

Lake dominates course

Local harriers finish strong in 12-team invite

Freshman Jenny Lake not only was the first Geneseo runner to take the tape in the varsity girls division of the Galesburg Invitational Saturday, September 6 but she was also the overall winner of the event.

The meet was held at Lake Storey Park in 78° temperatures.

This was Lake's second victory in her high school career, having taken first in Rock Falls Thursday, September 4 at the season opener. This was only the second scheduled meet of the season for the harriers as well.

Lake covered the 2.05-mile course in 11:53 with a split time of 5:40. Three Alleman runners took second, third and fourth with times of 13:22, 13:23 and 13:24.

Just one other Lady Leaf, Natalie Myers, earned a slot within the top ten. Myers clocked in at 13:33 with a 6:35 split, to earn seventh place overall.

Others running for Geneseo at the varsity level were Rhonda Loftus, 15th, 13:55; Amy Schneider, 19th, 14:11; Becky Riewerts, 26th, 14:26; Chris Kempfer, 63rd, 15:28; Jill Hinrichs, 74th, 16:02; Beth Bos, 91st, 17:00; Dawn Miller, 92nd, 17:12 and Joy Gray, 94th, 17:18.

Out of 12 teams, Geneseo placed second even though it tied in points with East Peoria. The sixth and seventh runners scoring for Peoria placed higher than those placing for Geneseo, giving East Peoria the win. Both teams amassed 68 points for the day.

Other teams competing were Alleman, third, 73 points; Moline, fourth, 96; UTHS, fifth, 127; Galesburg, sixth, 158; Peoria Richwoods, seventh, 189; Metamora, eighth, 197; Sterling, ninth, 219; Morton, 10th, 222; Rockridge, 11th, 261 and Macomb, 12th, 270.

The frosh-soph girls earned fourth place within the 12-team competition. Metamora took first with 32 points; Alleman, second, 55; Richwoods, third, 61; Geneseo, fourth, 85; Morton, fifth, 128; Sterling, sixth, 186 and UTHS, seventh, 210. Also attending were Galesburg, Moline, Macomb, East Peoria and Rockridge.

A Richwoods runner took the individual title with a time of 12:50 with second and third places finishing with times of 13:27 and 13:41, respectively.

Andrea Blondell was the first Lady Leafrosh to cross the line, taking sixth place overall with a time of 13:58.

Also competing for Geneseo were Rachael Williams, ninth, 14:18; Alysa Snyder, 10th, 14:21; Codi Hultman, 35th, 15:46; Mary Teronez, 38th, 15:54; Kari Reagin, 39th, 15:55; Kelli O'Dell, 40th, 15:56; Erin Schneider, 60th, 17:18; Jaime Gunnison, 71st, 18:15; Jody Thompson, 90th, 20:52; Megan Irish, 94th, 21:28 and Nikki Thompson, 95th, 22:17.

Second place finishes were also earned by the varsity and frosh-soph boys cross country teams.

At the varsity level, Metamora took first overall with a score of 62 followed by Geneseo in second with 75.

Other teams were Richwoods, third, 78; East Peoria, fourth, 88;

UTHS, fifth, 111; Alleman, sixth, 162; Moline, seventh, 191; Sterling, eighth, 195; Morton, ninth, 218; Rockridge, 10th, 254; Macomb, 11th, 282 and Galesburg, 12th, 293.

Jason Gray led the way for the Leafs, placing fifth overall with a time of 17:48. The top three times for the 3.1-mile course were 17:11, 17:31 and 17:46.

Also running for Geneseo were Andy Beuster, 11th, 18:19; Mark Keppler, 15th, 18:28; Chris Studer, 20th, 18:38; David Rutledge, 29th, 18:54; Josh Fleming, 50th, 19:57 and Matt Carlson, 114th, 30:52.

The frosh-soph harriers covered a 2.05-mile course with Tim Nelson and Grant Venema placing within the top ten for Geneseo. Nelson took eighth overall with a time of 11:50 while Venema's time of 11:57 earned him ninth place.

A time of 11:19 won the race for a Moline runner with times of 11:29 and 11:34 taking second and third.

As a team, Moline took the meet with 18 points while Geneseo earned 60 for second place. Other teams were Richwoods, third, 64 points; UTHS, fourth, 116 and Morton, fifth, 132. Also fielding runners were Alleman, Galesburg, Sterling, Macomb, Metamora, East Peoria and Rockridge.

GENESEO, Ill. — Jenny Lake is in it for the long run.

A freshman at Geneseo, Lake has committed herself to running and so far throughout a young season, she’s leading the pack.

Lake dominated the field last weekend at the Galesburg Invitational, even surprising herself by winning the two-mile girls race by 1 minute, 29 seconds over her closest competitor.

She toured the Lake Storey course of 2.05 miles in 11 minutes, 53 seconds and helped the Maple Leafs to a second-place finish in the 12-team meet.

“I was just hoping to stay with the leaders. I didn’t expect to win it — not my first invitational in my freshman year,” Lake said.

Cities region this summer.

She won championships at East Moline’s Firecracker Run 5K and the John Deere Commons 5K in Moline and finished 34th in the women’s division at the *Quad-City Times* Bix 7.

“She’s a very highly motivated young lady who wants to be the best she can be,” Fredericks said. “Her best races are ahead of her, but she’s off to a tremendous start.”

Lake has been running competitively for only a little more than two years, using it to cross-train for soccer.

She excelled in that sport as a member of the Quad-City Strikers team that became the first-ever Iowa-based squad to reach a Midwest regional finals match earlier this summer.

Although her father, Ray Lake, is the soccer

coach at Geneseo who will head the Maple Leafs' first girls team next spring, Jenny Lake plans to continue to pursue her skills in track.

"She's been playing soccer since she was old enough to walk, so it was a very tough decision for her," Fredericks said. "She's decided to see where running takes her, and I think she has a tremendous future."

For now, Jenny Lake plans to help a veteran Geneseo girls team achieve its goal of winning a second straight Illinois Class AA sectional championship.

"This is a great team, and we have the potential to accomplish a lot this season," she said. "I know I'm one of the newcomers, but the seniors have made me feel welcome. We're all working as a team and in cross country, that's what it takes."

Senior Natalie Myers, regularly the Maple Leafs' first finisher the past three years, said

start. I'll learn from it and do better the next time I'm in that situation. That's my goal this season — to learn and to improve with each meet."

Lake has been developing her skills as the running partner of veteran Geneseo runner Kelley Timmerman, a longtime force in Quad-Cities area road racing.

The pair trains together, and they have developed an almost sister-like relationship. Lake even baby-sits for Timmerman's children.

"She's been a big help. She's definitely a role model for me and somebody I respect a great deal,"

Jenny Lake said. "I've learned a lot from her so far, but I feel like I'm just starting to learn."

That's what excites Fredericks.

"Our junior high program is an extremely low-mileage program. Because of that, she is very early in the developmental process as a runner. But like any soccer player, she has put in a lot of miles in that sport," Fredericks said.

"She's a good fit with the rest of our team, too," he said. "They're all a very coachable group. Our whole team is that way, really, and I think we're all looking forward to see where this season will take us."
