Geneseo harriers are off to a blazing start

Geneseo cross country team dominated its competition Saturday, August 31 at the Canton Invitational by winning three of the possible four team championships. The varsity girls, led by Captain Priscilla Gomez, won the title with 36 points, 38 points better than the nearest competitor. One-half hour later, the frosh-soph repeated the feat by capturing the first place crown with 51 points. The junior varsity also won the title with 51 points. The boys varsity bettered last year's fourth place with a third place finish, only six points away from second.

Individually, the first place varsity girls were led by Priscilla Gomez with a second place finish overall and a time of 14:39 over the 2.2 mile course and junior Lorri DeBlick, the fourth place finisher with a 15:14 time. Freshman Gayle Perkins finish-

ed fifth with a 15:22, while sophomore Connie Gradert took ninth with a time of 15:46. Rounding out the field were Michelle Landrum, 16th place, Tara Zeitler, 23rd place and Kim Chapman, 24th place, with times of 16:17, 16:27, and 16:31, respectively. There were 105 girls from ten teams competing.

The next race was the frosh-soph race. The squad was led by Phil Walsh, a sophomore and Brad Baker, the only freshman on the team. This pair finished one-two over the 2.2 mile course. Walsh led throughout the race and won with a time of 13:05, while Baker came in behind with a 13:23. Mike Haars took seventh out of the 88 boys with a time of 13:37, while Tim Moran took 15th with a 14:09. Heath Lowe finished 26th with a time of 14:42, then right behind came Mike Morris in 51st place with a time of 15:01, and Conan Casta-

lein in the 34th spot with a time of 15:08 to his credit.

The junior varsity squad was represented well with three top ten finishers. John DeGrande was the first team member to cross the finish line in fourth place with a time of 13:55. Not far behind was senior James Werkheiser, who took 14:08 to cross the finish in sixth place. Jeff Schneider took the tenth spot running the course in 14:21.

The varsity boys were the last ones to race and when they did, they went out in a fury, with a group of them running the first mile of the 2.75 mile course in 5:01. The finishing times were also fast with Todd Puckett running the course in 16:10 to take 12th place out of 95 boys. Eighteenth place winner Cliff Harker and the 20th runner John Huyvaert were right behind with times of 16:18 and

16:20, respectively. The next runner in was Scott Perkins in 36th place with a time of 17:00, who was followed by Tony Linnabery in 39th place with a 17:08 mark. Scott Johnson, the only junior on the team, came in 47th in 17:23, closely followed by Whit Sieben in 49th, only three seconds behind with a 17:26.

Asking Coach Fredericks on what he thought about the team, he replied, "I was very impressed with the team spirit shown thus far, and the senior leadership in this group is fantastic, and will prove to be advantageous as the year goes along."

The group will try to equal and better its performance at its next competition Saturday, September 8, at the Rockford Harlem Invitational.
