

Harriers split meet

Lady Leafs win, Leafs fall to Moline in meet

The Lady Leafs raised their record to 11-1 on the season with an impressive 17 to 42 win over Moline Tuesday afternoon at Richmond Hill Park.

With Natalie Myers out for the season with a stress fracture, several other Lady Leafs will have to step up, according to Coach Mel Snook.

Molly Reade stepped up big to win the race by over a minute with a time of 12:54 on the 2.0-mile course.

Geneseo swept the top three spots and six of the top seven as Sara Rutledge and Sara Verplaetse took second and third.

Rutledge, returning from a pulled muscle, came across the line in 13:58 while Rutledge timed in at 14:07.

"It's good to have Sara Rutledge back," commented Coach Snook. "Some other girls didn't compete because of injuries. We still have some people dinged up. We're not 100 percent."

Nikki Parker was fifth with a time of 14:17, followed closely by Molly

Patten in sixth in 14:18 and Jill Hinrichs in seventh in 14:24.

Geneseo took home 13th through 20th place after Moline took eighth through 12th.

Finishing the race were Amy Schneider (13th in 14:57), Kate Altermatt (14th in 15:05), Anamika Holke (15th in 15:44), Becky Riewerts (16th in 16:17), Jenny Grier (17th in 16:26), Kari Voight (18th in 18:26), Jenny Beyerlein (19th in 19:29) and Heather Phelps (20th in 22:08).

The varsity boys team had their record drop to 9-3 on the season as Moline raced past them, 20 to 36.

"The guys ran very well," said Coach Snook. "Moline has a very good team."

Justin Fluck was the highest finisher for Geneseo, crossing the line in 17:38 in third place on the 3.0-mile course.

Chris Studer was fifth in 18:02 while Jason Gray and Mark Keplinger were eighth and ninth, respectively, to round out Geneseo's entrants in the top 10.

Gray crossed the line with a time of 18:24 while Keplinger had a time of 18:36.

Also competing were David Cryder (11th in 19:21), Adam Forest (12th in 19:40), Chris Farmer (14th in 20:02), Ben Forest (15th in 20:14), Doug Patchin (16th in 20:53), Jeremy Brown (17th in 21:10) and Adam Fleming (20th in 22:21).

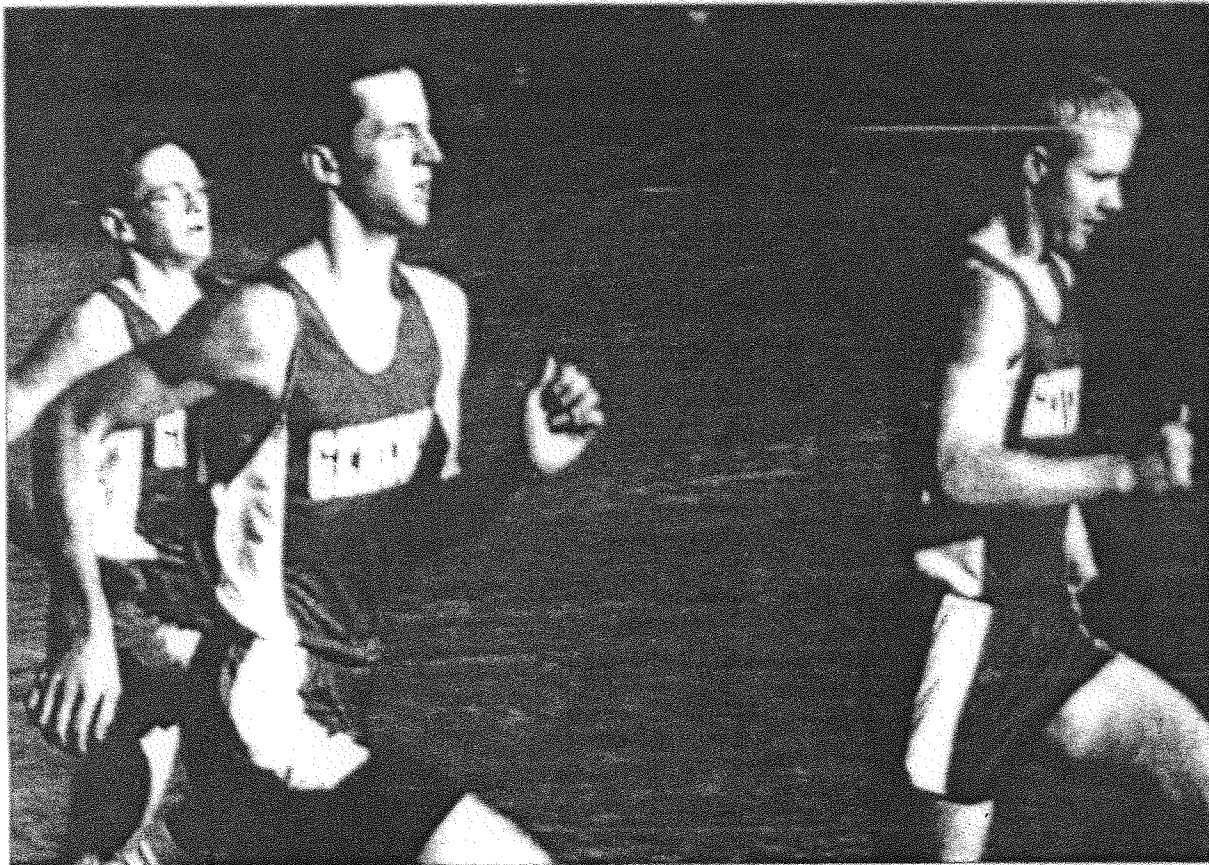
"We're running a little tired right now," commented Coach Snook. "We will start tapering off next week to get ready for conference and regionals."

