Frosh Fluck misses state by nine seconds

It was a rough day for the Leaf and Lady Leaf cross country teams at the Rockford Guilford Sectional meet Saturday, October 28.

"It was a tough course," commented Coach Mel Snook. "It was very slick and about every turn was 90 degrees.

"The girls had to make a 180 degree turn 10 meters before the finish line. There was a lot of slowing down and speeding up."

Not only did the teams not qualify, Geneseo failed to advance any harriers to the state meet to be held on Saturday, November 4 in Peoria.

The boys team placed 15th out of 20 teams with a total of 407 points. In first place was Moline with 127 points.

The Lady Leafs were 19th out of 20 teams with 483 points. Metamora won the meet with 103 points.

Freshman sensation Justin Fluck missed qualifying for state by nine seconds with a time of 15:52. He finished in 19th place out of 157 runners.

"Justin ran his best time ever for a three-mile course," said Coach Snook. "He ran a tremendous race. He was three places from qualifying for state, which is the highest individual place-finish for a Geneseo freshman boy."

Also competing for the Leafs were Chris Studer (82nd in 17:02), Adam Forest (116th in 18:07), Jason Gray (125th with no time available), Chris Farmer (130th with NTA) and Ben Forest (147th with NTA).

In the girls race, Geneseo's highest finisher was Molly Reade, coming in 55th place out of 153 runners with a time of 15:25.

Other lady harriers were Sara Rutledge (120th in 17:02), Sara Verplaetse (121st in 17:02), Rhonda Loftus (132nd in 18:29), Jill Hinrichs (133rd in 18:31) and Nikki Parker (143rd with NTA).

"The girls were a little disappointed in their races," Coach Snook

replied. "The change of schedule may have thrown them off."

Coach Snook commented the boys race was run first for the first time all year.

"The course was all chewed up," he stated. "For those who think a golf course is easy to run on, their wrong."

Coach Snook is definitely looking forward to the future with his young crew.

"The younger kids did a really good job," he noted. "I am really looking forward to the future."

"We are only losing one out of our top seven in each squad (boys and girls). We will have Natalie Myers healthy and Nicki Rocha back, so it looks very bright for the future if the kids keep active. I see a big gain in Geneseo cross country."

Coach Snook also noted his two assistant coaches, who each brought different aspects to the team.

"I can't say enough about my other two coaches, Jon Murray and Don Fredericks," he replied. "Coach Murray was our strength coach and Coach Fredericks was great with the workouts."

"I hate the title 'head coach' because the three of us are all coaches. We all split the responsibilities."

Moline harriers pack for state

UT girls, Sherrod joining Maroon boys at Detweiller

ROCKFORD — The Moline boys cross country packed it in and then packed up for a trip to state.

Moline captured its fifth sectional crown in the past eight years, this time at the Class AA Rockford Guilford Sectional on a chilly and rainy Saturday.

And the Maroons qualified for state despite the fact that at first count, a ninth-spot finish in 15:42 by their top finisher, junior Eli Soliz, wasn't figured into the original team tallies.

Still, the Maroons won it going away on a rain-slicked Elliott Golf Course three-mile layout by totalling 127 points. That by far outdistanced Rockford Jefferson's 152 points.

Bloomington was third (158), Rockford East fourth (170) and Peoria Richwoods fifth (176).

Geneseo (15th), United Township (10th) and Rock Island (12th) did not qualify. The top five teams and seven individuals not on a qualifying squad advanced to next Saturday's state meet at Peoria's Detweiller Park.

"It was pretty rough out there and I hoped everybody (his teammates) was behind me, and it turned out they were," said Soliz about the Moline finish. "I think it was a pretty good race. We were pretty determined to win. We packed it in pretty good today. We had seven guys in front of Richwoods."

For UT coach Bob Feller, it turned out to be a bittersweet day as his girls squad placed

third to advance to state and Josh Sherrod (14th) qualified as an individual.

But two Panthers — Everett Casas and Larry Gant — just missed the cut and a trip to state.

In fact, Gant recorded the same time as Belvidere's Jeremy Denhoff, but was denied because of Denhoff being a split-second ahead of him in the chute. Both checked in at 15:43. Gant placed 17th and Casas 18th in a clocking of 15:48.

"I just don't feel too overly excited about today," said Feller. "Larry Gant and Everett Casas were the next two to go (to the state meet). Gant is just one of the classiest kids you ever want to meet."

