Cross country teams head to Sterling Regionals

J. D. Darnall High School varsity cross country teams have won the N.C.I.C. meet. Now it's time for regionals.

The Leafs and Lady Leafs will head back to Sterling for Class AA regional competition this Saturday, October 25. At 1 p.m., the varsity girls will be signalled to start with the boys to follow at 1:30 p.m.

In addition to Geneseo, Dixon, United Township of East Moline, Galesburg, LaSalle-Peru, Moline, Ottawa Township, Princeton, Rochelle, Rock Island High School and Sterling High School will field teams.

The top five teams and the first five runners who are not members of qualifying teams will advance to the sectional.

The winner of the Sterling Regional will take part in the East Peoria Sectionals along with winners from the Peoria Richwoods Regional, Pontiac Regional and Rockford East Regional.

Class AA sectionals will run Saturday November 1 with the state

finals slated for Saturday, November 8 at Detweiller Park in Peoria.

The top five teams and the top seven runners not members of qualifying teams from sectionals will advance to the state meet.

Last year, the Lady Leafs made it all the way to state, earning second at regionals, first at the Rockford sectionals and then 23rd at state.

It was the fifth sectional title earned by a Geneseo girls cross country team. The trip to state in 1996 was the first since 1988 for the team.

Several of this year's squad saw action at last year's state meet, including Natalie Myers, Andrea Blondell, Rachael Williams, Becky Riewerts and Rhonda Loftus.

As for the Leafs, the 1996 squad earned third in regional competition to earn a right at the sectional meet. The boys took tenth at sectional, running just two seniors, the rest expected to return in 1997.

After the disappointing results following regionals, Coach Fredericks noted the boys were only 35 points out of fifth place - the final slot which would have qualified the team for state.

Members of the 1997 squad attending last year's sectional were Chris Studer, Justin Fluck, Jason Gray, Mark Keplinger and Andy Beuster.

Freshman harrier leads Lady Leafs to regional crown

Freshmen Jenny Lake and the J. D. Darnall High School girls varsity cross country team have earned an out-and-out right to attend the East Peoria Sectionals this Saturday, November 1.

The Lady Leafs took first place in the Class AA Sterling Regionals Saturday, October 25 under cold, rainy and windy conditions.

In addition, the squad had three Lady Leafs place within the top five in the field, Lake, Andrea Blondell and Natalie Myers.

The 1996 team took second at the regionals and included Myers and Blondell as well. Also running in last year's meet and returning this year were Rachael Williams and Rhonda Loftus.

The top five teams and the first five runners not members of a quali-

fying team advanced to sectionals. The girls will start at 11 a.m. while the boys will kick-off at 11:50 a.m. The East Peoria Sectional will be run at Illinois Central College in East Peoria. From here, the top five teams and top seven individuals not on a qualifying team will head to state.

In the team standings, Geneseo earned just 35 points, well ahead of second-place Rock Island with 86 and the rest of the 11-team field. Also earning a trip to East Peoria with a top-five placing were Rochelle, 107 points; Moline, 138 and United Township High School, East Moline, 139.

Other team totals were Dixon, 146; Sterling, 151; LaSalle-Peru, 192; Ottawa, 220; Galesburg, 221 and Princeton, 251.

Lake completed the 2.10-mile race in 12:15, nearly a half-minute ahead of Jesse Atkins of Rock Island who took second with a time of 12:46.

Lake had taken first her other two trips to Sterling this year as well. On September 30, the local harriers took

part in a regular meet at Sterling with Lake winning in a time of 12:20. At the invitational on October 11, Lake clocked 11:50.

Lady Leaf Blondell captured third overall with her time of 12:56 while teammate Natalie Myers took fourth in 12:57. Jessica Wright of United Township was the final top-five harrier with a time of 13:07.

Individuals qualifying for the second meet include Andi Clinard of L.P., 13:14; Marie Shafer, Dixon, 13:23; Stacy Gualandi, L.P., 13:47; Erica Madison of Ottawa, 13:52 and Becky Schlomer of Galesburg, 13:54.

