

Harriers place second at Crystal Lake co-ed meet

Geneseo's varsity boys and girls cross country teams combined to place a solid second in the Crystal Lake Co-ed Invitational meet held Saturday, September 23.

The boys ran freshman, sophomore, junior and senior races while the girls ran just one race. Scores were combined from each race to come up with the final team totals.

Benet Academy placed first with 525 points followed by Geneseo (546), Antioch (698), Elmwood Park (709), West Chicago (770), Kaneland (834), Hinsdale South (1010), Crystal Lake Central (1025), Stevenson (1251), Harvard (1274), Grant (1387), Johnsburg (1412), Deerfield (1419), Riverside-Brookfield (1431), Waukegan East (1435) and Mundelein (1471).

The Geneseo girls, with 69 points and the freshmen boys, with 35 points, placed first in their divisions. The junior boys were second with 56 points, the senior boys were fifth with 152 points and the sophomore boys were ninth with 234 points.

In the girls race, Wendy Wassell was fourth overall followed by Karmen Roehrs (10th), Kirstin Kemmis (13th), Suzanne Patton (17th), Renee Clifton (25th), Jenny Wurslin (56th) and Julie Ghys (67th).

Competing for the freshmen boys were Andy Snook (2nd), Alan Sand (3rd), Bill Loftus (4th), Scott Durian (9th), Kris Keegan (15th), Chris Kutsunis (45th) and Yarger (67th).

The second place junior boys were comprised of Bryan Glass (3rd), Adam Boardman (4th), Justin VanVooren (11th), Travis Stroh (18th), Neil Radicic (20th), Martin (39th) and Shane McKibbin (40th).

Competing for the senior boys were Jason VanVooren (2nd), Brian Walsh (9th), Justin VanOpdorp (29th) and Darin Henderson (51st).

Sophomore harriers competing in the meet were Chris Walters (16th), Micah Miller (49th), Matt Lotz (50th), George Stone (53rd) and Darin Lavery (66th).

"It was a very solid effort by the entire team. We're rounding into shape for the meets that we point towards at the end of the season," noted Coach Don Fredericks.

The Geneseo harriers also had a meet against Pleasant Valley on Tuesday, September 26 at Hidden Hills golf course.

Wassell won the girls race but the Lady Leafs were defeated by the Pleasant Valley girls 23-34.

There were no team scores in the boys varsity or frosh-soph races as Pleasant Valley did not field a full team in either.

Jason VanVooren captured the varsity boys race while Sand won the sophomore race.
