Bulldogs dominate hilly Geneseo meet

GENESEO - Any trophy taken home from Saturday's Geneseo Invitational cross country meet isn't likely to gather dust in a dark corner.

That's because the competition was as tough as the hilly Richmond Hill Park course.

That was particularly true in the varsity girls race, where Bettendorf, led by defending individual state champion Julie Hudetz, beat defending Iowa team state champion Pleasant Valley for at least the second time this season in a major meet.

The Bulldog boys also won, nipping Galesburg, which had the individual champ in Matt Bell.

GENESEO FARED BEST of Dispatch area teams, placing third in both girls and boys competition. Complete results, including all individual finishes of Apple Leaf, Alleman, East Moline and Moline runners appear in Sports d.

"Just to give you an idea how tough things were," said Geneseo coach Jeff Quick, "I thought Leanne Larson (from Moline) ran well here today. And yet she was third (15 seconds behind winner Hudetz). Leanne won the DeKalb Invitational last weekend, and that's a prestigious meet in Illinois. Because we're so close to the (Mississippi) river here, we're able to bring those good Iowa teams over and run against them."

Hudetz didn't set the pace from the outset. "I started to move up after that first hill," said the Bettendorf junior. "We run some hilly courses, but this is the hilliest."

Hudetz covered two miles in 11:30. Galesburg's Kris Watters 11:37; Larson's third-place time was 11:45.

Bettendorf teammates behind Hudetz placed fourth, 11th, 16th account for the team's 16-point win over Pleasant Valley. Genes 89 points, was well in front of area teams East Moline, Moline, defending NCIC champion Princeton.

CONNIE GRADERT AND Priscilla Gomez paced Geneseo with eighth-place finishes, with Amy Alexander 14th and Lori DeBlieck.

In the boys race, defending champion Tim Arnett of Geneseo pace, but by the mid-point of the 2.7-mile trek, Bell, Jim Jung Joh and Jeff Koos of Bettendorf were stride-for-stride with him.
