LEAFS 5TH IN INAUGURAL WESTERN ILLINOIS

BIG-6 CONFERENCE MEET

On Wednesday, June 2nd, the Leafs traveled to Rock Island to participate in the Western Illinois Big 6 Conference Meet. Since COVID-19 forced the cancellation of last year's meet, this was the first time in school history that Geneseo participated in this meet. The meet was held at Rock Island's Public Stadium. It is simply one of the best "Venues" in Western Illinois and one of the best in the entire state of Illinois. To make it even better is the knowledge that the Rock Island Staff ALWAYS puts on a "Top Notch" event. The field included teams from: Galesburg, Geneseo, Moline, Quincy, Rock Island, Rock Island (Alleman), Sterling, and United Township. The conference added both Geneseo and Sterling two years ago as they expanded to eight teams. "The Western Big 6" Conference has been considered to be one of the premier conferences in the State for DECADES. It is an honor for both the Leafs and Golden Warriors to now be included as members. The administrations chose to maintain the traditional name of the WB-6 even though there are now eight teams. That decision is similar to those of the NCAA's Big 10 (14 schools) and Big 12 (10 schools.) TRADITIONS MATTER.

Due to COVID-19, this is the first time in state history that the high school track season has moved into the month of June (and we still have two weeks to go.) Thus, heat will be an issue.

The weatherman gave the competitors a near perfect day for early June in the State of Illinois with a daytime high of 85° and minimal winds. The fact that the dew point wasn't too bad made for great conditions. The pre-meet "seeds" predicted that there would be potential "All-Staters" in most of the events. That included a couple of potential state champions. When the "dust had settled", the Moline Maroons had won their 2nd consecutive "Big 6" Title. The team scores were as follows: 1.) Moline 144, 2.) Rock Island 121, 3.) Quincy 111, 4.) United Township 89, 5.) Geneseo 80, 6.) Galesburg 52, 7.) Sterling 33, 8.) Rock Island (Alleman) 39.

The Leafs team enjoyed a tremendous meet and exceeded the pre-meet "seeds". Leading the team were the Vault Crew who "Swept the Pole Vault going 1-2-3. They scored a "Jaw-Dropping" 30% of the team total points in ONE EVENT. Junior Malakai Schaad continued his impressive season and was "Crowned" the Leaf's lone Individual Champion in the meet clearing 14' 00" to win the event. He took 3 attempts at 16' 00" and had two near misses. Senior Nate Clark-Holke jumped a season best of 13' 06" to grab 2nd place while Freshman Cooper Schaad cleared 13' 00" to place 3rd and help the Leafs complete the sweep. Additional team members who earned "Top Three" finishes were the following: Hunter Clark-Holke (400 Meter Dash);

Malakai Schaad, Nate Ryerson, Will Taylor, Ethan Holke (1600 Meter Relay), and Justin Johnson, Will Taylor, Gavin Allison, Eli DeBrock (3200 Meter Relay.) COVID-19 has presented many challenges this season. The Leafs competed in the meet with only three seniors. The good news is almost the entire team will return for the 2022 season. Expectations are high to say the least.

Next up for the team will be the IHSA Sectional Meet on Wednesday, June 9th. Geneseo is hosting one of the boys Sectional Meets for the first time in school history. The girls team hosted their Sectional Meet last night with great success. The team has been blessed with tremendous support in regards to facilities and equipment. Geneseo Track and Field is ALIVE AND WELL. Keep "Dreaming Big", Men. Our team is a strong contender to win the meet. Let's see many team members can score points in the meet. The omnipotent goal is to see how many Leafs can "Punch da Ticket" and qualify for the IHSA STATE FINALS to be hosted in Charleston, Illinois with the 2A meet being held on Friday, June 18th. It took a full team effort and a last-second substitution for the Moline High School boys track & field team to get the job done on Wednesday night at the Western Big 6 Conference Meet.

