

Tracksters prepare for cross country invitational

On Saturday, September 6, 11 teams will compete in the 1986 Geneseo High School Invitational Cross Country meet at Richmond Hill park. Runners will be divided into five divisions, with the junior varsity boys race leading the pack at 10 a.m.

Following the leaders will be the junior varsity girls, who will start at 10:30 a.m. Frosh-soph boys will begin at 11 a.m. followed by the varsity girls' race at 11:30 a.m. and the varsity boys at 12 noon.

Teams participating in addition to Geneseo are Bettendorf, Clinton, Davenport North, Davenport West and Pleasant Valley, all in Iowa and Freeport, Joy-Westmer, Orion, Rock Island Alleman

and Sherrard, all in Illinois.

According to Coach Don Fredericks, the strongest teams in the meet will be Bettendorf, Clinton and Geneseo in the boy's division and Bettendorf, Pleasant Valley and Geneseo in the girl's division.

Seven people may enter the boys' frosh-soph and varsity races and the girls' varsity race, with the top five people counted in team totals. There will be unlimited entries available in the junior varsity boys and girls races, again with the top five counting for team totals. Runners may only run in one race.

Varsity and junior varsity boys will run a 2.7 mile course while frosh-soph boys

and the girls' races will be two-mile courses.

Team trophies will be awarded to the first, second and third place finishers for the boys' and girls' varsity division with trophies also being given to the top 30 individual finishers.

Junior varsity boys and girls will be awarded a team trophy for the first place team only. Trophies will be awarded to the top 10 finishers and ribbons for places 11-30.

In the frosh-soph boys' division, a team trophy will be given to the first and second place teams. Trophies will also be received by the top 10 finishers while anyone finishing 11-30 will be awarded a ribbon.

Geneseo cross country squads romp over invitational opponents

Geneseo's cross country squads started the season on the right foot, taking four of five divisions at the Saturday, September 6, Geneseo Invitational.

One of the major highlights of the day was a tremendous showing by the girls varsity squad. Fourth, fifth and sixth place finishes by junior Connie Grader, senior Lorri DeBlick and sophomore Gail Perkins, respectively were a key to the final victory.

The top five finishers for a team counted in the final score. Sophomore Kim Chapman and junior Tara Zietler, finishing 17 and 22, respectively, rounded out the field toward the 54 point final.

Two of Iowa's best teams, Bettendorf and Pleasant Valley, took the second and third place positions. Bettendorf tallied 69 points while Pleasant Valley marked 70.

Geneseo's only team miss came after a gallant effort by junior Phil Walsh. The varsity Leafs led Iowa state champ, Clinton until the final half mile when fatigue helped the River

Kings claim a close 53-58 victory.

Others aiding in the close margin for Geneseo were junior Mike Haas, eighth place finish, sophomore Brad Baker, ninth place, senior Scott Johnson, 17 and senior John DeGrande, 21.

Junior Tim Moran was held out of the Invitational meet with a hip injury. He is the varsity squad's third man. "With Moran they were history," Coach Don Fredericks commented.

Geneseo also took wins in the frosh-soph boys and both the junior varsity boys and girls races.

Three towns sported a full five or more runners for the junior varsity boys race. Geneseo took first with a total of 41 points followed by Davenport North and Bettendorf in a tie with 44.

Finishers tallied toward the 41 points final were senior Bill Holevoet, fourth place, junior Mike Morris, fifth, juniors Heath Lowe and Greg Ryner, ninth, junior Todd Erbst, 11 and junior Mike Johnson, 12.

In the junior varsity girls-

division, Geneseo took the event with a total of 18 points. The closest competitor was Bettendorf with 72 points followed by Davenport West, 90.

Clinton, Davenport North, Freeport and Pleasant Valley also participated in the race but did not have enough runners to tally a final score.

Kristin Kemmis led the pack, the only individual first place runner for Geneseo in the Cross Country Invitational. Teammate Karen Roehrs followed with a second place finish. Both girls are freshman.

Fourth, fifth and sixth place finishes rounded out the scoring for the junior varsity girls. Place finishers in their respective order were freshman Renee Clifton, sophomore Rachel Perkins and sophomore Janice Kleiman.

A "great job" by the frosh-soph boys team was the final team victory for Geneseo. The squad racked up 62 points with Clinton in second with 74.

Runners tallied in Geneseo's victory were freshman Jason VanVooren, second place finish, sophomore Vic Dzekunskas, 12, sophomore Joe Holevoet, 15, freshman Brian Walsh, 16 and sophomore Christian Michael sen, 17.

