

Top running talent converges on Geneseo

Geneseo becomes the cross country capital of western Illinois Saturday when the Maple Leafs host the fifth annual Geneseo Invitational at Richmond Hill Park.

Action begins at 10:30 a.m. with frosh-soph competition. The varsity girls' meet starts at 11, with the varsity boys' meet beginning at 11:30.

Seventeen teams will compete in the girls' division — Bettendorf, Clinton, Davenport West, DeKalb, East Moline, Geneseo, Kewanee, LaSalle-Peru, Moline, Naperville Central, Lincoln-Way, Pleasant Valley, Iowa, Princeton, Rock Falls, Rockford Guilford and Rock Island.

The field is smaller - but not by much - in the boys' division which 14 teams have entered. Competing are Aurora West Bettendorf, Clinton, DeKalb, East Moline, Geneseo, Kewanee, LaSalle-Peru, Moline, Naperville Central, Princeton, Rock Falls, Alleman and Rock Island.

ACCORDING TO Geneseo boys' coach Jeff Quick, competition in the boys' division for both the team and individual titles should be intense.

"I don't know what Naperville Central and Aurora West have been doing," Quick said. "I'd say the top contenders are DeKalb, Moline, Clinton and possibly us. I definitely know of several teams that won't be in it."

At last weekend's DeKalb Invitational, Moline finished third while the host school captured the championship. But the Maroons' Craig Ford was the individual champion, and he's expected to be a top contender at Geneseo.

Other individuals tabbed by Quick were Jeff Jacobs of Clinton, Tony VandeWalle of Rock Island, Rich Prettyman and Matt Terronez of East Moline and the Maple Leafs' own duo of Rich Werkheiser and Eric Zeitler. Prettyman was the champion of the frosh-soph race last year, while Werkheiser was fifth in the varsity event.

IN THE GIRLS' meet - won last year by Naperville Central Quick also predicts a tough race.

"Pleasant Valley was the Iowa state champion last year," he pointed out. "Some of the best teams from Illinois will be here, too."

Moline, Geneseo dominate invite

GENESEO — It looked like a Moline-Geneseo dual meet when the runners began coming off the course at the weather-delayed Geneseo Invitational Cross Country Meet Monday.

The Maroons and Maple Leafs alternated the first four runners before allowing a finisher from one of the other nine schools entered. That domination was shown in the final team results, too, the Maroons beating their hosts by a scant three points, 62-65.

MOLINER CRAIG FORD kept his season record unblemished by taking individual honors. He finished the 2.95-mile run in 15:33.9 to beat Geneseo's Rich Werkheiser. Next to come in were Maroon Don Curtis and Leaf Eric Zeitler, with Tony VandeWalle of Rock Island and Rick Pretymann of East Moline rounding out the top six.

In the girls' division, Conni Frank of Rock Falls was the individual winner, while Pleasant Valley dominated the team competition, placing three runners in the top 10.

Bettendorf, paced by winner Steve Hunter, won the boys' frosh-soph competition.

The meet, which was to have included several Chicago-area teams, originally was scheduled Saturday, but was postponed by lightning.

Moline, Pleasant Valley win meet

Moline nosed the Leafs' boys' harrier team by three points in the Geneseo Invitational on Monday, September 28. "We ran well," Coach Jeff Quick observed. "We knew that Moline was the team to beat. We came back and beat Sterling who had beaten us earlier."

"The key for us in beating Moline at district in four weeks will be if Chris Gomez can run with Tim Renihan and if Harold Cooper can continue to drop."

Rich Werkheiser finished second in the meet in 15:58, behind Moline's Craig Ford in 15:33.9. Eric Zeitler finished fourth in 16:11.

The Leafs' season record in dual meets is 8-0.

Tim Renihan finished 18th, Harold Cooper was 29th, Chris Gomez came in 47th while Cris Bouwens ended in 49th.

Pleasant Valley won the girls' side of the Geneseo Invitational. The Geneseo girls finished eighth.

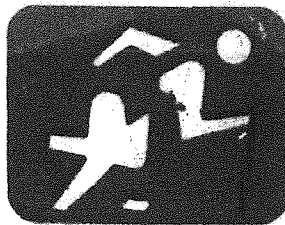
