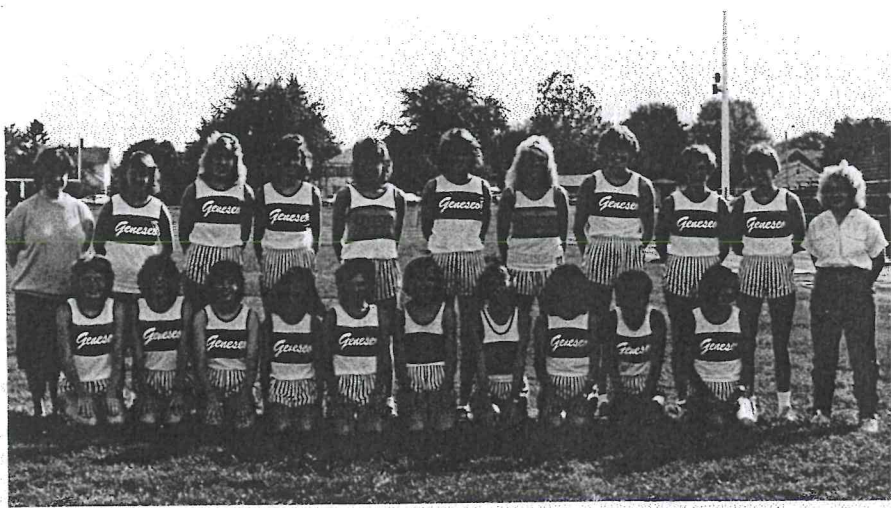

The Cross-Country season was filled with victories beginning in August and lasting into November. The girls outdistanced the competition in five of six dual and triangular meets, plus won several major invitationals. At the conference meet, the girls demolished the competition, placing all seven varsity runners in the top 15 finishers. Victory was repeated at the regional meet, hosted by Geneseo. This is the third straight year the Lady Leafs have won both conference and regional titles. The girls were narrowly defeated at the Sectional meet, finishing second to state-ranked Guilford. The highlight of the season was the Leaf's third, consecutive, top-ten finish at the state meet.



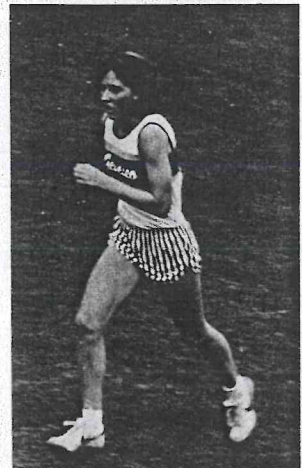

The Maple Leafs Boys Cross-country team had an extremely successful season under second-year coach Don Fredericks. Both the Varsity and the Fresh Soph finished with 7-3 overall meet records. The team's best invitational finish was at the Geneseo Invitational where the Fresh-Soph won and the Varsity finished a close second to Iowa state champions, Clinton. The Leafs capped the successful season with the Varsity winning its second straight NCIC championship and the Fresh-Soph tying with Iaceton for the title. In IHSA post-season meets, Geneseo placed third at regionals and fourth at sectionals. John DeGrande and Scott Johnson were voted Co-Captains, Phil Walsh was voted Most Valuable Runner, Joe Holevoet was voted Most Improved, and John DeGrande was voted Most Inspirational.

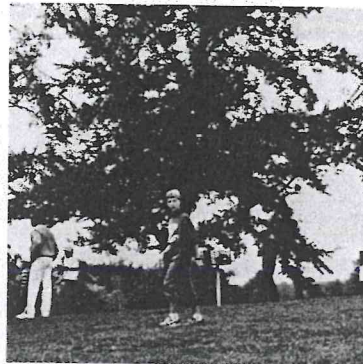
