Schaad breaks Leafs record

Geneseo pole vaulter stars but Rocks win quad

School records are made to be broken, and for Geneseo pole vaulter Malakai Schaad, he and his coach Arthur Atwell shared a special moment on Saturday.

Schaad cleared a height of 15 feet, 6 inches to beat the previous Maple Leafs record of 15 feet, 5 inches set by Atwell when he was a senior in 2016. The immediate feeling after earning the record was something that Schaad will never forget.

"I was elated after I cleared the bar," Schaad said. "It was a huge deal for myself and Coach Atwell and I know he was very excited for me. During the picture we took after getting the record, I

had to try and stop myself from shaking because I was filled with adrenaline."

There were no bad feelings from Atwell seeing his record

being broken at the four-team gathering at Rock Island's Public Schools Stadium. It was all positive vibes.

"I was aware that it could hap-

pen eventually and it was likely to happen this season," Atwell said. "I'm not upset at all, my name is still up there and it was awesome to watch one of my athletes break the record and see the consistent improvement."

The work is far from over for Schaad, who now holds the second best height in the state of Illinois and in class 2A this season and barely missed clearing 16 feet on two of his three attempts at the height.

"I'm very excited to keep going and use some new poles," Schaad said. "There's more work here to do to set myself up in a good position to give everyone at state a run for their money."

Rock Island won the team title at its own quad meet with 96 points. Galesburg (81 points) finished second, followed by Geneseo (61.5) and Alleman (27.5).

Helping lead the Rocks to victory was Darrell Woodson, who won the open 100 with a time of 11.09 seconds, placed third in the open 200 at 23.38 seconds and ran on the winning 400 and 800 relay teams.

Woodson said he is willing to do whatever event that his team needs him to do and has practiced as hard as he can over the course of the season to peak at the right time.

"With practicing every day, all of this has just become mus-

cle memory," Woodson said. "I just want to do what I can do to succeed and continue the hard work."

The senior sprinter is one of the quickest athletes out of the blocks and relies on that acceleration to help him throughout the race.

"I always try to start off strong," Woodson said. "Getting through the drive phase is a key moment for my race and then it's just finishing as best I can."

Alleman middle distance runner Michael Turner is enjoying his first season running for the track team in his senior year as an injury held him out of his

sophomore campaign and his junior year was canceled due to COVID-19.

Turner took second in the 800 with a time of 2:07, just one second behind Galesburg's Alex Buchen.

"I feel good after my run today," Turner said. "I'd like to be more aggressive in my first lap and should have tried to stick with the leader after the first 200. Once I slipped back, it was just out of reach."

While Schaad set the school record in the pole vault for Geneseo, his brother, freshman Cooper Schaad, is making waves of his own in the pole vault scene.

Cooper finished second behind Malakai with a height of 13-6 and is improving every single day.

"I definitely need to add more speed into my approach," the younger Schaad said. "I also need more work on the top end to really get into the next level."

Malakai has enjoyed working with his brother this season and has felt closer to him throughout the process.

"We started with competitions throughout the winter, and it became a bonding thing for us," Malakai Schaad said. "I'm excited to see his improvement and I know someday he'll be able to surpass me."

LEAFS 3RD IN ROCK ISLAND QUAD.

On Saturday, May 22nd, the Leafs traveled to Rock Island to participate in quadrangular meet. The field included teams from: Galesburg, Geneseo, Rock Island, and Rock Island (Alleman) with the competition being held at Rock Island's Public Stadium. We checked weather.com when the meet was almost over and the temperature at that point had climbed to 77°. The daytime high ended up being 85° with an unusually high dew point in the 60's with south winds at 20-25 m.p.h. This is the kind of weather we need to acclimate to with our season not ending until the middle of June due to COVID-19.

Rock Island always puts on a quality meet and their facilities are among the best in Western Illinois. The "Rocks" will be hosting the Western Big Six Conference on Wednesday, June 9th. Head Coach Matthew Deets made a smart decision when he chose to lessen most of the team's entries, dropping down to only one or two events for most of the guys. The reason was the fact that the meet with Dixon had to be moved from Tuesday, May 18th to Thursday, May 20th. That afternoon contest resulted in less than 24 hours until the Rock Island Quadrangular which had a 10:00 a.m. starting time for the field events and a 11:00 a.m. starting time for the track events. When the final team points were calculated the team scores were: 1.) Rock Island 96; 2.) Galesburg 81; 3.) Geneseo 6.150; Rock Island (Alleman) 27.50.

The competition was pretty fierce. It will be a lot of fun to return to Rock Island Public Stadium in ten days with a "Loaded" Geneseo Team Line-Up and see what happens. Bring it on!!! Leading the team in this meet were Sophomore Karson Emry (High Jump), Senior William Plumley (3200 Meter Run) and Junior Malakai Schaad (Pole Vault) who each won their events. There were a plethora of "Highlights" on the day but Malakai's School Record in the Pole Vault topped the list. Malakai entered the 2021 season with some big goals. Included among those goals was breaking the Geneseo High School Record of 15' 05" . When Coach Arthur Atwell set that record back in 2016 during his senior year I didn't know if the record would be even "scared" anytime soon. Who would have guessed that it only would "live" 5 short years?!

Malakai has been closing in on the record all season long and took his first competitive attempts at it last Friday night at the Dunlap Invite. He came in at 13' 06" and easily cleared it. Ditto for 14' 00" and 15' 00" . Then he and Coach Atwell decided to "Go For It" and had the bar raised to 15' 06" . Malakai took two good attempts at clearing it and barely missed. Then he readied himself for his final attempt at the height. He "SCREAMED" after he sailed over the bar and was still 16 feet in the air. He was "MOBBED" by his teammates and Coach Atwell seconds after he landed, safely, in the pit. After several pictures, the bar was raised to 16' 00" . He took three great attempts at it but sadly, saw the bar tumble to the mat. Stay tuned.....he has some other big goals in mind. Way to Go, Malakai! It was a special moment. One that anyone who witnessed it, will never forget. Goals that are challenging are the most satisfying to attain. Especially, when there is an enormous amount of work put in to attain it. Keep "Dreaming Big" and re-writing the Geneseo Record Book. We are VERY proud of you.
