

Talented Geneseo running stronger

GENESEO — Geneseo's cross country teams were emerging state powers when new coach Don Fredericks took over the program this fall. And local fans who attend Saturday morning's Geneseo Invitational in Richmond Hill Park may find that the Maple Leafs are still improving.

The Leaf girls, fifth in the state last year, are better yet, said Fredericks, who served as a grad-assistant at Western Illinois last year. Why? They're faster. And there are more of them.

And Fredericks thinks the boys, despite graduating all-stater Tim Arnett, the 12th-place finisher in last year's state meet, have improved. "to where we should be ranked among the top 10 in the state."

Those are pretty high numbers, but then interest in cross country in Geneseo is pretty high, too. Fredericks has 53 runners, including 18 girls, on his squads. He said both figures are record numbers for Geneseo.

THE LEAF GIRLS Saturday won the prestigious Homewood-Flossmoor Invitational, beating Downers Grove North, last year's second-place team at state.

Maple Leaf senior Priscilla Gomez won the race by 200 yards, tying the course record of 14:38 for 2.5 miles set last year by Tracy Laughlin of Downers Grove North, who was last year's third-place finisher at state.

"Priscilla looked like a state champion," said Fredericks. "She ran her first mile in 5:18. That's just four seconds slower than her personal best in the open mile, so that's an indication her mile time will come down this spring, too."

Gomez is one of three Leaf captains, the others being senior boys Cliff Harker and Todd Puckett.

Seven runners compete in cross country meets, with the first five finishers for each team counting toward team total. Last year's Geneseo girls had four strong runners.

Geneseo is stronger now, said Fredericks, because the Leafs have seven solid performers now — two freshmen have helped mightily — and all the runners back from last year are much improved.

The remainder of the Geneseo front seven: Junior Lorri DeBlieck, sophomore Connie Gradert, freshman Gail Perkins, sophomore Tara Zeitler, freshman Kim Chapman and sophomore Michelle Landrum.

The top 25 place finishers at the state meet earn all-state honors; Gomez was 26th last fall. "My goal this year," said Fredericks, "is for our top four (Gomez, DeBlieck, Gradert and Perkins) all to finish in the top 25."

FREDERICKS BELIEVES Wheeling and Palatine are stronger than his girls squad right now, with Elmhurst York and Downers Grove North fitting in just behind the Leafs.

"What's so encouraging is that we're just doing strength work now. We're running a lot of hills, and doing a lot of long, slow distance. We won't do our speed work until later, and that's when you'll see our times really come down. It's good for the kids to know that they're nowhere near where they will be, yet they're still

winning."

Observers in Geneseo didn't believe the Leaf boys would be as strong after Arnett graduated. But look again. "I've never seen a more determined group," said Fredericks. "We've gotten great senior leadership. We're packing better. And, these guys have killer instinct."

The top four Leafs all have been Geneseo's top runner in various meets. They are sophomore Phil Walsh and seniors John Huyvaert and Harker and Puckett.

Fredericks named senior Tony Linabery, Whit Sieben and Scott Perkins as the fifth through seventh runners, not necessarily in that order. Another Leaf to watch: Senior James Werkheiser.

"James didn't run all summer. He hadn't planned on coming out this year," said Fredericks. "But he had a change of heart. He has the ability to crack our top five."

THE LEAF BOYS were third at Homewood-Flossmoor, trailing the hosts and Chicago Marist, both annual fixtures in the state's top 10. "The kids had to get up at 3 a.m. Saturday, but they didn't make any excuses. After the meet, they went over to Brookfield to root for the football team."

There are 53 runners out for Geneseo's teams, but only 15 are mentioned here. What do the rest contribute? "Every kid means something to us, even if it's just a smile, a pat on the back, or a word of encouragement he or she gives a varsity runner," said Fredericks. "They have a lot of fun."

And so does the coach. "We have no trophy case for cross country, so one of our goals is to fill my desk with trophies so I don't have room to do any work on it. It's half full already."

"The dedication, leadership and talent is there," said Fredericks. "My job is to keep our runners healthy and motivated. I'm having a blast."

Richmond Hill park's hills will be covered with scores of runners on Saturday morning, September 21 for the annual Geneseo cross country invitational for boys and girls.

The JV boys step off at 10 a.m. followed by the JV girls half an hour later. At 11 a.m., the frosh-soph boys take off with the varsity girls at 11:30 and the varsity boys at noon.

Boys' teams entered are Belvidere, Bettendorf, Clinton, Davenport North, Davenport West, East Moline, Geneseo, Kewanee, Moline and Alleman while the girls' field includes Pleasant Valley in addition to the others.

The boys' varsity and JV course is 2.7 miles while the other races will cover two miles.

Lady Leaf harriers will be in pretty heady company if the cross country state poll out soon goes as Head Coach Don Fredericks expects. He anticipates the Geneseo girls will be ranked at least third and perhaps as high as second.

The boys may also be ranked high, somewhere in the top ten, Mr. Fredericks indicated.

Gomez, Lady Leafs win harrier invitational

Gomez tied the 2.5 mile course record of 14:38, set last year by Tracy Laughlin of Downer's Grove North who finished third at state later that year. Gomez was not alone in the first place Geneseo finish, with three other top ten finishers in the field. Lorri DeBleck was the second woman for Geneseo to cross the finish line in fourth place with Connie Gradert in seventh and Gail Perkins in tenth.

The team was rounded out with the finishes of Tara Zeitler in eighteenth place, and Michelle Landrum in twenty-seventh place.

Priscilla Gomez took first place in the Homewood-Flossmoor Invitational on Saturday, September 14 while leading her team to a convincing 28-point

victory.

The boys finished third with Phil Walsh's 21st place the highest finish for the Leafs.
