Cross country runners shut out their competition

When it rains, it pours. And this time it does not mean just the weather, even if it was pouring during the Wednesday, September 24 cross country meet in Spring Creek.

Opposition also thought it was raining runners. Geneseo's frosh-soph squad and varsity girls squads shut-out the competition during the meet.

In the varsity girls division, Geneseo runners took the top six slots before a competitor, Johnson of Sterling, crossed the line in seventh.

Lorri DeBlick led the pack, finishing first with a time of 15:41. Gail Perkins, Michelle Landrum, Kim Chapman and Tara Zeitler finished second through fifth, respectively, and rounded out the five top finishers scoring.

The sixth place slot belonged to Kirstin Kemmis while Rachael Perkins, eight, Renee Clifton, ninth, Denise Ryner, 16, Janice Kleinau, 18, Heather Clifton, 19 and Gretchen Perkins, 20, also competed.

Final scores showed Geneseo with 15 while Sterling marked 49.

The other shut-out, the frosh-soph boys, showed Geneseo placers in the top five slots. The top five finishers for a team are tallied for the final score.

Geneseo won the division with 15 points. Sterling placed second followed by Streator in third. Team pairings showed Geneseo tallying 15 to Sterling's 44, Geneseo, 15 to Streator's 50 and Sterling, 16 to Streator's 39.

Narrow times in the first three positions helped Geneseo. Joe Holevoet clocked in first with 15:04 with Brian Walsh on his heels in 15:08. Teammate Vic Dzekunskas clocked in third with a time of 15:11.

Rounding out the scoring for the frosh-soph squad were Mich-

ael Bell, fourth in 15:29 and Christian Michaelsen, fifth in 15:30.

Sterling had two place finishers before Geneseo crossed the line again. Howard Harmon placed eighth in the field. Other runners for Geneseo were John Marsh, 13, Jim Henderson, 15, John Puentes, 20, John Stone, 23 and Thad Lindstrom, 25.

And the rain continued to pour.

LaSalle-Peru took top honors in the varsity boys division. The victory put LP in the drivers seat for the conference, but according to Coach Don Fredericks, "watch out!"

Competition for the squad was tough and Geneseo kept pretty even pace with the LP team. In team pairings, LaSalle-Peru only beat Geneseo by three points, 26-29. In other pairings, LP beat Sterling, 24-31 and Geneseo beat Sterling, 23-32.

Overall LP tallied 35 points while Geneseo finished second with 37 with Sterling in third with 48.

Philip Walsh placed first for Geneseo, second overall, with a time of 14:50, just 14 off the winner. Brad Baker was the

next Geneseo runner to cross the tape, coming in fifth overall.

Finishing the scoring for Geneseo were Mike Haars, ninth, Scott Johnson, 10 and Jason VanVooren, 11.

Others covering the course for Geneseo were John DeGrande, 16, Shawn Alexander, 17, Bill Holevoet, 18, Mike Morris, 19, Health Lowe, 21, Tim Moran, 22 and Jason Kneen, 26.

Additional runners were Greg Ryner, 27, Mike Johnson, 30, Todd Erbst, 31, Fred Freund, 32 and Ryan Edwards, 33.
