

## Class AA cross country sectional

■ **Time & place:** Of the five sites statewide, just one holds local interest today at Illinois Central College in East Peoria. The girls' race begins at 11 a.m. while the boys' start at 11:50 a.m.

■ **What's at stake:** The top five teams, and top seven individuals not on one of those teams, qualify for next Saturday's state meet at Peoria's Detweiller Park.

■ **Local interests:** Moline, Geneseo and United Township have both their boys' and girls' teams competing. Rock Island's boys' team is joined by Lady Rocks Erin Copen and Emily Marquis.

■ **Boys' field (in order of regional score):** Peoria Notre Dame (30, champ), Rockford Guilford (41, champ), Rochelle (49, champ), Moline (54), Bloomington (54, champ), Pontiac (54, champ), Belvidere (56), Pekin (74), Peoria Richwoods (76), Rockford Jefferson (76), UT (90), Rockton Honenegah (90), Metamora (95), Rocky (99), Mahomet Seymour (104), Normal West (108), Geneseo (112), Morton (122), Peoria (123), Sycamore (126).

■ **Girls' field (in order of regional score):** Peoria Notre Dame (33, champ), East Peoria (41), Moline (51, champ), DeKalb (52, champ), Bloomington (59, champ), Normal West (63), Geneseo (67), Freeport (71), Peoria Richwoods (73), Rockford Boylan (93), Pekin (100), United Township (102), Mahomet Seymour (102), Sterling (105), Metamora (105), Belvidere (118), Sycamore (118), Bradley-Bourbonnais (120), Princeton (129), Morton (140).

■ **Boys' forecast:** Without a regional title to boast about, Western Big 6 champ Moline is alone among the best four qualifying scores coming in. The seven-time sectional champion Maroons last won at this level in 1995.

"Rochelle is probably the third, or fourth best team in the sectional, so we know that with us right behind them we have a pretty good shot to make it as a team," Moline coach Jeff Quick said.

UT, Rocky and Geneseo don't figure in the top 10 teams, according to last week's numbers. But, if that doesn't change, expect UT's Brian Taghon and Ammon Paquette to be in the individual running for state along with Geneseo's Josh Franks and Rocky's Boomer Creger and Keith Moroni. All five finished in last week's top 10 overall with a Moline threesome led by Drew Patterson.

"We ran good races (at Regionals), so hopefully team wise we'll be competitive," said Taghon.

Creger, also the Big 6 champ, comes in with the slowest regional-winning time (15:40), which ranks ninth-best in the field. Bloomington's Kyle Hilgendorf (15:18) was the quickest qualifier.

"Boomer planned out his race, and ran conservatively, due to his bad quadricep, so hopefully he'll be able to run his top race at sectional," said Rocky coach Michelle Menke.

Geneseo won this sectional in 1998; Rocky and UT are still looking for their first sectional crowns.

■ **Girls' forecast:** Coming off its first regional title since 1991, Moline looks for more. The Maroons own the third-best qualifying team score while regional runner-up Jill Steffens boasts the third-best qualifying time (15:01). "The girls are really starting to peak now, so we have a really solid shot at this week's sectional," said Quick.

Don't doubt that Geneseo is out for revenge, though, after having a string of three straight sectional crowns snapped last year by Pekin. The Sterling Regional championship

time by Leafs' star Jenny Lake tops the field (14:49). Teammate Emily Alden owns the 10th-best qualifying time (15:29). Moline's Jessica Griffin is two spots behind her.

But while Moline and Geneseo are strong candidates to either win or move on, UT ranks outside of the top 10 qualifying scores. If the Panthers fail to make it as a team, expect Beth Brorby to make a run at returning to state. Brorby was ninth last year to earn a state date.

# Moline boys, girls make state

**Rocks' Creger  
wins boys race by  
3-second margin**

EAST PEORIA, Ill. — Rock Island senior Boomer Creger set the pace in the boys race while boys and girls teams from Moline earned state tournament berths Saturday at the Illinois Class AA sectional cross country meet.

It was the first time Moline qualified both teams since 1991.

Creger, who earlier won Western Big Six and regional championship, covered the relatively hilly three-mile course at Illinois Central College in 15 minutes, 18 seconds to win the sectional title by three seconds over David Bergeson of Rochelle.

The Maroons finished as the runner-up in the girls team race and earned the fifth of five state-qualifying spots in the boys race.

Coach Jeff Quick's girls team placed two athletes in the top 15 to finish second to Normal West. Western Big Six champion Jill Steffens finished fifth in the 2.4-

mile race in a time of 16:24 and Jessica Griffin took 15th in 16:52.

Geneseo's Jenny Lake finished second in the girls race, crossing the finish line in 16:02. Her state-qualifying effort was seven seconds off of the pace set by Meghan Braffet of Normal West.

In the boys race, the top five finishers finished within 10 seconds of Creger's winning time.

