

Geneseo runners win quad

To say Geneseo cross country coach Don Fredericks has things looking up for the Maple Leafs is like saying Joe Biden's political career has turned into a fiasco.

There's no doubt about it.

The Maple Leafs pulled into Spring Creek Thursday in two team buses and were accompanied by two coaches, five team statisticians and over 40 runners.


"They're in a class by themselves right now in our conference," said L-P coach John Carls, after Geneseo won a quadrangular over the Cavaliers, Sterling and Streator.

Geneseo, led by individual winner Phil Walsh, tallied 22 points to defeat Sterling (53), L-P (61) and Streator (115).

Walsh won the 2.75-mile race in 14:58, and was followed by Sterling's Chris Wilkinson (15:02), Geneseo's Jon Baker (15:04) and L-P's Carlos Almaraz, who took fourth in 15:21.

"Carlos (Almaraz) is just a sophomore and to be running up there with Walsh and Wilkinson is very good for him," Carls said. "He showed some improvement today and that's all we're looking for at this point."

Other top L-P finishers were Carlos' brother, Javier, a freshman, who finished 11th in 16:05; Kyle Kaszynski (14th in 16:21); Rob Magglo (16th in 16:42); Chuck McConnell (20th in 16:54); Mark LeRette (22nd in 17:08); and Lorenzo Espinoza (23rd in 17:09).

In the frosh-soph race, Geneseo took first with 16 points, followed by Sterling with 40.

L-P did not have enough runners for a team score. L-P's Eric Zack took fifth in 15:27 for 2.5 miles, while Brian Tumia placed 12th and Mark Whitfield finished 18th.

AT PRINCETON. Steve Schennum finished second in 16:42 to lead Princeton to a triangular meet win over Ottawa and Dixon at City County Park. Princeton had 38 points while Ottawa and Dixon finished with 43 and 47, respectively.

In addition to Schennum, Princeton's top finishers included Andy Morris (2nd), Mark Stephens (8th), E.J. Carter (8th), Jason Patterson (13th) and Rob Koger (15th).

Dixon's Rob Dowell was the meet's top finisher, as he covered the three-mile course in 16:37.

In girls action, Dixon clipped Princeton 24-31. Princeton's Jenny Faber finished first in 15:26. Princeton's other finishers included Mary Ellen Markea (4th), Lara Lickó (7th) and Melissa Beauprez (11th).

Princeton returns to action Saturday at the Dixon Invitational.

AT HALL. Jason Holbrook finished second in 15:01 over 2.6 miles to lead the host Red Devils to a 26-30 win over Mid-County.

Top finishers for the Red Devils included Ken Poole (3rd), Jim Stebbins (5th), Brian Tlemann (7th) and Scott Shilkuski (9th).

Geneseo may not have placed a runner until the seventh slot but it was all-around team effort that gave Geneseo the edge.

Brad Baker clocked in at seventh followed by Mike Haars in ninth, Jason VanVooren, 10th and Phil Walsh, 12th. Also running were Moran, 17th, Lowe, 35th and Morris, 47th.

Walsh again led his squad to victory in a cross country meet with Sterling, Streator and L-P at Spring Creek on Thursday, September 24. The Leafs scored 22 points to Sterling's 53, L-P's 61 and Streator's 115 points.

Walsh covered the 2.9 mile course in 14:58, for the top honor. The second-place finisher from Sterling clocked in at 15:02.

Baker held on to third place for the Leafs with a time of 15:04. The Leafs packed the field for fifth through eighth place. VanVooren took fifth in 15:24, followed by Haars, sixth, 15:28, Boardman, seventh, 15:43, and Moran, eighth, 15:46.

Heath Lowe took tenth in the field with a time of 16:04. Other finishers included Morris, 13th, 16:20; Bassler, 19th, 16:52; Shawn Alexander, 21st, 17:00; Conan Castelain, 24th, 17:13; Harmon, 26th, 17:58; Randy Kinkade, 28th, 18:23; Holveoet, 29th, 18:25; John Stone, 33rd, 18:47; Jon Marsh, 34th, 18:55; Mike Coleman, 37th, 19:33; and Brett Leslie, 41st, 20:11.

Frosh-soph harriers roll over opponents

A solid effort by the frosh-soph cross country team led the squad to a 16-46 victory over Sterling Thursday, September 24. A "well run race" also contributed to the lopsided victory Tuesday, September 29 over Pleasant Valley.

Pleasant Valley could only muster up three runners for Tuesday's two-mile race at Hidden Hills.

Brian Walsh led the Geneseo Leafrosh in the overwhelming victory, taking the tape in 11:57. Cubby Orwig clipped his heels, finishing second in 11:58. Justin VanVooren took third with a time of 12:17.

Pleasant Valley managed to catch just one spot in the top 10 for the race. Eric Gruhl timed in at 13:22 for an eighth place finish.

Geneseo packed the field with place finishers in fourth through seventh slots. In fourth was Mike Bell who clocked a 12:25 followed by fifth place finisher Jim Henderson, 12:34. Sixth place was given to Steve Campbell who clocked a 12:35 while Bryan Crawford's time of 13:10 earned him a seventh place finish.

Sterling, LaSalle-Peru and Streator made an effort to edge out the Leafrosh in Spring Creek on September 24. Geneseo scored 16 points to Sterling's 46 for the victory. Streator and LaSalle-Peru did not score.

The Leafrosh held tight to the first four slots in the field with Bryan Glass heading the pack. Glass took the 2.5 mile course tape in 14:38 with Jason Leigh right behind in 14:40. Orwig took third with a time of 15:02 while Walsh came in at a close fourth in 15:03.

VanVooren and Henderson kept close, taking seventh and eighth places, respectively. VanVooren crossed the line in 15:39 while Henderson clocked 15:45.
