

Harriers take one point sweet revenge on Clinton

Clinton: "A bad word to the Geneseo varsity boys cross country team for years. Well, not anymore. "Sweet revenge" was how Coach Don Fredericks dubbed the one point victory over the Iowa team at the IHSA Cross Country Invitational in Geneseo Saturday, September 5. In the past, Clinton has taken the victory from the varsity harriers but this year the Leafs took charge and the crown with a one-point margin.

In addition to the varsity boys' first, Geneseo earned firsts in the frosh-soph boys, junior varsity boys, and junior varsity girls' divisions. The varsity girls squad finished third in the contest with two runners on the injured list.

Team scoring for the varsity boys showed Geneseo in first with 56 points, Clinton, Iowa in second with 57 and Bettendorf, Iowa in third with 93. Other team scores were Pleasant Valley, Iowa, fourth, 106; Joy-Westmer, fifth, 122; Freeport, sixth, 150; Orion, seventh, 162 and Sherrard, eighth, 179 points.

Clinton harriers claimed the first two slots with the winning time clocked at 14:28. Geneseo runners took the third, fifth and sixth places within the top ten.

For Geneseo's varsity boys squad, Phil Walsh can be given much of the credit for the win with a 15:25, third-place finish for the 2.7 mile course, according to Coach Fredericks. Close behind was Jason VanVooren with a fifth-place finish and a time of 15:34. Mike Haars was sixth in 15:37.

Others scoring in the Leafs' defense were Tim Moran, 16th, 16:21; Heath Lowe, 26th, 16:43; Brad Baker, 41st, 18:34 and Barry Bassier, 42nd, 18:43.

Coach Fredericks felt the top three Geneseo finishers had a "great race" in the season opener while Moran and Lowe ran "solid" races for the day.

The Leafrosh took an overwhelming lead in the frosh-soph division scoring 19 points for the victory. The closest competitor was Davenport West with 60 points for second place, followed by Clinton, third, 75 points and Bettendorf, fourth, 82 points. "Awesome depth" is all that is needed to describe the frosh win. Geneseo claimed five of the top seven slots with runners in

both first and second.

Adam Boardman took the overall meet with his time of 11:29 followed by his teammate Brian Glass, 11:40. Scott Mumey of Davenport West claimed third place clocking in at 11:42.

Three more Geneseo runners crossed the tape with just one Clinton runner interrupting the complete sweep. Cubby Orwig, 11:46, nabbed fourth followed by Jason Leigh, 11:47, fifth. Wes Golden of Clinton, 11:50, took sixth place, while Brian Walsh, 11:52, captured seventh.

Justin VanVooren and Steve Campbell also finished for Geneseo. VanVooren clocked in at 12:16.02 for 12th place, while Thad Barker clocked in at 12:16.81 for 13th place. Campbell's time of 13:24.15 earned him 23rd place.

An overall team effort handed the junior varsity boys a victory with 23 points. Davenport North captured second place with 87 points.

The top 10 individual winners were awarded trophies for the invitational with Geneseo runners claiming six of the ten slots.

The winning time of 16:31 was claimed by Davenport North's Vince Robinson, but Geneseo stacked its harriers in second, third, fourth and fifth places.

Joe Holevoet led the Leaflets with his time of 16:46. Conlan Castelein clocked in at 16:54 for third followed by Vic Dzekunkas, 17:07, and Mike Morris, 17:11.

Several other Leaflets dominated the field by finishing within the top 20 runners. They include Shawn Alexander, ninth, 17:48; Jim Henderson, 10th, 17:53; Howard Harmon, 12th, 18:12; Dartin Cowan, 13th, 18:16; Gene Miller, 15th, 18:49; Randy Kinkeade, 16th, 18:52; Pat Barnes, 17th, 18:57; John Marsh, 18th, 19:09.