A total of 55 boys and girls reported for the cross country sport this year. In addition to the top five finishers for a school in each division, other trackers were running.

Leafs' harriers boast record numbers

GENESEO - The long green line? In Geneseo, it's the high school cross country program, which has a record 55 boys and girls (and counting) out for the sport.

Enthusiastic second-year coach Don Fredericks coaches both the boys and girls, and considers them one team - they run the same workouts, and have almost identical schedules.

Both Leaf teams won NCIC championships last season, the boys ending Sterling's three-year hold on the title. The girls also won the regional and the sectional, and finished ninth in the state meet - and six of the top seven runners from that team return.

The girl the Leafs lost - to graduation - "is one we can't replace," said Fredericks, about Priscilla Gomez, who was the number 10 individual in the state meet.

But, if the returnees have improved, learn to pack better, and stay healthy, Geneseo's girls will be dynamite.

The returning six: senior tri-captain Lorri DeBleck, juniors Connie Gradert, Tara Zeitler and Michelle Landrum, and sophomores Gail Perkins and Kim Chapman.

DeBleck had mono much of last season, "but she's looking real strong this year," said Fredericks. Gradert was bothered badly by bronchitis late in the campaign.

Fredericks said senior Denise Ryner has looked strong in practice. She was bothered by a leg injury much of last

season. And the coach said sophomore Rachael Perkins has been Geneseo's number seven runner in pre-season practice.

For the boys, the only member of the top seven back is junior Phil Walsh. "He was our top runner last year, though, and he's looking great," said Fredericks. "We have good underclassmen, so we're optimistic."

Seniors Scott Johnson and John DeGrande are the squad's other tri-captains, and a third senior vying for a spot in the top seven is Jeff Schneider.

Strong juniors, said Fredericks, are Mike Morris, Tim Moran, Heath Lowe, and Mike Haars, with sophomore Brad Baker a contender. The coach said three more seniors could work into the picture: Bill Holevoet, Jason Kneen, and Howard Robinson.

The Leafs open with their own Geneseo Invitational this Saturday in Richmond Hill Park. "We moved it up a couple weeks to avoid conflict with the Peoria Spalding Invitational," said Fredericks. "A lot of teams were opting to go to that meet - we are, too - because it gives the kids a chance to run on the state meet course in DeWeiller Park."

Fredericks said that Geneseo will host the regional, and that Sterling has the sectional. "Those are courses we're familiar with," he said.

Geneseo runs well at invite

GENESEO - It was their first cross country meet of the season, "and the Maple Leafs are smiling," said Geneseo coach Don Fredericks.

The reason(s): team wins in four of five races in Saturday's Geneseo Invitational. The highlight: a win by Geneseo's varsity girls over a field including Iowa's two best teams, Bettendorf and Pleasant Valley.

Geneseo's only team miss came after a mighty effort in the varsity boys race. The Leafs led Iowa state champ Clinton until tiring in the last half mile, the River Kings claiming a close, 53-58 win.

Running in packs keyed the win for Geneseo's girls. Leafs Connie Gradert, Lorri DeBleck and Gail Perkins finished third, fourth and fifth, respectively. And Geneseo's Kim Chapman, Tara Zeitler and Michelle Landrum were 17th, 22nd, and 23rd. The first five finishers for each squad figure in the team scoring, "and that run by Chapman may have been the key to our win," said Fredericks.

Bettendorf's Sara Roberson covered the hilly, two-mile course in 11:32, winning by almost a minute. "She just crushed a strong field," said Fredericks. "I'd like to see her run against Dana Miroballi. I think it would be a great race." Miroballi, from Wheeling, is Illinois' two-time defending state champion.

The top area finisher in the girls race was Alleman's Colleen Doak, who was third in 12:45. "She ran a fine race, and it was good to see her running well," said Fredericks.

"We haven't done any speed work yet, and I had our boys maybe too pumped up," said Fredericks. "Clinton just went by us that last half mile."

Geneseo junior Phil Walsh charged into the lead while attacking a long hill at the 1.5-mile mark of a 2.75-mile course. But he was passed in the final half mile by Pleasant Valley's L.J. Albrecht, who won in 14:33, and by defending champ Brad Wall of Clinton, who was second in 14:45. Walsh was third in 14:50. "Phil was aggressive; he went for the win," said Fredericks.

Geneseo also took team wins in the frosh-soph boys and in the junior varsity boys and girls races. Kristin Kemmis of the Leafs took the individual title in the jayvee girls race.
