Moline, Geneseo win quadrangulars

Moline and Geneseo got the better of the fields at an early season matchup of Quad-City running powerhouses Tuesday at Credit Island Park in Davenport.

Moline swept the boys portion of the quadrangular that included Rock Island, Geneseo and Alleman, while the Geneseo girls proved themselves to be a tough team as they swept their meets in the same field.

At the flat Credit Island course for the first meeting of the Quad-City rivals, Mario Vesey of Rock Island and Moline's Eric Edmunds stole the boys' show. Vesey and Edmunds battled their way through the last 3/4 of the 2.97-mile course and Vesey ended up winning it down the stretch.

Vesey finished with a 15:40 clocking, while Edmunds crossed the finish line in 15:45. Moline's Rob Harvey, the third finisher, was well back at 16:27.

But Moline's balance out front was just too much. Behind Edmunds and Harvey, Moline had Joe Perez (16:40) in fourth, Cesar Lopez (16:50) in fifth and Tauwon Taylor (17:00) in ninth.

"We were packed pretty good until the two-mile mark," said Moline coach Jeff Quick. "The kids still ran a good race for the first outing."

Vesey proved he could be the top Q-C cross country runner this season.

"He went out and ran the type of race you expect a kid with his talent and experience to run," said Rocky coach John Coolidge. "To win the opener against a quality field has to help him immensely."

And Vesey was about the only bright spot for the Rocks as they placed no other runner in the top 15.

Geneseo, on the other hand, placed all five of its runners in the top 14. Jason VanVooren led the Maple Leafs with a 16:44 clocking that placed him fifth overall.

Sophomore Jerome Reyes led Alleman with an 11th place finish with a time of 17:17.

In the girls' race, there was no surprise with Geneseo easily winning. But Quick got a big surprise from his Moline girls that finished a close second.

"The girls really answered some major questions we had," said Quick. "I think if they run like this all year, they can be competitive against just about anybody."

Moline senior Jane Johnson proved she could compete with anybody as she went wire-to-wire with Geneseo's Wendy Wassell before out-kicking the Leaf senior in the final 50 meters. Johnson's winning time was 13:31, while Wassell finished at 13:39.

But the Geneseo girls — running without their top two runners — duplicated Moline's boys as they placed all five runners in the top 10. Kristen Kemmis (13:54) was third, Brandy Hilton (13:59) fourth, Renee Clifton (14:03) fifth and Kim Chapman (14:15) eighth.

Priscilla Perez was the highest Rocky finisher as her 14:17 time carried her to ninth place, while Kristen Lelonek (16:29) led Alleman with a 28th-place finish.
