Snyder, Anderson finish one-two

Lady Leafs take second; Reade is 2nd

Geneseo boys cross country team claimed its ninth consecutive conference title at the NCIC meet Saturday, October 16.

The girls squad claimed second place, being edged out the second year in a row by Sterling.

Kishwaukee Junior College near Malta was the sight for this year's NCIC Cross Country tournament. Rochelle Township High School served as hosts.

The boys claimed their ninth consecutive conference championship easily over second place Rock Falls. Geneseo tallied just 31 points while Rock Falls edged out Sterling 75-77. Other teams fielding harriers were Mendota (122), Dixon (138), Kewanee (148), Ottawa (183), Rochelle (195) and Princeton (202).

Andy Snyder placed second for the field, first for the Leafs, with a time of 15:45 and was named to the All-Conference team.

Todd Moroney of Rock Falls set a new course record, covering the 2.9-mile course in 15:22 for first place.

Snyder was followed over the finish line by fellow Leaf Eric Anderson who clocked in at 15:52. Two Sterling runners rounded out the top five positions.

Chris Pobanz (16:10) and Eric Misfeldt (16:13) placed sixth and eighth, respectively, for the field.

The top 15 places in the conference meet are awarded All-Conference honors. Anderson and Pobanz received second All-Conference awards while Snyder earned third All-Conference recognition.

Other runners for Geneseo were Josh Inch (12th, 16:26), Ryan Carter (15th, 16:53) and Jeremy Michels (16th, 16:56).

The girls team took second behind Sterling, 24-43. Other teams competing were Rochelle (85), Dixon (116), Princeton (130), Kewanee (151) and Rock Falls (209).

Despite the slow, wet course, yet another new record was set. Sterling's Jennye Lawrence took the tape in 15:01 to claim the new title for the 2.35-mile course.

Molly Reade (15:14) finished third, 13 seconds in back of two leaders, Sterling's Lawrence and Leslie Edmonton, 15:02.

Dawn Yarger (15:49) and Kristy Windy (15:52) took ninth and tenth for the field. Also running for the

Lady Leafs were Mindy Patten (12th, 16:02), Mary Stancliff (13th, 16:05), Sara Rutledge (16th, 16:31) and Angie Smith (17th, 16:35).

The top 15 places are named to the All-Conference team. Windy was given the fourth All-Conference award while Yarger, Patten and Stancliff each received third All-Conference awards.

In the frosh/soph race, Geneseo (74) placed third behind Princeton (46) and Kewanee (58).

Steve Thompson set a course record for the 2.35-mile course, taking the tape in 13:07. Princeton dominated the top five positions, taking three, while Kewanee claimed the other two slots.

Chris Farmer and Jared Thompson finished ninth and tenth overall and earned All-Conference honors. They were the first two finishers for the Leafrosh. C. Farmer covered the course in 14:04 while J. Thompson completed it in 14:06.

Jeremy Brown (17th, 14:32), David Cryder (18th, 14:33), Shane Nordstrom (22th, 14:50), Doug Patchin (26th, 15:03) and Jason Farmer (40th, 16:16) all participated for Geneseo.

Before the conference meet, Geneseo took part in the Sterling Invitational on Saturday, October 9.

The varsity boys finished in sixth place out of ten teams. Conant claimed the title with 57 points. The top five teams were Iowa City High (70), Oswego (118), Schaumburg (133) and Rockford Jefferson (204).

Dean Shaw of Oswego took the tape for the top spot with a time of 15:44 for the 3.0-mile course.

Andy Snyder was the first Geneseo runner to cross the finish line followed by Eric Anderson, Chris Pobanz, Josh Inch, Eric Misfeldt, Jeremy Michels and Joe Loftus. Their times were Snyder (16:17, 23rd overall), Anderson (16:19, 26th), C. Pobanz (16:56, 48th), Inch (17:13, 55th), Misfeldt (17:14, 56th), Michels (17:16, 61st) and Loftus (17:41, 79th).

Geneseo's varsity girls finished ninth overall with a team score of 234. Schaumburg took first with 47 points; Iowa City High, second, 66 points; Conant, third, 135; Belvidere, fourth, 136; Pleasant Valley, fifth, 136; Sterling, sixth, 154; Rock Island, seventh, 169; and Sycamore, eighth, 217. Tenth place was taken by UT, 267.

Molly Reade was first on her team followed by Kristy Windy, Dawn Yarger, Mindy Patten, Mary Stancliff, Sara Rutledge and Jenny Terronez. Times were Reade, 23rd, 13:08; Windy, 43rd, 13:40; Yarger, 50th, 13:52; Patten, 13:58; Stancliff, 14:09; Rutledge, 14:26 and Terronez, 15:05.

Varnett of Iowa City High was the first place finisher of the 2.1-mile course with a time of 12:15.

The frosh/soph boys finished 12th in the invite with 297 points. Iowa City took the crown with 52 points followed by Conant, 111, Pleasant Valley, 112, Oswego, 142 and UT, 183.

Chris Farmer crossed the finish line first for the Leafrosh and 35th overall with his time of 12:06. Rockford East's Jeremy Demarb took first with a time of 11:17.

Others that finished for Geneseo were Jared Thompson (12:11), David Cryder (12:45), Jeremy Brown (12:51), Shane Nordstrom (12:59), Doug Patchin (13:27) and Jason Farmer (14:45).

The JV girls also ran in the meet with no team scores kept. Kris Hain of Iowa City placed first in 13:34.

Lady Leafrosh harriers included Angie Smith (19th, 14:23), Sara Verplaetse (20th, 14:23), Amy Gibson (23rd, 14:29), Sara Terronez (28th, 14:44), Katie Lavery (32nd, 14:51), Molly Patten (37th, 14:55), Amy Ghys (15:27) and Anamika Holke (16:19).
