Back on the road

Lake, Studer, Venema win at only home meet

Jenny Lake, Chris Studer and Grant Venema showed Alleman, Rock Falls and Mendota what homecourse advantage is all about as the J. D. Darnall cross country teams hosted their only home meet Tuesday, September 9. All three won their respective divisions for Geneseo.

Lake won her third meet of the 1997 season by finishing the varsity girls division in a time of 12:04. Natalie Circello of Alleman was her closest rival, taking second in 13:25. Lady Leaf Natalie Myers took third overall with a time of 13:29.

Three other Lady Leafs finished within the top ten, Andrea Blondell, Rhonda Loftus and Rachel Williams. Blondell took fifth overall in 13:51; Loftus was ninth in 14:16 and Williams rounded out the top ten with a time of 14:27.

Also running for Genesco were Amy Schneider, 12th, 14:34; Alysa Snyder, 13th, 14:43; and Becky Riewerts, 15th, 14:53.

As a team, Geneseo beat Rock Falls and Mendota, both 15-50 but were beaten by Alleman, 27-28. Alleman also beat Rock Falls, 15-49.

Studer won his first race of the year, taking the varsity boys meet with a time of 17:50. Nic Rivera of Rock Falls took second with a time of 18:03, just fractions of a second ahead of Leaf Jason Gray who clocked in at 18:04.

Three other Geneseo representatives finished within the top ten. Mark Keplinger took fourth overall in 18:15; Andy Beuster was eighth in 18:55 and David Rutledge took ninth in 19:02.

Josh Fleming and Matt Carlson also ran for the Leafs. Fleming was 18th overall with a time of 20:46 while Carlson placed 24th with a time of 30:37.

In the team standings, Geneseo beat all three opponents. The Leafs scored a 19-36 victory over the Rock Island team while scoring a 21-35 win over Rock Falls and a 15-50 victory over Mendota. Alleman in turn edged Rock Falls, 28-29.

Domination by the Leafrosh would be an understatement indeed. Out of the top ten positions, only one was NOT taken by a Geneseo harrier. Venema led the way with a time of 11:54 followed by Tim Nelson in second, 11:58. These two top runners have consistently finished together this year usually with Nelson in the lead.

Bobby Ristau, who has also been keeping close tabs on the top two Leafrosh harriers, took third with a time of 12:10.

Rounding out the top ten were Luke Owens, 12:43; Matt Travis, 12:46; Neil Kuhlman, 13:00; Charles Peters, 13:05; Bill Bean, 13:10 and Brandon Sandoval, 13:12. Ian Burke of Alleman took tenth overall with a time of 13:15.

Helping Geneseo in its overwhelming victory were strong efforts by Mike Skelton, 11th, 13:26; Mike Heitzler, 12th, 13:30; Mike Brown, 13th, 13:33; Jared Betcher, 15th, 13:48; Nathan Thompson, 18th, 14:52; Adam Kuban, 20th, 14:58; Mark Gleason, 24th, 15:23; Billy Johnson, 25th, 15:36 and Mike Stone, 26th, 16:05.

The final tallies in the team stand-

ings showed Geneseo beating both Alleman and Rock Falls by 15-50 scores.

The junior varsity girls didn't have as much luck as the rest of the Geneseo teams. Alleman took the team competition with a 22-33 final.

The top two individual finishers were also from Alleman. Mindy Smith took the meet with a time of 15:08 while her teammate, Lindsey Baker, was third in 15:17.

Chris Kempher was the first Lady Leaflet to cross the line, taking third place overall with a time of 15:26.

Four other lady harriers stacked up in the sixth through ninth place slots, giving Geneseo a strong showing.

Cody Hultman took sixth in 16:04 followed by Mary Terronez, 16:05; Kelli O'Dell, 16:10 and Kari Reagin, 16:34. Three other Alleman runners took the remaining places within the top ten.

Lady Leaflets packed in again for 11th, 12th and 13th places. Beth Bos

led the way with a time of 17:24 followed by Jill Hinrichs, 17:40 and Dawn Miller in 17:53.

Also competing for Geneseo were Jaime Gunnison, 17th, 19:32; Jennifer Vermost, 18th, 19:33; Sarah Kiefer, 19th, 19:44 and Megan Irish, 20th, 19:53.

The varsity girls, junior varsity girls and the frosh-soph boys teams all ran two-mile courses while the varsity boys covered a three-mile course. Runners noted the track was wet as three inches of rain fell earlier in the day.

Geneseo's cross country teams will head to East Moline for a 4:30 p.m. meet on Tuesday, September 16 then to Peoria on Saturday, September 20 for the 9 a.m. Notre Dame invitational.