After previously going 36 years between championships, the Maroons earned their second straight conference title, doing so with 144 team points. Hosting Rock Island finished second with 121 points at Public Schools Stadium

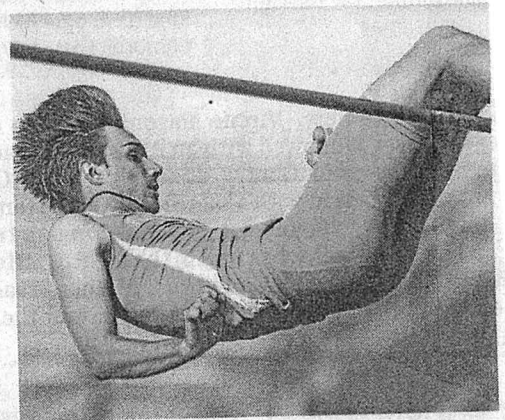
and Quincy placed third with 111 points.

Multi-event athlete Rob Pulliam helped lead Moline's repeat, and in just his first season out for track & field he won the high jump and was a member of the winning 400 and 800 relay teams, along with finishing second in the triple jump.

Pulliam only expected to participate in three events on Wednesday but a last-second scratch from 800 relay anchor Boukary Mbengue had him enter and take home

the win for his team.

"I'm not worn out because of the shape our coaches put us in, but I am definitely tired," Pulliam said. "It was definitely a surprise but I did what I had to do for the team."

Mbengue injured his left leg during the open 100, but was able to anchor the 400 relay team earlier in the meet and was happy with how the full team performed in all aspects of the relay.

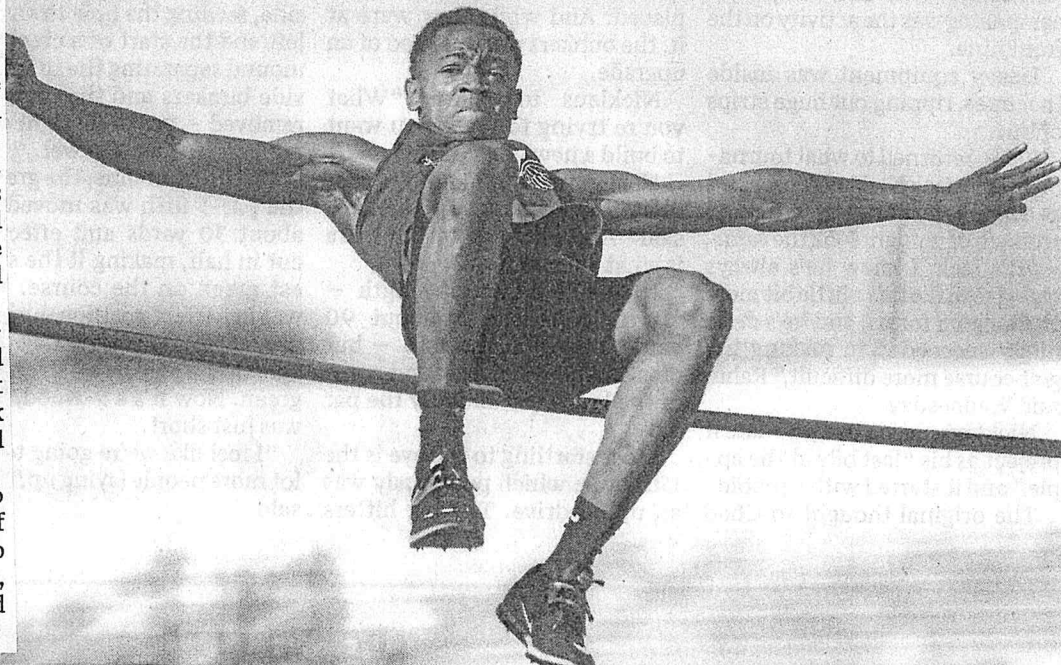

"We did an amazing job in the event and that's all from the hard work that we put in throughout the week," Mbengue said. "We were working on handoffs which is what separates good teams from great teams at the next level, and we just focused on our own race."

In both the 400 and 800 relays, the Rock Island teams had handoff issues on exchanges but fought and clawed their way back into respectable finishes of third and second, respectively.

Pulliam's high jump mark of 6 feet, 6 inches wasn't his best of the season but it was enough to earn himself a conference title, something that he's very proud of.

"I feel very confident going into sectionals," Pulliam said. "I've had a pretty consistent set of jumps this season and right now I'm just focusing on the end goal of state, which has been my goal throughout the season."

