

Combined Geneseo harrier squad wins Crystal Lake Invitational

CRYSTAL LAKE — Geneseo's cross country team honored coach Don Fredericks' return to his old stomping grounds by romping to victory in the Crystal Lake Invitational on Saturday, Sept. 24.

The meet's format included runs for varsity girls, and freshman, sophomore, junior and senior boys. The combined scores were added to determine the team total, thus a school's total program was tested.

Geneseo beat second-place Elmwood 416-664 for the team title.

Jason VanVooren grabbed an individual title for Geneseo, winning the

junior class boys race.

The Maple Leaf girls, rated 10th in the state in last week's poll, won their division, with Wendy Wassell leading the way with a fourth-place individual finish.

Geneseo's sophomore boys also won, getting a third-place finish from Bryan Glass.

The Leaf freshmen, junior and senior boys all finished third in their class races.

Geneseo harriers team up for co-ed invitational title

Geneseo's harriers dominated the field at the Crystal Lake Central co-ed invitational Saturday, September 24.

As a team Geneseo tallied 416 points for first place honors followed by Elmwood in second, 664 points. Other top five teams were Benet Academy, third, 732; Antioch, fourth, 736 and West Chicago, fifth, 834 points.

In individual class scoring the Lady Leafs placed first with 52 points. The sophomore boys squad also claimed first as a team for Geneseo, scoring 50.

Third place finishes were awarded to the freshmen boys team, junior varsity and varsity teams.

"We really came together as a team," Coach Don Fredericks stated. "There was some gutsy performances by each and everyone (of our runners)."

Once again the Geneseo harriers had early morning wake-up calls to head for the Chicago area meet. The bus left at 4 a.m. for the three-hour excursion.
