Pulliam chases 3A state repeat

The 2022 Illinois boys track & field state meet will be held in Charleston from Thursday to Saturday, and many local athletes will be looking to defend — or receive their first — state medals.

Here are some of the biggest local storylines heading into the weekend at Eastern Illinois University.

Mighty Maroons

Moline will send three individuals to state, but two — Rob Pulliam and Saiheed Jah — have already had state meet success.

Pulliam is the defending state champion in the high jump after clearing 6 feet, 9 inches to win the gold. The senior Maroon

has won every single high jump competition in his high school career — all 13 — and advanced to the state meet again after becoming a sectional champion.

In the long jump, Pulliam has a good chance to be a finalist as well. Pulliam cleared 22 feet, 11 ½ inches to finish second at sectionals, but cleared 24 feet at the Western Big 6 meet earlier this season to become a conference champ.

Jah placed sixth in the 110 hurdles and ninth in the 300 hurdles at state last season, and has already set new personal-best times in 2022. The junior Maroon placed second in both events at sectionals to qualify for state, but ran a lifetime-best 14.57 in the 110 hurdles. Jah's 39.02 time in the 300 hurdles at the WB6 meet, which earned him a conference title, was his fastest of his career. He ran 39.07 at sectionals.

Can Geneseo brothers find the podium?

The Maple Leafs are sending four individuals to state, and two are a pair of brothers. Geneseo's Malakai Schaad and Cooper Schaad head to Charleston with a podium finish on the radar in the pole vault.

Malakai Schaad, the older brother, finished second at state last season as a junior with a 16 foot, ½ inch jump. He has battled injuries this season, but placed second at sectionals after clearing 14 feet, 5½ inches.

His little brother Cooper Schaad grabbed the sectional title after hitting a new PR with a 15 foot, 6 ½ inch vault. It broke his previous record by a foot. Cooper placed ninth in the pole vault at state last year.

Riverdale trio

Riverdale is sending six individuals to compete in eight events at state, the most for a local school in Class 1A. Three

of those, Landis Musser, William Leighty and Tommy Murray, qualified for state last season.

Murray was the only medalist with a seventh-place finish in the 3,200. The junior Ram will try to improve on that position this season after setting new PR's in both the 1600 and 3,200 - the two events Murray will run in Charleston. Murray hit 4:26.15 in the 1,600 on April 28 and has yet to lose in the event this season. Murray was also a sectional champion in the 3,200 with a time of 10:04.67, but has ran the event under 10 minutes twice this season.

Musser, who placed 20th at state last season in the 800, earned a sectional title with a time of 1:59.78 last Thursday. Musser also qualified for the 1,600 after finishing behind Murray in the sectional meet with a personal-best time of 4:44.85.


Leighty finished 19th at state last season in the triple jump, but has improved this year with a new lifetime best of 42 feet, 2 1/4 inches earlier this season.

Riverdale is also sending Reece Richmond (shot put), Luke Wiklund (100) and Eli Hinde (300 hurdles) to state.

Panther sighting

Erie-Prophetstown is sending four individuals and two relay teams to Charleston after dominant showings at sectionals.

Braxton Froeliger will be in three events, both individual and in relays. Froeliger became a sectional champion after a personal-record leap of 21 feet, 11 inches in the long jump last week. Froeliger, along with Michael Carlson. Trevor Cobo and Ben Lantz, ran weekend.

The 4x200 team won its sectional with a season-best time of ferent ways. Mottet tied for third 1:33.72 with those four runners. Froeliger qualified for state last season in the long jump and with the 4x100 and 4x200 relay teams, but was unable to place.

Cobo (high jump), Lantz (300 hurdles) and Parker Holldorf (pole vault) will also compete individually.

He will join Pulliam and Jah as Moline state qualifiers this



On Thursday, June 26th, the Leafs' four qualifiers: Sophomore Jake Rapps (110 Meter High Hurdles), Sophomore Kaden Salisbury (Discus), Sophomore Cooper Schaad (Pole Vault), and Senior Malakai Schaad (Pole Vault) departed Geneseo at 11:00 a.m.. They were headed for Charleston's Eastern Illinois University. Joining them on the trip were Coaches: Matthew Deets, Kyle Deets, Arthur Atwell, and Zach Johnson. Also making the trip to help with warm-up, etc...were: Sophomore Reed Preston, and Juniors Kyle Guerrero and Nate Ryerson.

