Hope Jackson (shot put) and Lauren Lodico (400, 1:03.24).

On the boys' side, Morrison swept all three of the relays, with the foursome of Keegan Anderson, Koby Brackemeyer, Nick Allen and Nathan Mickley striking gold in the 4x200 (1:34.43) and the 4x800 (8:16.57). With Hunter Newman in Allen's stead, the Mustangs captured the 4x400 in 3:32.17.

Orion's Logan Lee and E-P's Levi Cole each brought home silver medals. Lee threw 51-2¼ to finish as the shot put runner-up, while Cole cleared 6-4 in the high jump, finishing four inches behind Warrensburg-Latham's Jorden Tedford.

Galva's Caelin Foley fared well in the distance events, placing fifth in the 3200 with a time of

9:45.44; he also turned in a 4:42.51 clocking in the 1600 to take 11th, missing a top 10 finish by less than a second.

Sherrard's 4x400 relay quartet of Levi Miles, Gavyn White, Ryan Mack and D'Angelo Moody posted a time of 3:37.46 to take fifth. Individually, Miles placed 10th in the triple jump with a 40-3¼ effort.

Annawan-Wethersfield junior Julian Samuels cleared 20-5 to take ninth in the long jump.

In 2A girls' competition, Geneseo freshman Ali Rapps placed sixth in the 60 hurdles (9.65) and teamed with Alison Bowers, Julia Poel and Josie Brown for a third-place, 4:11.20 clocking in the 4x400 relay.

Brown and Poel then teamed with Esther Brown and Anna Girtten to help the Maple Leafs' 4x800 relay (9:53.49) take third. Individually, Abby Reakes cleared 5-2 to place fifth in the high jump as teammate Alex Horne placed 11th, two inches shy of a top 10 finish.

In 2A boys, Geneseo's Colton Pischke took sixth in the 60 hurdles (8.52 seconds); teammate Billy Blaser threw 48-7½ to take eighth in the shot put.

Monmouth-Roseville's Jamonny Skinner (21-6¼) was the long jump runner-up and also took fourth in the triple jump (43-4). Kewanee's Kavon Russell cleared 6-1 to take ninth in the high jump.
