

#### LEAF VAULTERS LEAD TEAM

LEAFS CLAIM WESTERN BIG 6 ABC GOLD

On Saturday, May 8th, the Leafs played host to Galesburg, Quincy, Moline, Rock Island, Rock Island (Alleman), Sterling, and United Township in the Western Big 6 ABC Invitational. Due to Covid-19 restrictions, normal season schedules were reduced to mostly dual and triangular meets with only one or two invitationals allowed. There will also be a conference championship meet and IHSA post season. Saturday's meet was held at Geneseo's Bob Reade Field with action beginning at 11:00 a.m. in the field events and high noon in the track events. The teams were treated to a decent day in regard to weather with a daytime high of 61° with 10-15 m.p.h. winds.

A special "Shout Out" goes to Head Maple Leaf Coaches Matthew Deets (Boys) and Kyle Morey (Girls) who have been working "night and day" to learn the challenging F.AT. timing system operation. Geneseo School District's Technology Guru, James Roodhouse, also stepped in to help. With Geneseo's Girl and Boys programs hosting the IHSA Sectional Meets for the first time in school history later in the season, it is critical to get "all the bugs" worked out. Head Maple Leaf Boy's Basketball coach, Brad Storm, has also been a key part of the process and was also part of "da Technology Crew". Job well done, Men. There were a few minor "snags" but overall, the meet was a tremendous success. To say the least, we were very proud of each and every man on the team. It takes a total team effort to run a major invitational and every single member of

the team did their job. We also appreciated the help of several members of the girls team who pitched in to help us (including several of the coaches). We will repay their kindness when it comes time for them to host the Girls Sectional Meet. Thanks to all. Now, onto the meet.

We love the ABC meet format. It puts a large number of team members in scoring position. That, of course, is true for every team. Ultimately, it is "Win-Win" situation. We were forced to scramble a bit moving team members around to "cover" as many of the events as possible. When the "dust had settled", the Leafs found themselves on top with a winning team total of 230.00 points. Quincy ended up 11 points back to place second while Moline finished a close third with 219 points. Quincy edges Moline for WB6 ABC meet title

GENESEO - Mistakes can happen at any time on the track. but the best are able to bounce back from the setbacks.

That's exactly what happened in the 3,200 relay for Geneseo High School at the Western Big 6 boys ABC invite on Saturday afternoon.

The baton was dropped be-

tween the second and third legs off." of the race, but Justin Johnson and Hunter Clark-Holke finished the race strong and took Moline anchor Jaeger Norton. first place with a time of 8 minsecond-place Moline for most of the race. The Maroons finished in 8:41.51.

Johnson felt the baton slip out of his hands but once he started running his leg, there was no stopping him.

"I was pretty mad at myself for dropping it," Johnson said. "After that, the adrenaline took over and I just focused on closing the gap and letting the energy burn

"It was one of my first times utes, 40.53 seconds after trailing racing in the 800," Clark-Holke said. "I had to learn to pace myself on the fly and use the guy in front of me to keep up. At the end, I kicked in to full gear."

Quincy took the win in Division A with 124 points, just beating Moline (117). Galesburg finished third with 96 points.

There was another close call in the 400 relay between Rock a time of 44.21 seconds, just Island and Moline.


The Rocks' anchor Jayden

two-hundredths of a second faster than Moline in second. It took everything that Bomelyn had to get the win.

"I was able to ward him off and throw my chest out for the win," Bomelyn said. "The hard work from all of us in the past few weeks has paid off."

The hard work from Moline's Rob Pulliam continues to pay off as the junior placed first in the high jump with a height of 6 feet, 5 inches. He finished second in the triple jump at 43 feet, 10 inches.

His personal best of 6-8 is still the second best in the state of Illinois.

"I want to get my form down and keep working hard," Pulliam said. "It's still my first year and I'm definitely not mad at myself because I'm already at a good height."

In the pole vault, Geneseo junior


Malakai Schaad tied his personal best vault of 14 feet, 1/2 inch and took first place. Going forward, Schaad just wants as many attempts as he can get in a competitive environment.

"I'm mostly concerned about volume," Schaad said. "I've been getting my steps down and have done well moving up the pole, but the competition experience is really valuable."

It was a Maple Leafs sweep in the pole vault, with Malakai's freshman brother Cooper Schaad taking first place in flight B with a height of 13 feet and Clark-Holke finishing first in flight C at 11-6.

Above all else, Schaad is just happy to be competing again after losing the 2020 season due to COVID-19.

"I'm just excited to be out here," Schaad said. "It's going to be a difficult season, but hopefully I can prove I have what it takes down at the state meet."




## Geneseo Boys' Track claims WB6 ABC Gold





Dropping the baton in the 3200 relay didn't hinder the Geneseo Maple Leafs from finishing first at the Western Big 6 Boys' ABC Invite on Saturday at Geneseo.

And that is what Coach Matt Deets is most proud of from the Invite..."The moment I am most proud of in the meet is when our A 4x800m team dropped the baton durian an exchange. Justin Johnson didn't even think twice and stopped, picked up the baton, and took off after the leader. We ended up winning that race and took about 20 seconds off our previous personal best in the race."

"I told the team in life sometimes we will make mistakes and 'drop the baton,' but it is what we do after those moments that define us," Deets said. "Do you give up and drop out of the race, or pick yourself up and keep going. I am proud that our team kept going."