The I.H.S.A. State Meet is back to its traditional 3-day format. Class 1A Prelims on Thursday and both Class 2A and 3A Prelims on Friday. All the finals are held on Saturday. Prelim "Marks" in all the field events except the High Jump and Pole Vault carry over after each athlete's three attempts. The top 12 then will received 3 more attempts on Saturday. Both the High Jump and Pole Vault jump until they have their "Final's Field" (usually, around 12.) All track events (except the 3200 Meter Run) also have prelims and their marks do NOT carry over to Saturday's Finals.

Leafs brothers chase title

CHARLESTON, Ill — Two brothers took the next step toward making

history Friday.

Geneseo's Malakai Schaad and Cooper Schaad, who both placed at state last season in the pole vault, qualified for the finals at the IHSA boys track and field state meet Friday at Eastern Illimois University.

Malakai, a senior, and Cooper, a sophomore, a dvanced to Saturday's final portion by clearing 13 feet, 6

inches.

"It's cool to have two brothers as some of the best in the state," Cooper Schaad said. "It doesn't happen very often where you have family together in one competition.

"It would be really, really cool (to stand on the podium together). We have talked about it — placing one and two. It would be amazing. I don't think that has ever happened before — brothers one and two. We want to be the first for that."

For Malakai Schaad, the defending state runner – up, clearing the preliminary round height was more of a challenge than he expected. Malakai jumped 16 feet at state last year.

"We came out for warmups

and mine just felt awful," Malakai Schaad said. "They were so bad. I was kind of nervous coming into it, but an official on the track who is a pole vault coach came up and told me 'Just get out of your head, you've been doing it all year."

"And so I did, and went for it and cleared it. They told us after all the guys cleared 13'6 that we were done because it was enough to qualify for

finals. So that was it."

With the return of the two-day schedule, the competition was unlike anything Malakai experienced at state last season.

"It was exciting because all the guys that qualified went around and hugged each other," Malakai Schaad said. "It was a lot different than last year because that was much higher stress. There was only once chance, and that was the final. I almost felt lazy today."

Cooper Schaad, who won sectionals last weekend over Malakai with a personal record 15 foot, 6 inch jump, also cleared 13'6 to reach the finals.

"We were trying to make today easy with one jump to clear it and get into finals," Cooper Schaad said. "My warmups weren't good, but my

second attempt did it. It was a little nerve-wracking."

Despite only being a sophomore, Cooper Schaad has experience at the state meet. He said placing ninth last year helped push himself this season

"It gave me a sense of the competition I would have this year," Cooper Schaad said. "There was still a lot ahead of me last year. It gave me a drive for this season."

Malakai may have the better hardware for now, but he believes his little brother will be even better than he is — a prediction coming from someone who has stood on the second highest podium at state.

"He's going to be so much better than me," Malakai Schaad said.
"He's had so much more time to get better than I did and he's just got that talent for it. People say the same thing about me sometimes, but it's not even close. He's going to be so much better than me and I sure hope he is."

The Maple Leafs' Kaden Salisbury will join the two brothers in the finals after a PR in the discus. The Geneseo sophomore launched the disc 153 feet, 6 inches to break his PR by over six feet.

"I have been practicing pretty hard this week and we were focusing on bringing my leg around and driving through the ring," Salisbury said. "Everything just came together and it worked out really well. I was very happy with it.


"It means so much to me (to make the finals). I'm only a sophomore so I have two more years to go. I am just so happy. I was just happy I PR'd, too"

Geneseo's Jacob Rapps was the only local qualifier in a track event in the Class 2A preliminary round. The sophomore Maple Leaf set a PR at sectionals and ran just .06 off the mark at state with a 15.67 time in the 110 hurdles, but it wasn't quite enough. Rapps finished 10th, one spot off and .27 behind the last qualifier for Saturday's finals.


Kewanee pole vaulter Xander Gruszecka was the lone Boilermaker to advance to the finals. Gruszecka, a senior, tied with two others to grab the final spot. 11 athletes were slated to advance, but after 10 tied at the 13'6 mark, three more — including Gruszecka — tied at 13 feet for the final spots.

Finals for all classes will begin at 10 a.m. Saturday.



Last up for the Leafs was Sophomore Kaden Salisbury who competed in the Discus. Kaden had three solid throws but the big news was made on his second attempt where he threw a "Lifetime"

Best of 46.76 meters (153 05.) He qualified with the 7th best throw on the day. Way to Go, Kaden!

The Maroon junior started his day in the 110 hurdles, where he ran his second fastest time of the year at 14.70 to finish fifth, a spot higher than he did last year in the event.

"To be honest I barely remem-Pulliam said. "I want to thank ber that race because I was just running," Jah said. "I just ran as fast as I could and overall I felt

About three hours later, Jah was back on the track for the 300 hurdles. He crossed the finish line

at 39.32, placing sixth.

