

Leaf harriers dominate Bettendorf invitational

Despite the windy conditions, Geneseo's varsity cross country team dominated the 3.1 mile course at Hidden Hills, Bettendorf, Iowa, Thursday, September 17.

The frosh-soph harriers took second in their division of the meet.

The varsity squad tallied 27 points for the win followed by Bettendorf in second, 54 points, United Township, third, 68 points and Dixon, fourth, 71 points.

Phil Walsh led Geneseo while taking second in the field with his time of 17:05.9. Walsh was preceded by Rob Dowell of Dixon who set a course record of 17:01.1.

In a close third place was Leaf harrier Brad Baker who clocked in at 17:06. Jason VanVooren rounded out the top five in the field with a fifth place time of 17:31.

Mike Haars and Adam Boardman, a freshman, sewed up eighth and ninth positions with their respective times of 17:49 and 17:52. This was the first meet Boardman competed as a varsity runner.

The Leafs stacked runners later in the field with Mike Morris, 18:30, in 17th place; Heath Lowe, 18:34, 18th place; Barry Bassier, 18:48, 20th position and Darin Cowan, 18:50, 21st place.

Other Geneseo cross country runners and their placings include Shawn Alexander, 19:08, 25th; Randy Kinkade, 19:53, 32nd; Howard Harmon, 20:37, 39th; John Stone, 20:52, 44th; Mike Coleman, 21:25, 46th; Jon Marsh, 21:47, 48th; Brett Leslie, 22:20, 53rd; Dan Roehrs, 22:30, 55th; Gene Miller, 22:47, 57th, and Chad Lowe, 22:55, 58th.

Bettendorf took the top slot in the frosh-soph class with 29 points. Geneseo, 36, placed second for the field while United Township, 90, placed third and Dixon, 92, placed fourth.

Bryan Glass claimed the top honor for Geneseo when he took the tape in 18:38. Three more Leafrosh harriers placed within the top ten for the field. Jason Leigh, 19:02, nabbed fifth place while Cubby Orwig, 19:12, took sixth and Brian Walsh, 19:53, placed 10th.

Several frosh-soph runners kept close together for Geneseo, keeping the overall scoring tight.

Jim Henderson and Justin VanVooren took 14th and 15th places, respectively, with times of 20:10 and 20:35. Tim Harker, 20:40, placed 18th overall while Steve Campbell, 21:04 and Bryan Crawford, 21:15, took 21st and 22nd. Shane McKibbin, 22:02, finished 24th.

Other harriers finishing were Glenn Klopp, 22:37, 27th; Pat Barnes, 23:02, 28th; Travis

Stroh, 23:26, 31st; Shannon Sowers, 23:41, 33rd; Chris Bush, 24:25, 39th and Bret Felski, 32:13, 42nd place.

The Lady Leaf harriers packed the field for places seven through nine. Wendy Wassell, 13:26, nabbed the seventh place slot followed by her teammates Renee Clifton, 13:33 and Kirstin Kemmis, 13:38.

Michelle Landrum and Gail Perkins placed 13th and 14th respectively, with times of 13:49 and 13:59.

The coach feels his varsity harriers have a good chance to place in the top 10 teams in the state with the help of Gradert and her teammates. It would make the fourth year in a row for the feto. As a team the cross country harriers have won conference and regionals the last three years.

Thursday afternoon, September 17 in Bettendorf. The girls ran the 2-mile course at Hidden Hills golf course.

Bettendorf edged out Geneseo for first, tallying just 18 points while Geneseo racked up 20. United Township and Dixon remained in close contention among themselves with UT scoring 56 points and Dixon 61 points.

Bettendorf's Robinson continued to edge out Geneseo by taking the tape in 12:28. Gradert wasn't far behind, taking second place honors in 12:44. Karmen Roehrs, who held the same time as Gradert, earned the bronze medal slot.

Coach Don Fredericks has nothing but praise for senior harrier Gradert. According to the coach she "has been a leader both on and off the field for four years. It has been exciting as a coach to see her enjoy the year and the success she has been having."

Mr. Fredericks added that Gradert has placed fourth in the two major invitationals the team

has high predictions for the boys' team as well, saying "hopefully they will win the triple crown at conference."

Geneseo walked away the victors in the girls frosh-soph division of the meet. The Lady Leafrosh tallied just 24 points, slipping past second place Bettendorf with 25 points. UT remained in the competition with a final 36 points while

Dixon finished with 108.

Geneseo's first harrier to cross the finish was Cindy Mattan. Mattan's time of 14:44 earned fourth place overall, 21 behind the first place runner.

Jill Minnert took fifth place overall with a time of 14:53 while being the second Geneseo place finisher.

Rachel Perkins and Karen Miller nabbed seventh and eighth place slots with their respective times of 15:14 and 15:22. Carin Musak also placed within the top 10 for the field, coming in 10th at 15:37.

Other frosh-soph runners include Julie Ghys, 16:07, 14th; Theresa Miller, 16:10, 15th; Cathy Orwig, 16:21, 16th and Gretchen Perkins, 16:42, 18th.
