New Geneseo coach likes Q-C harriers

Don Fredericks has only been coaching cross country at Geneseo for about a month, but he's already running into some stiff competition in the Quad-City area.

Fredericks spent several years as an assistant coach at Crystal Lake South in the northwest Chicago suburbs prior to finishing up a degree in exercise physiology at Western Illinois University last year.

From what he's seen on the course so far, Quad-City area teams compare favorably with teams from the Chicago area in most respects.

"The difference is that there are a lot more quality competitors available in the Chicago area because of its size," Fredericks said.

In order to fight that problem, Fredericks has had his Maple Leaf team traveling to meets in some rather far-off places.

"We left at 3 a.m. for a meet at Homewood-Flossmoor last week," Fredericks said. "If you want to be a competitive school in Illinois, you've got to compete in some of the major metropolitan meets."

And the results so far have been good. The Maple Leaf girls are ranked fifth, the only area team ranked in Illinois. The only Illinois Quad-City area team ranked in the boy's poll is Galesburg. The Silver Streaks are 19th.

Fredericks said it is hard for prep runners in this area to gain proper recognition.

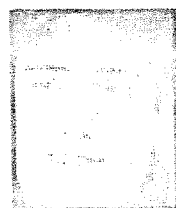
"If the teams don't get the opportunity to go in and knock heads with the suburban schools, it's really hard for teams in this part of the state to gain any recognition," Fredericks said. "That's too bad because there are some teams out here that deserve it."

Fredericks took over for current Moline cross country Coach Jeff Quick at the beginning of the school term. Quick didn't leave the cupboard bare when he left Geneseo.

The Maple Leaf girls are led by senior Priscilla Gomez, who won the two-mile title at last week's Geneseo Invitational in 11 minutes, 50 seconds.

Gomez edged out Sara Roberson of Bettendorf, Rock Island Alleman's Colleen Doak, and two of Pleasant Valley's best, Robin Kelly and Christine Thorburn, for the title.

Last weekend at the Geneseo Invitational, Fredericks got a look at some of the best Iowa has to offer in the Pleasant Valley and Bettendorf

girls' teams and the Clinton boys' program.

"They've got very good programs at those schools," he said. "They've got good, quality competitors."

In fact, Pleasant Valley and Bettendorf are ranked 1-2 in the latest Iowa girl's Class 3A ratings. North Scott is fifth. In Class 2A, the DeWitt girls are fourth. Wapello is ranked sixth in Class 1A.

Coach Bob Heiselaw's Clinton boys are top-ranked in Class 3A and Bettendorf is No. 7.