Others crossing the line were Brett Leslie, 22nd, 19:29; Bryan Crawford, 23rd, 19:32; John Stone, 24th, 19:38; Shannon Sowera, 25th, 19:41; Tim Harker, 26th, 19:42; Glenn Klopp, 28th, 21:01; Dan Roehrs, 29th, 21:10; Shane McKibbin, 30th, 21:19; Corey Carroll, 31st, 22:24; Chad Lowe, 32nd, 22:42; Lee Eastburn, 33rd, 23:00 and Bret Felske, 35th, 26:39.

Geneseo also claimed victory in the junior varsity girls division with 46 team points. Bettendorf slipped into second with 49 points while Clinton claimed third with 88.

A "very exciting performance" by Wendy Wassell, claimed the top notch for the Lady Leaflets with her time of 13:55. Rachel Perkins and Garin Musak also finished within the top 10 runners with Perkins clocking 15:47 for sixth place while Musak's time of 15:59 earned a seventh place finish.

Other Lady Leaflets' times are Cathy Orwig, 17:14, 12th place; Gretchen Perkins, 18:02, 20th place and Julie Ghys, 19:26, 26th place.

The Lady Leafs were hampered by injuries for the IHSA invitational. Gail Perkins didn't run the meet at all while Tara Zeitler couldn't finish her race due to injury.

Bettendorf claimed the team victory with 35 points followed by Pleasant Valley, second with 38 and Geneseo third with 56. Other team tallies include Clinton, fourth, 124 points; Davenport West, fifth, 125 points; and Freeport, sixth, 131 points.

Geneseo could only place two runners within the top 10 slots with Connie Gradert and Karmen Roehrs running "tough" races for sixth and seventh places. Gradert's time of 13:17 claimed sixth, while Roehrs clocked in at 13:18 for seventh.

Packing was the key later in the pack with Kim Chapman, Renee Clifton and Kirstin Kemmis coming in 12th, 13th and 16th, respectively. Chapman clocked a 13:59 followed by Clifton, 13:59 and Kemmis, 14:04. Michelle Landrum placed 24th for the Lady Leafs with a time of 14:42.

Leaf boys whip top Iowa

harriers; girls finish third

GENESEO — Geneseo's cross-country teams took on some of the best Iowa squads at its own invitational Saturday, but the Leafs proved to be the strongest school by winning the boys event and taking third in the girls contest.

Phil Walsh powered the Leaf boys to first with a third-place finish at 15:25 for the 2.7-mile boys course as Geneseo squeezed out a one-point win, 56-57, over Clinton. Bettendorf and Pleasant Valley finished third and fourth, respectively, while Westmer recorded 122 points for fifth place and Freeport took sixth with 150. Orion finished seventh with 162 and Sherrard settled for eighth place with 179 tallies.

Clinton's Dave Ladehoff was the individual winner with a time of 14:28.

Leaf standout Connie Gradert led the Geneseo girls into a third-place spot with 56 points behind Bettendorf and Pleasant Valley. Clinton, Davenport West and Freeport rounded out the six girls squads. It was Bettendorf's Dan-

nelle Robinson who took the girls individual title with a time of 12:33, for the 2-mile course.

"We ran well and I was pleased," said Geneseo coach Don Fredericks.

Jason VanVooren also cracked the top five for Geneseo, notching a time of 15:34 which was good enough for fifth place ahead of teammate Mike Haars who was three seconds behind at 15:37. Tim Moran, Heath Lowe, Brad Baker and Barry Bassler were the other Geneseo placers.

Orion's best runner on the day turned out to be Pete Knox, who took 13th place with a 16:06 mark. Sherrard's Clint Weber wound up 14th with a time of 16:12.

In girls action the Maple Leafs got a consistent performance from its entire team. Karmen Roehrs finished seventh at 13:18, one second behind Gradert, and Kim Chapman, Renee Clifton and Kirstin Kemmis notched 13th, 14th and 16th places respectively.
