Maroons edge Leaf runners

GENESEO — Geneseo's boys hung in there, but Moline, the state's third-ranked cross country team, edged the Maple Leafs 25-34 in a battle of area powers Tuesday afternoon, Oct. 3, in Richmond Hill Park.

"Our top three ran great races, and Jason VanVooren (second place) and Adam Boardman (fourth), ran like all-stars," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said.

"Andy Snook, running in just his second race since elbow surgery, came on and was our No. 5 guy," Fredericks said.

Moline's girls, ranked eighth in the state, were 19-43 winners over the Lady Leafs, who are hampered by lack of numbers. Five Geneseo girls competed in the race.

Wendy Wassell took a second place for the Leafs, behind a great Moline runner, Trista Lester.

"Wendy ran a courageous race," Fredericks said.

Geneseo won at the frosh-soph boys level as Moline, running right with the Leafs otherwise, was unable to field a fifth runner. Five are needed for team scoring purposes.
