Maroons cruise to boys title

■ Rocks are 8th at Belvidere event

BELVIDERE, Ill. — For the fourth time in six years, Moline won the boys sectional cross country meet.

Jamie Verstraete's seventh-place finish led the Maroons, who used a strong team effort to score 99 points Saturday at the boys Class AA sectional cross country meet at Belvidere High School.

Peoria Richwoods finished second with 141 points. The top five teams qualify for state.

Rock Island was eighth, while Geneseo and Galesburg were 12th

and 20th, respectively.

Verstraete finished with a time of 15 minutes, 52 seconds, but teammates Greg McMahill (22nd), Chad Pankey (25), Jeff Adams (27), and John Blomgren were separated by only 44 seconds.

"Basically, we have a very strong team," Moline Coach Jeff Quick. "We have depth throughout and that helped us. Jamie was as high as third and ended seventh. We just try to follow him. If we stay close to him, we win in most cases. Our team is at our best if we keep contact with one another."

Verstraete was the only state qualifier a year ago for Moline, who won sectional titles in 1988, 1989, 1991 and 1993.

"We expected to win," Quick said. "All the kids have been work-

ing for this. Last year only Jamie went to state. I'd much rather have it this way. These seven seniors have been together for four years."

Brad Wilson's fifth-place finish led Rock Island, which had three runners in the top 20. Wilson, Rock Island's lone state qualifier, had a time of 15:40, while John Hutton and Brett Loy were 18th and 19th, respectively.

"Brad Wilson, John Hutton and Brett Loy were all in the top 20 and that is a pretty big feat," Rock Island Coach Dave Archibald said. "Our three guys finished in front of the second man from all of the teams qualifying for state. That's how great a performance it was."

Rocks take 4th in sectional meet

BELVIDERE, Ill. — Tasha Esparaza and Jen Wilson's top-10 finishes helped Rock Island to a fourth-place finish Saturday at the girls Class AA sectional cross country meet at Belvidere High School.

It was only the second time in the last 15 years that Rock Island has qualified its entire team for the state meet.

"It's quite an accomplishment," Rock Island Coach Bob Wilson said. "The kids have been running

real well in practice. We thought we had a real legitimate shot at qualifying. We ran solid races and did what we had to do."

Lincoln Way won the team title with 97 points, followed by Sterling (98), Pekin (128), Rock Island (145) and Peoria Richwoods (179). The top five teams advance to state.

Geneseo was 10th, while Moline and United Township were 13th and 14th, respectively.

Esparaza was fifth in 12 minutes, 54 seconds, while Wilson

finished seventh in 12:58.

Rock Island was without No. 3 runner Amber Peterson, who has a strained Achilles' tendon.

While Rock Island was the lone area team to have state qualifiers, other teams had respectable finishes.

Geneseo's Molly Reade was 26th with a time of 13:32, while Moline's Janelle Goldstone (38th) finished in 13:43. United Township's top runner was Liz Haney, who was 44th in a time of 13:50.

Moline boys win sectional CC title

BELVIDERE — The Moline boys and Rock Island girls cross country teams can now book their reservations to Saturday's 1993 IHSA State Meet in Peoria.

The Maroons earned their trip to Detweiller Park by demolishing the rest of the 20-team field at Saturday's Class AA Belvidere Sectional, scoring 99 points. Runner-up Peoria Richwoods had 141.

The Rocky girls, meanwhile, rode top 10 finishes by their dynamic duo of Tasha Esparza (fifth, 12:54 on the 2.1-mile course) and Western Big 6 individual champ Jen Wilson (seventh, 12:58) to a fourth-place team finish with 145 points.

New Lenox Lincoln-Way won the girls team title with 97 points, edging out second-place Sterling by a point. Pekin was third with 128 points ahead of the Rocks.

Individually, East Peoria scored a sweep as Tim Broe won the boys race in a time of 15:13, while Jenelle Deatherage destroyed the field in the girls competition, cruising to first in a time of 12:24.

Of the other local teams, only the Rock Island boys could advance a runner on to state, that being Brad Wilson with a fifth-place, 15:37 finish on the 3-mile course. The Geneseo boys took 12th with 260 points, while United Township's lone boys runner, Dan Walker, was 52nd.

In the girls' race, Geneseo was out of the money in 10th place, scoring 255 points. Moline was 13th with 307 points, 10 ahead of 14th-place UTHS.

One more step

With Saturday's crushing victory on a frigid day at Belvidere High School, the Maroons are one meet away from what they've worked for since Day 1 -- a top-three state finish.

"The only time these guys will be satisfied is when they have a state medal around their necks," said Moline coach Jeff Quick. "If they don't get a medal, then they'll be upset."

Senior Jamie Verstraete, who led Moline with a seventh-place, 15:52 clocking, expressed the confidence of his

teammates and himself.

"We were expecting to get first coming in after getting first the last couple of weeks," said Verstraete, referring to the Maroons' victories at the Western Big 6 and Freeport Regional meets.

Greg McMahon followed in 22nd place, while Chad Pankey finished 25th for the Maroons, who dethroned Rockford Guilford for the sectional crown.

While Wilson will advance for Rock Island, John Hutton and Brett Loy weren't as fortunate despite strong outings. Hutton took 18th place and Loy 19th to miss out on a state trip.

"They were ahead of a lot of qualifying teams' second runners," said Rock Island coach Dave Archibald of Hutton and Loy. "They both gave great efforts."

Geneseo's highest-ranking runner was Andy Snyder, who finished in 36th place with a time of 16:38.

Historic occasion

Rock Island girls coach Bob Wilson spared no enthusiasm in describing his team's trip to state, only the second in 15 years for the Rocky girls.

"This is an historic occasion, one these kids should be proud of," said the Rocky coach. "We were running without our No. 3 runner (Amber Peterson, pulled achilles tendon) but the rest of the team sucked it up and did great."

"As for state, realistically, we could be in the top 15. That would be an accomplishment. Anything more than that would be wonderful."

Among teams not advancing, Molly Reade led the Lady Leafs with a 26th-place effort, while Janelle Goldstone took 38th to pace Moline.

Liz Haney was United Township's top runner, coming in 44th.