If the rest of the Lady Leafs had not already earned a trip to sectionals with the team qualification, their times alone could have earned them a trip.

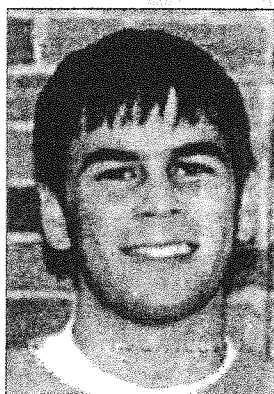
The last individual qualifier finished in 13:54. All but one Lady Leaf had a better time.

Juniors lead cross country team to 2nd-place finish

Bettering its third-place 1996 finish, the J. D. Darnall High School varsity boys cross country team earned second place of 11 teams at the Class AA Sterling Regionals.

Justin Fluck did even better than that, he earned first place overall. Under cold, rainy and windy 40-degree temps, Fluck took the crown in 15:53 for the 3.05-mile course.

Rock Island won the meet with 42 points while Geneseo scored 56 for second. Moline, 89 points; Rochelle, 113 and Dixon, 152 also earned a trip to the Class AA East Peoria Sectionals this Saturday, November 1.

Leaf Chris Studer joined Fluck in placing within the top five for the field, taking third at 16:05.

Others finishing within the top five were three Rock Island harriers, Sean Mendoza, second, 16:01; Ryan Sheets, fourth, 16:13 and Ryan Allen, fifth, 16:15.

In addition to the top five teams, the top five individuals not members of qualifying teams advance. Sectional qualifiers are Alex Casas of United township, 16:26; Dan Sherman, Sterling, 16:32; Eric Crowhurst, Ottawa, 16:57; Pierre Woods, Galesburg, 17:10 and Eric

Wesslemann, United Township, 17:19.

Sectionals will be held at Illinois Central College, East Peoria Saturday, November 1. The boys' competition will begin at 11:50 a.m.

The top five teams and top seven individual runners not on qualifying teams will advance to the state meet which is slated for Saturday, November 8 at Detweiller Park, Peoria.

This was Fluck's third trip to Sterling in less than a month. On September 30, Fluck won the regular meet with a time of 16:17 while at the invitational on October 11, his time of 14:42 earned 10th overall. In the earlier meet, Studer earned second with a time of 16:39.

The Leafs packed it up in the higher teen place finishes, placing three runners within the top 20 with the final two coming in 21st and 22nd out of a field of nearly 80 runners.

Andy Beuster took 16th overall with a time of 16:47 followed by Mark Keplinger, 17th, 16:49 and Grant Venema, 19th, 16:57. Tim Nelson and David Rutledge placed 21-22, respectively, with times of 17:01 and 17:07.

Fluck, Studer and Keplinger, all juniors, competed on the 1996 team which took third at regionals.

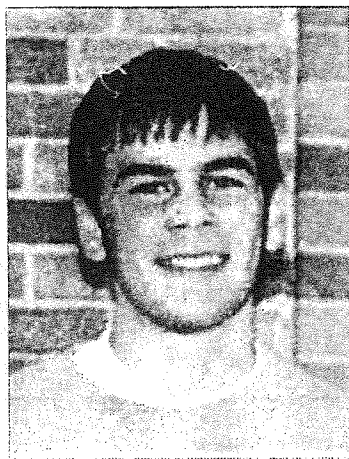

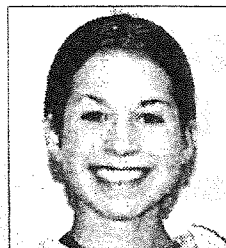

Q-C advances all 4 teams in AA girls cross country

STERLING — Geneseo, lead by freshman sensation Jenny Lake's first-place finish, took the Sterling Class AA girls cross country title Saturday in what turned out to be a total team effort.

The Maple Leafs scored a paltry 35 points, 51 points lower than second-place finisher, Rock Island.

In the 11-team field, Rochelle (107) took third, Moline (138) followed in fourth, UTHS (139) finished fifth. The top five teams advance to sectional.