He'll be joined at next Saturday's state meet at Detweiller Park in Peoria by a pair of United Township athletes.

The Panthers' Brian Taghon and Ammon Paquette earned the final two individual qualifying spots at the sectional by finishing 12th and 13th overall.

The pair crossed the line together in 15:36, three seconds ahead of Moline's top finisher, Nate Medinger.

A senior, Medinger finished 14th overall for a Moline team that pushed five of the first 55 runners across to advance to state.

Drew Patterson finished 28th and Brent Clawson, Jeff Decker and Erik Steffens finished within three seconds of each other, led by Clawson's 16:25 time which was good for 48th place.

# Moline boys and girls run to state

## Rocks' Creger wins boys title; Lake 2nd in girls

It was a Maroon day at the East Peoria Class AA Cross Country Sectional as both the Moline boys and girls teams advanced to next weekend's state finals at Peoria's Dettweiler Park.

"At the beginning of this year, I don't think anybody expected the girls team to go this far and to do this well," said Moline coach Jeff Quick of his team's second-place finish. "They went out and ran a great race from top to bottom. This was a great race for as young of a team as we have."

"It's also a very good way to go out for our senior captain, Tara Rogers."

The Maroon boys advanced by taking the fifth, and last, team qualifying spot.

"We knew that it was going to be close, and we didn't know until they announced us, so for both teams to be going, it is something special," said Quick.

Other area boys advancing to state were Rock Island's Boomer Creger, who won the race, and United Township's Ammon Paquette and Brian Taghon, who took the sixth and seventh individual spots.

On the girls side, the only area runner to advance was Geneseo's Jenny Lake — second overall.

### Boys

Rock Island's Creger showed that if he wasn't completely healed from his bad left quadricep, he was good enough to win, using a late kick to prevail.

"It (quadricep) was getting a little tight during the second mile, but the last mile, it just seemed to work itself out," said Creger.

"I was worried about Boomer because he was limping a little during warm-ups

and at practice yesterday," said Rock Island coach Michelle Menke, "but he fought through it and ran a great race."

The course at East Peoria featured a more hilly terrain that Creger saw to his advantage.

"I tried to stay behind the leaders and draft the wind while we were going up the hill," he said, "I wasn't using as much energy as (Rochelle's David Bergeson) was, so I knew at the end I would be stronger, and it worked to my advantage."

"He (Creger) ran a smart race. I knew that the layout here was a little confusing, so I didn't know if Boomer would know when to make his move, but he did it at the right time," said Menke.

Creger used the benefit of a late kick in the last 20 meters to beat Bergeson for the second week in a row.

"I never led until the very

end, but I was exactly where I wanted to be," said Creger. "This is a great field, and I knew it was going to be tight all the way and I got really pushed."

The Moline boys used a strong team effort to take home fifth place, and advance the team to state.

"The boys have been running together all year, so this is really special for them to get to state, especially with all the seniors we have on the team," said Quick.

The Maroons headed to state are Nate Medinger, Drew Patterson, Brent Clawson, Jeff Decker, Erik Steffens, Mike Verre and Mike Barrett.

Also advancing from the area scene was United Township's duo of Taghon and Paquette, who finished 12th and 13th, respectively, but took the last two remaining individual qualifier spots.

"I'm really relieved that Brian and I made it together," said Paquette.

"I was really nervous, because I knew it was tight. I'm glad for Moline, though, they ran a good race," added Taghon.

### Girls

The Moline girls, not to be outshone by the boys' team effort, will also take the entire team to state, led by Jill Steffens' fifth-place run.

"I really wanted to finish in the top five, so I am somewhat

happy," said Steffens. "I really wanted to pass the girl ahead of me, but she closed strong."

Like the boys' race, Steffens did have a little confusion on the layout of the course.

"I thought we were going to run through the loop twice, instead of once, so I kind of held back a little," said Steffens. "Getting down to state, though, will be a good experience for the team."

Quick was not only pleased with Steffens, but the entire team effort.

"Jill ran a super race, and we also got another good performance from the whole team," said Quick.

Joining Steffens at state from Moline are Jessica Griffin, Anne Gloeckner, Tara Rogers, Jenna McAdam, Lacy Chappell and Renee Minch.

Also heading to state is Geneseo's Lake.

"I wanted to go out fast, and that helped me a lot," Lake said. "It was back and forth the whole race between me and Megan (Braffet, Normal West) and a girl from East Peoria."

"We lost the girl from East Peoria going up the last hill, and while we were coming down, I lost Megan."

While he was happy to see Lake return to state, Geneseo coach Don Fredericks was hoping for a first-place finish.

"This is the third time Jenny's placed second at sectionals, so it's disappointing she didn't win it," he said. "Still, it is nice she is going back to Peoria."

"It was real tight overall, though. We finished ninth, but we were only 23 points back. We knew coming in that this was a strong sectional field."
