

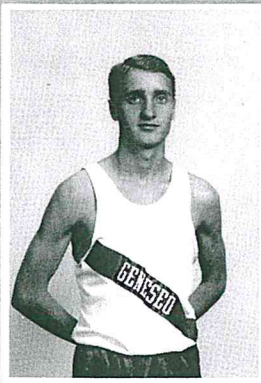
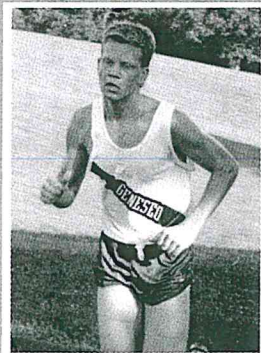
CROSS COUNTRY

Senior, Brian Glass finished 17th in the state run and was named All-State. Andy Snook, Sophomore just missed All-State by three points.

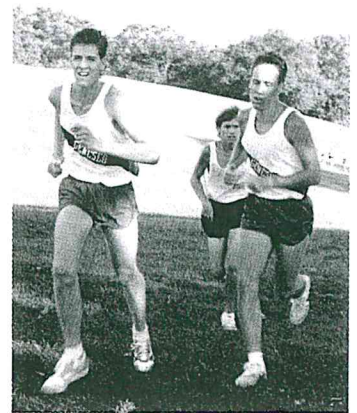
Adam Boardman was named the team's Captain.

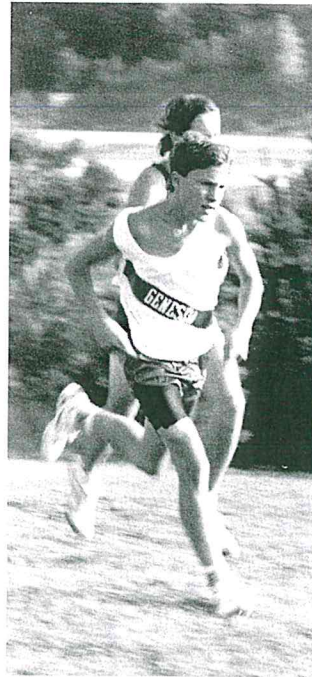