"It was a tremendous team effort," said Geneseo coach Don Fredericks. "Our fourth today is usually our seventh, so it's nice to see that kind of effort."

Lake took the top spot with a time of 12:15, but felt a little lag near the end of the race.

"I had no push at the end," Lake said. "I'm not used to running in the cold, so maybe that added to it."

Lake also cited how well her team

is doing.

"The whole team has stepped it up. Race after race, we've been improving and this is a testament to our hard work," the freshman said.

Runner-up Rock Island was lead by Western Big 6 champ Jesse Atkins, who finished second, and teammates Amy Farrar (12th place), Sarah Todd (16th) and Melanie Round (21st).

Rocky coach Dave Terronez was pleased with his Rocks' second-

place performance and how well they kept up with the Leafs.

"Jesse Atkins ran great again and everyone else put in a great effort. The closer we can stay to Geneseo, the better we'll be," he said.

Moline was lead by the running of Kayti Bouljon (11th), Breanne Stefens (18th) and Jill Decker (28th).

Moline coach Jeff Quick was a pleasantly surprised at his team's good finish.

"They surprised me with how well they did. All of the girls ran a good race," Quick said.

UTHS used strong finishes from Jessica Wright (5th) and Beth Brorby (7th) to put the Panthers in next week's sectional.

"Jessica and Beth both ran extremely well for us and our team has been trying to get over the hump and this did it for us," said UTHS coach Jim Wesselmann.

"All of our runners are young still and just learning how to run their race and today was a good step toward that."

Q-C teams move to sectional

■ Geneseo's Fluck, Lake capture titles

STERLING, Ill. — And then there were five.

The Class AA boys and girls cross country regional meets at Sterling's Hoover Park ended the seasons of all but five teams in each field on Saturday.

Each of the top five teams advance to next Saturday's sectional meet in East Peoria.

The advancing boys' teams are Rock Island, Geneseo, Moline, Rochelle and Dixon, finishing in that order.

Geneseo, Rock Island, Rochelle, Moline and United Township will each be sending their girls teams to next week's Class AA sectional.

"It's just great that there are all these area teams that will be competing at sectionals," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said. "There is a lot of competition and camaraderie between our local teams. Most of these kids have been running against each other since grade school."

Geneseo's Justin Fluck edged out Rock Island's Sean Mendoza by eight seconds to take first place.

Mendoza had passed Fluck between the two-mile mark and the finish line before they entered the woods. When they emerged from the woods, Fluck had re-established the lead and kicked it in down the stretch.

"Mendoza made a conscious move and maybe expended too much energy in the woods after he passed Fluck," Rock Island second-year coach Dave Terronez said. "I'm just happy for our kids; they worked really hard to get where they are."

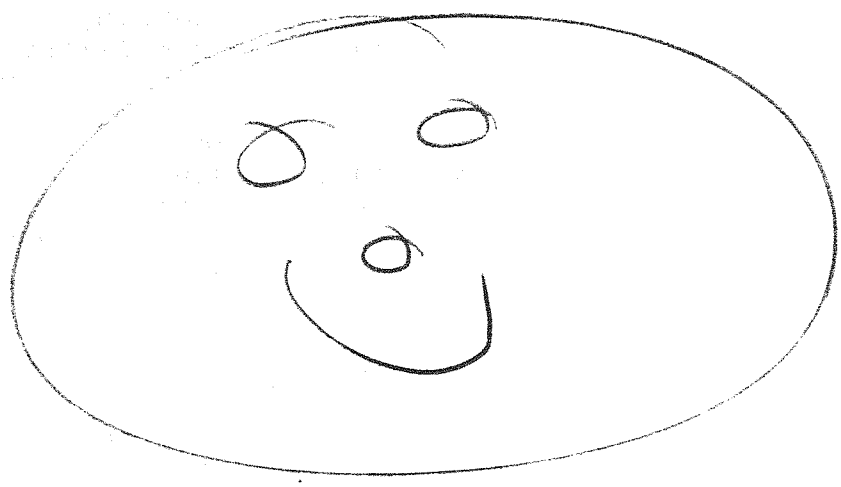