"I felt like I was going fast, but on the third hurdle my form started to get bad. I could see the distance between me and the guy in front of me get bigger because I landed weird, which slowed me down a lot."

Despite the stumble, Jah improved in both events from last season. He moved up one spot in the 100 hurdles and three spots in

the 300 hurdles compared to last season at state.

"My biggest goal for everything is to always improve so it feels good to do that," Jah said. "I know a lot of people aren't lucky enough to (get two medals) so it feels good. I did my best.

"I was the only junior in both finals. I know next year there will be good runners, but I'm hoping to be in the one, two or three spot. I'm going to put in some work and

get better."

In 2A, every Geneseo finalist

earned a state medal.

The Maple Leafs' Cooper Schaad was the highest local finisher in 2A with a third place

finish after clearing 14 feet, 9 inches, which he did on his first

attempt.

"Going into it today I was not expecting third" Cooper Schaad said. "Everyone showed up with their A-games this morning and I was honestly kind of surprised with third, but I'm happy with it.

"The (14'9) jump was one of the easier ones honestly. After that, I got stuck on the 15-foot. I was fighting to get on the pole - that

was the problem."

Cooper Schaad's third place finish was a six-place step up on the podium after a ninth place finish at state during his freshman season.

Malakai Schaad, Cooper's older brother, placed ninth after clearing 13 feet, 9 inches. Malakai was the defending state runner-up and ended his high school career at state with another medal.


"I wasn't feeling the greatest today, so I was pretty relieved when they went through the list and told me that I got ninth," Malakai Schaad said. "I like it. I'll take a medal and get points on the board for Geneseo.

"It's nice to finish on the podium. I can't lie, it was a better result than I was expecting when I went out as low as I did. I get to share it with my brother against this year which is fun."

Geneseo's Kaden Salisbury also earned a state medal in the discus. The sophomore Maple Leaf recorded a personal-best 156 foot, 9 inch heave to place eighth. The distance beat Salisbury's most recent PR, which he set Friday in the preliminary round, by three feet.

Kewanee's Xander Gruszecka placed 10th in the pole vault, missing out a medal by one po-

KADEN AND "THE FLYING SCHAADS" EARN ALL-STATE HONORS

On Saturday, May 28th, the Leafs participated in the IHSA STATE FINALS. The Leafs were represented by THREE MEN. It is the goal of every athlete in every sport to end their season in the State Meet Finals. For Cooper, Kaden, and Malakai, that dream had come to fruition.

The vaulters were up first. Both Malakai and Cooper are experienced vaulters. Both men earned "All-State Honors" last season. In last year's State Meet, Cooper placed 9th while "Big Brother" Malakai placed 2nd on a day that saw him break the Geneseo High School Record THREE TIMES (all on third attempts.)

This year, Malakai has been battling a nagging hamstring injury for much of the season but made it to the State Finals anyway. Cooper broke his own Geneseo High School Sophomore School Record at the the Sectional Meet where he "Soared" 15' 06 1/4". That jump also moved him up to Number Two in GHS All-Time History.

Both Schaads entered the competition at 4.10 meters (13′ 05 1/4″.) Cooper cleared it on his first attempt while it took Malakai all three attempts to clear it. Welcome to Pole Vault 101. Nothing is guaranteed. Cooper passed at 4.20 meters (13′ 09 1/4″) while Malakai cleared it on

his second attempt. They both passed 4.30 meters (14′ 01 1/4″.) Both men were back in action at 4.40 meters (14′ 05 1/4″.) Cooper cleared it on his second attempt while Malakai was unable to clear the bar. Then, Cooper cleared 4.50 meters (14′ 09″) on his first attempt. Up next was 4.60 meters and Cooper was unable to clear the bar. When the "Dust had Settled", Cooper had landed in a three way tie for third. We were all "Holding out Breaths" and "Crossing our Fingers" hoping that Malakai had placed in the Top 9 to earn All-State Honors again. Take a DEEP BREATH and EXHALE. He placed 9th. We understand that both men had higher goals in mind but the bottom line is WAY TO GO GUYS! Congratulations on an AMAZING Season.

WOW....the Leafs still had Sophomore Kaden Salisbury competing. What an exciting day for the Leafs. Kaden's best throw from Friday of 46.78 meters (153' 05") had him "Sitting in 7th". Kaden wasn't able to improve on his tremendous throw from Friday and one athlete passed him up to drop him into 8th place. Yup, that's EIGHTH PLACE IN THE STATE CLASS 2A MEET. That place earned Kaden "ALL-STATE HONORS'. Way to go, Kaden! It has been a lot of fun watching you improve during the last two years.