Finishing second in the high jump, Alleman's Ryan Dockery-Jackson felt that he had a pretty good day with two separate personal bests in his jumps. However, it was only after he had finished that he was informed that his final height of 6-4 set the school record, which was previously 6-3.

"It feels really great, it was a huge surprise to me," Dockery-Jackson said.

"I was hoping just to get 6-2, but I didn't even know that was the record. That's a huge burst of adrenaline for me and crazy to think about."

In class 1A, 6-1 is the state standard for high jump, giving Dockery-Jackson a nice mark to look at when preparing for the sectional meet.

Geneseo pole vaulter Malakai Schaad came away with the pole vault title at 14 feet, and once he cleared that height he and his coach immediately pushed the standards up to 16 feet. Schaad had three good attempts at the height, but couldn't quite clear

Veloz said. "I just tried to leave it all on the track and keep improving."

While Samson Shukuru of Rock Island came away with the triple jump title at 44-1, he had to wait for Pulliam to finish his jumps to truly know if he had won it.

He hopes to improve on his marks before sectionals.

"He's a good jumper and definitely could have done it," Shukuru said. "I want to try to get 23 feet in the long jump and 46 in the triple at sectionals."

it. Overall, he was happy with the attempts that he had while sluggish on a hot June afternoon.

"I think that we knew it was risky, but I had felt I couldn't just slowly work my way up the standards because I would be too tired by the end," Schaad said. "I knew I wouldn't have the energy, but we just wanted to risk it for that personal best and school record."

Geneseo has three pole vaulters who have cleared the state

standard this season in Schaad, his brother Cooper Schaad and Nate Clark-Holke, but by rule can only send two to sectionals. Schaad doesn't envy his coaches who have to make a tough decision.

"I'm a little upset with the rule, it affected me personally in my freshman year where I missed out because of that," Schaad said. "I understand the position and predicament that my coaches are in with the decision they have to make, though."

United Township middle distance runner Logan Veloz set a personal best in the open 800 with a time of 1:58.54 and hopes to improve upon that further to hit the state standard of 1:57.

"It's a big confidence boost and I knew that I could run it,"

He cleared 14 ft. for the win.

The Leafs Pole Vault crew swept the first three places with Nate Clarke-Holke jumping a personal best of 13 ft. 6 inches to take second and Cooper Schaad was third clearing 13 feet.

Hunter Clarke-Holke continued his strong season on the track placing third in the 400m dash in a time of 52.89 seconds.

The 4x800 meter relay team of Justin Johnson, Will Taylor, Gavin Allison and Eli DeBrock also placed third with a time of 8:44.9.

The 4x400 relay team of Malakai Schaad, Nate Ryerson, Will Taylor and Ethan Holke finished the night for the Leafs with a third place finish in 3:57.6.



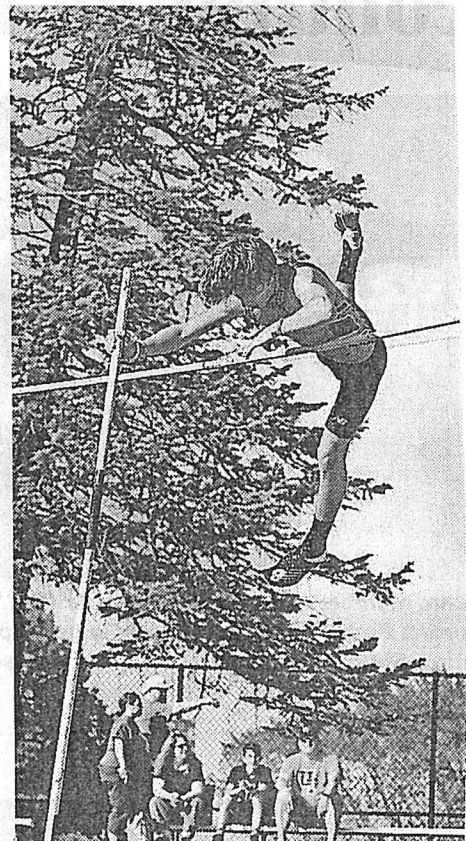