The frosh-soph Leaflets also fell to Moline, 23 to 34, dropping their record to 6-6.

John Kiss placed second with a time of 11:52 in the 2.0-mile course, 12 seconds out of first place.

Also in the top 10 for Geneseo were Jeremy Sides (4th in 12:07), David Rutledge (seventh in 12:28) and Jared Anderson (10th in 13:07).

Also running were Josh Fleming (11th in 13:20), Bill Heitzler (13th in 13:47), Matt Sullivan (14th in 14:20) and Ryan Gillespie (16th in 15:51).



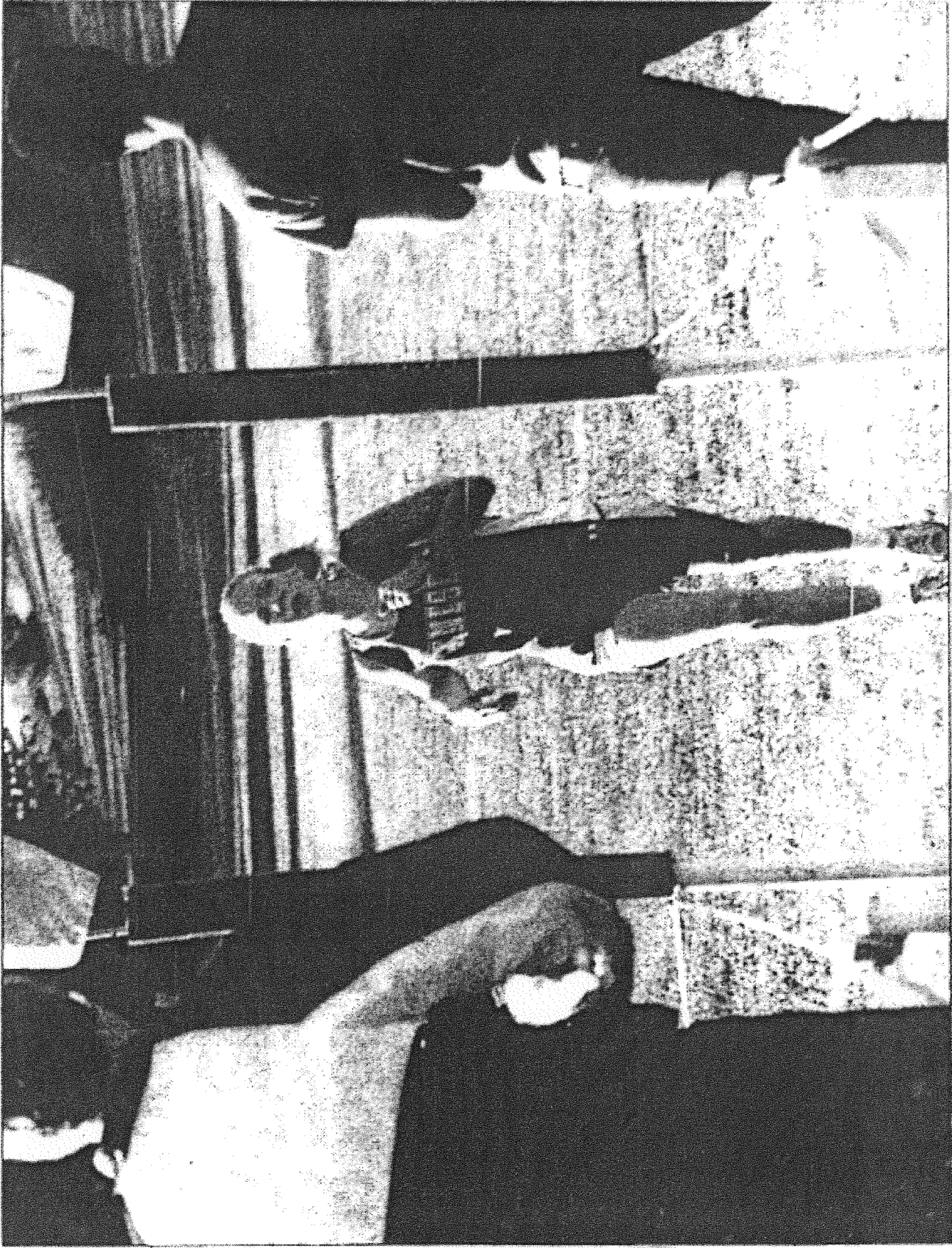

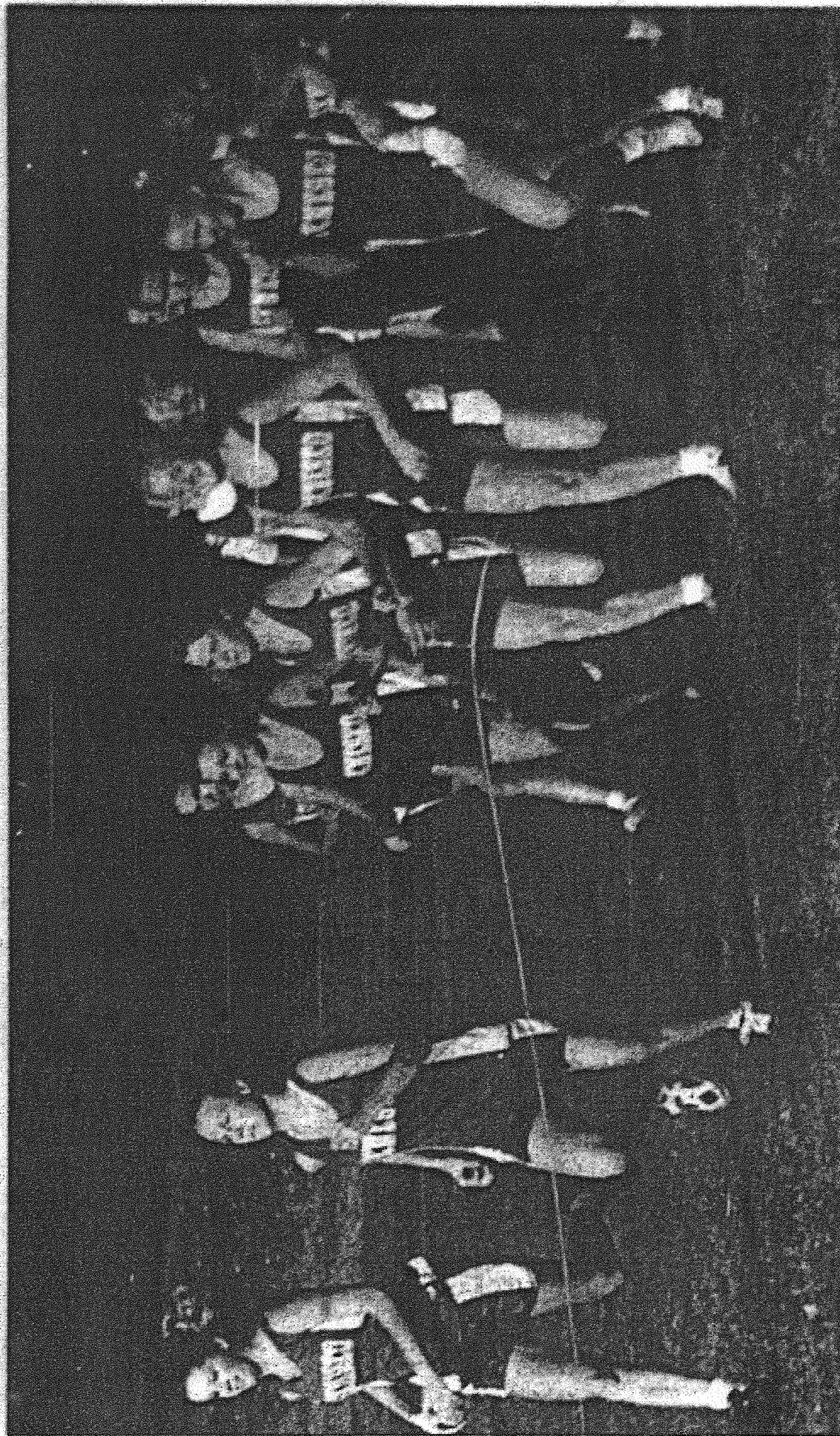
