

Moline harriers set for final step

Ready to take that last step.

That describes the attitude of the Moline boys cross country team, which has a lot of quiet confidence and a recent sectional championship under its belt.

On Saturday, Moline will reach the last step when it competes in the 1993 Class AA State Meet at Detweiller Park in Peoria.

This group of Maroons is hungry. Very hungry, and coach Jeff Quick plans to see to it they don't lose any of their hunger.

"This is the last meet; they'd better be ready to run," said Quick of his Maroons, ranked third in Class AA. "This meet is what they've been pointing to all year."

For Bob Wilson and his Rock Island girls squad, however, they're happy just to be at Detweiller Saturday.

"A realistic goal for us is to finish in the top 15," said Coach Wilson. "Anything beyond that would be wonderful."

Carrying the Rock Island banner in the boys race will be senior Brad Wilson, who advanced with a fifth-place individual finish at last Saturday's Belvidere Sectional.

Although Wilson's teammates won't be competing in the race, they'll be there to lend plenty of support.

"I know they're all going down Friday, and I'm happy they'll be there to support me," said Wilson, who hit the chute at Belvidere with a time of 15:40.

Come Saturday, Wilson, the Western Big 6 runner-up and Freeport Regional champ, has his eyes set on a top 10 finish.

Quick is glad his team is

past sectionals.

"It's always a big relief to know that you've qualified for state," he said. "So many things can happen at sectionals. We learned about that last year."

In last year's sectional, Moline's state hopes were upended when Greg McMehill, then a junior, was tripped on the course. He went to the ground and so did the Maroons' state hopes.

"We've been on a crusade ever since that day," said Quick, whose squad certainly proved that at Belvidere, crushing the field with 99 points. Second-place Peoria Richwoods had 141 points.

"Our juniors that day knew they had one more shot."


Moline will put an all-senior lineup on the Detweiller course. Leading the way is Jamie Verstraete, this year's Western Big 6 champion. Following is Chad Pankey, John Roehr, Jeff Adams, John Blomgren, McMehill and Chris Quick.

"Jamie didn't like to run by himself last year," Quick said. "He wants to make sure we're one of the last ones up at the awards ceremony, which means getting a team trophy."

Leading the Rocky girls' charge will be juniors Jen Wilson and Tasha Esparza, who finished 1-2 at the Big 6 meet and the Freeport Regional. At Belvidere, Esparza finished fifth while Wilson took seventh.

Also running will be talented freshman Amber Peterson, who looks to be on the road to recovery from an Achilles tendon injury suffered at the Big 6 meet.

Rounding out the Rocky lineup are freshmen Tammy Vesey and Tiffany Hagen, se-

Verstraete leads Moline to 5th place

Rocks' Wilson to 9th

PEORIA, Ill. — Moline, Rock Island, and Rock Island Alleman each had a runner receive all-state honors Saturday at the state cross country meet at Detweiller Park.

Rock Island's Brad Wilson and Moline's Jamie Verstraete each earned a top 10 finish Saturday in the Class AA boys 3-mile race, while Alleman's Al Esperaza was 16th in the Class A race.

Moline, which qualified its team after last week's sectional championship, earned fifth place in the team standings.

Verstraete, who was sixth a year ago and 18th in 1991, finished 10th with a time of 14 minutes, 58 seconds. Teammates John Roehr and Chad Pankey came in 29th and 77th, respectively, to lead the Maroons.

"I'm not happy after getting sixth last year," Verstraete said. "I wanted to get top five. I was 30th at the mile and that's not a good thing to do in the state meet. At about the one-and-a-half marker, I got up to the pack for third place. With 100 to go I was in sixth place. I started sprinting, but it wasn't fast enough."

Moline's other runners were Greg McMahill (118th), Jeff Adams (127th), John Blomgren (183rd), Chris Quick (200th). The top five runners' places are used for the team standings.

"It was a very fast race, faster than we expected," Moline Coach Jeff Quick said. "Jamie set a 10-second p.r. (personal record). He was way faster than last year. John Roehr ran a fantastic race. Our top three guys got a real good start. We've had good depth all year, but today a couple of guys got caught in the excitement and pressure."

Wilson, Rock Island's only runner, finished ninth with a time of 14:58.

"My goal was to get in the top 10," Wilson said. "After two miles, I dropped back to 12th or 13th. I got a spurt of energy and passed a pack of guys. I know they didn't slow down, I just had more energy to pass them."

