Windy, Snook pace cross- country squads

Kristy Windy and Andy Snook each posted individual victories as the Geneseo girls and boys cross-country teams fared well in a meet against Alleman, Rock Falls and Sherrard Tuesday, September 10 at Richmond Hill park.

The Lady Leafs earned a 24-35 victory over Alleman. Sherrard and Rock Falls did not field girls teams.

Windy's winning time over the 2.0 mile Geneseo course was 13:14. Also competing for Geneseo, as well as their times, were Dawn Yarger (13:51, third), Angie Smith (14:30, fifth), DeeAnn Olson (14:36, seventh), Mindy Patten (14:39, eighth), Sara Terronez (14:45, ninth), Becky Grier (14:47, tenth), Noel Myers (15:03, 12th), Jenny Wurslin (15:08, 13th), Amy Ghys (15:29, 15th), Tracy Brewer (15:34, 17th), Lea Nissen (15:40, 20th), Lynn Zwica (16:35, 24th), Julie Upchurch (16:48, 26th), Sarah Williamsen (18:56, 30th) and Chrissy Kanke (20:05, 32nd).

The Geneseo varsity boys, paced by Snook's winning time of 14:34 over the three-mile Geneseo course, topped Alleman 24-32, Rock Falls 23-34 and Sherrard 16-45.

Snook was followed by teammates Josh Pierce (15:08, third), Karl Taets (15:31, fifth), Andy Snyder (15:56, 10th), Ryan Carter (16:19, 14th), Chris Pobanz (16:31, 15th), Scott Durian (17:10, 20th), Ben Hahn (17:18, 21st), Darin Lavery (17:26, 22nd), Chris Walters (17:46, 27th), Dave Farmer (17:50, 28th), Jeff Patchin (19:35, 32nd), Chad Weinzierl (20:21, 36th), Jarrett Bernahl (20:33, 37th), Chris Miner (20:46, 39th) and Todd Gilbert (20:48, 40th).

The frosh-soph boys team, paced by Eric Misfeldt's victory, earned a win over Sherrard (17-38) but fell to Alleman (23-32). Rock Falls did not field a frosh-soph boys team.

Misfeldt, who was clocked at 11:35, was followed by teammates Josh Inch (12:01, fifth), Adam Radicic (12:40, seventh), Joe Loftus (13:00, ninth) and Derek Betcher (14:23, 12th).

The Geneseo boys and girls teams sent split squads to meets Tuesday, September 3 at Emels Park in Davenport and Thursday, September 5 at Johnson Sauk Trail Park, Kewanee.

The Geneseo girls topped Sherrard 14-24 but lost to Davenport West 17-20 in the Tuesday, September 3 meet in Davenport.

Lady Leaf runners were Orier (15:02, third), Smith (15:08, fourth), Meyers (15:27, eighth), Terronez (15:43, ninth), Wurslin (16:01, tenth), Ghys (16:21, 12th), Brewer (16:41, 13th), Nissen (17:45, 16th), Upchurch (20:16, 17th) and Kanke (22:35, 20th).

The varsity boys squad earned victories over West (24-31) and Sherrard (22-33).

Pierce finished second overall with a time of 17:59. He was followed by Mitch Pray (18:07, third), Snyder (18:41, fifth), Durian (19:51, 10th), Walters (20:03, 11th), Chad Sager (21:59, 20th) and Patchin (22:41, 21st).

In the boys reserve race, Misfeldt placed first with a time of 19:39. Also competing for Geneseo were Weinzierl (24:07, 12th) and Miner (25:16, 15th).

On Thursday, September 5 a second Geneseo split team went to Kewanee for a meet against the host Boilermakers, Ottawa, Streator and Rock Falls.

The Geneseo girls topped Ottawa 24-31 but fell to Kewanee 25-30. Rock Falls and Streator did not field girls teams.

Windy finished second overall with a time of 15:06. She was followed by Yarger (16:01, sixth), Stanciliff (16:41, ninth), Patten (17:07, 11th), Olson (17:11, 12th), Zwica 19:05, 16th) and Williamsen (21:51, 25th).

The Geneseo varsity boys, behind Snook's second place overall finish, topped Ottawa 24-31, Kewanee 23-32 and Streator 19-38 but fell to Rock Falls 26-31.

Snook was clocked at 15:07. He was followed by Taets (16:01, fourth), Carter (16:20, sixth), Hahn (17:38, 18th), Farmer (17:57, 22nd), Lavery (18:59, 27th), Bernahl (20:13, 34th) and Gilbert (21:26, 39th).

Geneseo and Ottawa were the only two teams to field frosh-soph boys teams and the Leaflets gained a 19-36 win.

Pobanz was the overall winner with a time of 13:57. He was followed by Inch (14:19, second), Radicic (14:37, third), Joe Loftus (15:44, sixth) and Betcher (16:18, ninth).

The Leafs and Lady Leafs will host Dixon and UT for a triangular meet Tuesday, September 17. It will start at 4:30 p.m.

Geneseo boys win twice

Geneseo junior Josh Pierce led the Maple Leafs to a 2-0 start with a second-place finish as they beat Davenport West and Sherrard at the West Triangular at Emels Park on Tuesday.