■ **Maroons come a packing** — Maroon coach Jeff Quick was quick to point out the key to Moline's dominance was its ability to run close together, or "packing," as it is called in harrier lingo.

"This was a good example of packing, or a good team effort," Quick said.

Case in point was that no Maroon runner finished worse than 48th.

After Soliz, senior Dave Andrews took 15th (15:41), followed by Tony Miles (27th), Braeden Peters (35th) and Troy Thomson (47th) and Travis Patton (48th).

"After last year, we knew we could win it this year because we had everybody coming

back," Soliz said.

Geneseo freshman Justin Fluck paced the Leafs with a 19th-place finish. Another freshman, Rock Island's Sean Mendoza, took 26th, while teammate Brett Loy took 39th.

■ **UT girls advance** — Led by Liz Haney's 11th-place finish in a clocking of 14:29, the Panthers notched 174 points to take third. Metamora was the team champion with 103 points and the runner-up was Peoria Notre Dame with 121 points.

Even though she just missed a top 10 spot, Haney, last week's regional champ, seemed disappointed by her performance.

"During the race, I was just trying to hang with them when they came up beside me ... but I didn't feel good. My legs weren't tired and my breathing wasn't tired. I just felt I couldn't go at all," Haney said. "It might have been mentally; I thought I was ready for it, but maybe not."

"Liz didn't run as well as she thought she should have run," Feller said. "I know more than 100 girls right now who would be glad to be in her spot."

Also helping out UTHS in a big way was Greta Swanson (17th), Amanda Lewis (36th) Jessica Hess (56th) and Kristy Garcia (74th).

Garcia's performance was one Feller singled out.

"I thought Kristy really, stepped it up," Feller said. "She didn't run very well last week and really came through for us today."

The next best Q-C area team finish was Rock Island (15th), followed by Moline (18th) and Geneseo (19th).

Rock Island was paced by Amy Radosevich (27th) and Jesse Atkins (31st). Molly Reade topped the Leafs with a 55th placement. Moline was led by Holly Long's 89th-place finish.

Moline boys capture Class AA sectional

■ Races are plagued by muddy conditions

Saturday's sectional cross country meets all had a single common thread.

Both the Class A meet at Oregon, Ill., and the Class AA meet in Rockford, Ill., were effected by wet conditions that were better for ducks than runners.

The Quad-City area competitors didn't fare so well in the slop.

The Class AA competition at Rockford Guilford was also plagued by problems with results and scoring.

"It was a great course," Moline coach Jeff Quick said. "But, they had some problems with the finish area and they did a poor job of correctly scoring the meet."

Despite the problems, Moline captured the sectional title with its balanced attack with its top five runners all placed in the top 50.

"We ran so well that it didn't matter about the scoring," Quick said.

Eli Soliz led the Maroons with a ninth-place finish. He wasn't close to the top 10 until his final kick.

"I went all out down the stretch," said Soliz. "The key to us winning was the fact that Jeff Hansen and I beat Mr. and Mrs. Quick in euchre on Friday night. We beat them before the regional meet as well."

United Township's Josh Sherrod advanced individually to state with a 14th-place finish but Larry Gant and Everett Casas failed by two spots as they were 17th and 18th, respectively.

"I really thought we were going to get all three to state," UT coach Bob Feller said. "It's really disappointing for them to be so close and to miss. Larry Gant is pure class. He's a terrific kid to work with."

Class AA girls

United Township's Liz Hancy didn't have the type of run she wanted on Saturday as the regional champion finished 11th.

But Hancy advanced to state along with the rest of her teammates as the Panthers took third in the team standings.

"I don't know what was wrong, but I just didn't have it," she said. "My goal was for the team to make it."

"From the start I didn't have it. Whenever a girl would pull alongside of me, I just tried to hang with them. I felt better in the last quarter-mile of the race than I did dur-

ing any part of before that. I thought I was ready. I guess I wasn't."

United Township's trip to state is thanks in part to its No. 4 and 5 runners — Jessica Hess and Kristy Green.

"Sophomore Kristy Green ran very, very well," Feller said. "Our fourth runner, Jessica Hess, is just a freshman and she came through wonderfully under the pressure."

Sycamore advanced to state with a fourth-place finish. It is coached by former Moline prep Rob Harvey.