Esparaza ran his best race with a time of 15:33 to lead the Pioneers, who finished seventh in the Class A team standings.

"It was right where I expected," Esperaza said. "It was a perfect race. After the first mile, I was in the thirties. I just followed the lead pack and stayed within 5-10 yards. As I stayed with the pack some-

Alleman girl finishes 17th

PEORIA, Ill. — Rock Island Alleman's Kim Hills earned all-state honors for the third time Saturday at the Class A girls cross country state meet at Detweiller Park.

Hills finished 17th with a time of 13 minutes. She had finished 23rd last year and 20th in 1990.

"I would've liked to be in the top 15, but anything in the top 25 I'm happy with," Hills said.

Hills was about 35th before moving up in the 2.1-mile race.

"I hate to start too fast," Hills said. "After the first mile I was 25th. I gradually picked it up and kept on going. The weather didn't bother me."

Sterling Newman's Shelley Schaefer also earned all-state honors with a 19th-place time of 13:00. Sherrard's Amanda Johnson was 40th.

Rock Island, which qualified its team after last week's sectional, was 20th in the Class AA team standings.

Tasha Esperaza and Jen Wilson led the Rocks by finishing in 49th and 54th places, respectively, in the Class AA race. Esperaza had a time of 12:35, while Wilson finished in 12:36.

"There was great competition," Rock Island Coach Bob Wilson said. "Tasha ran only two seconds slower than last year when she was 22nd. It was really tough. Jen and Tasha had excellent runs. They ran a fast first mile. They were aggressive and went after it, but the competition was tough."

Moline fifth in state run

R.I.'s Wilson 9th;
Alleman's Esparza
finishes in 16th

PEORIA — After finishing in fifth place in the State of Illinois, you'd think Moline cross-country coach Jeff Quick and his Maroons would be pleased.

Not quite.

"The guys are down. Way down," said Quick, whose squad scored 253 points. "It's disappointing, but any time you're fifth in the state, you have to be happy with that."

While Moline was finishing fifth in Saturday's IHSA Class AA Boys State Meet on a cold, snowy afternoon at Peoria's Detweiller Park, Elmhurst York rolled to its fifth consecutive Class AA title with 137 points.

Tim Broe of East Peoria beat out Peoria Notre Dame's Adam White by nine seconds for the AA individual title. Broe registered a 14:22 clocking, while White finished with a time of 14:31.

Moline senior Jamie Verstraete was the sole All-State finisher for the Maroons, ranked third in the latest Class AA poll. Verstraete finished 10th with a time of 14:58.

In the Class A competition, Alleman received an All-State effort from senior Al Esparza en route to a seventh-place team finish, scoring 243 points. Normal University won the team title with 72 points.

Westmont's Chris Bailey won the Class A individual title, posting a time of 14:55.

The highest finish by any Quad-City individual Saturday came in the Class AA boys race, where Brad Wilson of Rock Island beat Verstraete to the tape for ninth place, posting a time of 14:58.

"I knew I had a good possibility to finish in the top 10 today," Wilson said. "The weather wasn't a factor at all. On the warm-up, I thought it might be slippery, but once I got my spikes on, there was no problem."

"I was a little bit nervous, but once I got up to the starting line, it all went away. I sort of got caught up in the meet."

Moline's Verstraete admitted to feeling more than a slight case of the jitters prior to the meet.

"I was scared before the meet; I felt scared nearly all week," said Verstraete. "I really just wanted to go out and race and get it over with. I was happy with my time today though."

Missing out on All-State honors was Moline's John Roehr, who finished 29th with a time of 15:18. Chad Pankey was 77th, followed by Greg McMehill (118th), Jeff Adams (127th), John Blomgren (183rd) and Chris Quick (200th).

"We're pleased with fifth, but we feel we could have been better," said Coach Quick. "However, there are only four teams in the state better than us. Not too many can claim that."

Alleman coach Joe Lopez will gladly take his team's seventh-place effort, however.

"I was just hoping we'd be in the top seven, because there are some very, very tough teams here," said Lopez. "We didn't have a good enough push from our younger runners in the back of the pack, but a race like this is a good experience for them."

"All the kids were relaxed, and this was Al's best race."

"I ended up right where I expected," said Esparza, who captured his first All-State berth with Saturday's performance. "I had a good pack to follow. It was a perfect race for me."

After Esparza, Bill Hawley finished 33rd with a time of 15:56, followed by 57th-place finisher Marc Dalmasso, who posted a time of 16:19.
