# FIVE LEAFS COMPETE WITH STATE'S BEST

On Saturday, March 26th, the Leafs competed in the Illinois Top Times Indoor Invitational. The meet is considered to be the "Unofficial" Illinois Indoor State Championship. The Leafs were represented by Sophomore Luke Johnsen (Shot Put), Sophomore Jake Rapps (60 Meter High Hurdles), Sophomore Cooper Schaad (Pole Vault), Senior Malakai Schaad (Pole Vault), and Junior Will Taylor (400 Meter Dash.) Most of the schools in the State of Illinois had NO ONE qualify. Geneseo was represented by FIVE MEN and four of them will return next year. The meet is a great opportunity to get some "Big Meet" experience.

The meet is set up for competition in all three Illinois Track and Field Classifications. The 1A competition was contested Friday evening. The 2A competition started at 9:00 a.m. with the 3A to follow. That resulted in a 6:15 a.m. bus departure time. The selection process for entry into the meet was based on performances during the indoor season through last weekend. Then, they offered entry into the meet in a descending order. Not all schools accepted but most did.

Sophomore Jake Rapps was the first Maple Leaf boy to compete when he lined up for the 3rd heat of the 60 Meter High Hurdles. Jake ran a solid race and ended up placing 5th in his heat. Only the top 8 fastest times qualified for the finals. Jake ended up 16th overall and ran an excellent time of 9.26 which was just off his personal best. Jake performed well and has a VERY bright future. Keep up the hard work, Jake. I am drooling with anticipation as we move

into the outdoor season. Bring on the 110 Meter High Hurdles and the 300 Meter Intermediate Hurdles. Way to go, Jake.

Up next for the Maple Leafs was Sophomore Luke Johnsen ("LJ, 3rd") in the Shot Put. Luke was up against a tremendous field of throwers and ended up with a throw of 13.20m (43' 03 3/4"). Luke wasn't happy and was hoping for a lot more. That is a GOOD problem. That means he cares a LOT. The Shot Put is a very technical event. Luke, your potential is "Through the Roof". Keep paying your dues in practice. The results will prove well worth it. Bring on the outdoor season and let's add in the Discus. We are VERY proud of you.

Up next for the Leafs were the "da Flying Schaads". Sadly, Malakai "Tweaked" his hamstring on Monday and was "Held Out" of the competition. It was not an easy decision but it was the right one. Better to be safe than sorry at this point in the season. He did a GREAT job of supporting his brother despite the challenging circumstances for him. Sophomore Cooper Schaad came in at 3.80m (12' 05 1/2") and cleared it on his 2nd attempt. Next up was 3.95m (12' 11 1/2") which he cleared on his first attempt. Next up was 4.10m and his first chance to use his new pole. It is the next pole in the sequence for him and it is going to take a bit of an adjustment for him to feel comfortable. He has complete faith in Vault Coach Arthur Atwell and used it for his first two attempts which he did not clear the bar. He switched back to the previous pole and "Mr. Clutch" cleared on his final attempt at that height. He then switched back to his "Big Stick" for 4.25m and repeated the exact same sequence. He had two solid attempts but near-missed before moving back to the same pole that he cleared to sail over 13' 11 1/4". "Mr. Clutch" was on his game. He then took 3 great attempts at 4.40m (14' 05 1/4") barely missing them all. Cooper ended up placing 7th to become the Leafs' lone medal winner. Way to go, Cooper! Bring on the outdoor season. Way to be a team man, Malakai!!!

Last up for the Leafs was Junior Will Taylor who competed in the 400 Meter Dash. The field was "Loaded" and Will ran a strong race. He participate in the 5th heat and was just off his indoor best time with his 54.35. His time was good for 20th overall. Great Job, Will! Bring on the outdoor season. Both your work ethic and intense competitive streak are true pleasure to watch. All the best in the coming competitive opportunities.
