■ **Advancement:** The top five placing teams along with the top five individuals not on a top five team advance to next

weekend's state meet at Peoria's Detweiller Park.

■ **Who's there?** Moline, Geneseo, and United Township's boys and girls teams. Joining them will be Rocky's Will Moeller and Erin Copen.

■ **Favorites:** On the girls' side, the Western Big 6 champion Moline Maroons carry a No. 14 ranking in the state of Illinois cross country power rankings.

The Maroons are the lone ranked team at East Peoria.

As far as individual times go, based on

last weekend's regionals, Moline's Jill Steffens' 14:58 is good enough for a 1-second advantage on East Peoria's Rachel Lowe (who ran at Detweiller Park last weekend) and Normal West's Meghan Braffet (who ran at the Bradley Regional) last weekend.

Also, fellow Maroon runner Jessica Griffin will be carrying the meet's 10th best time, of 15:39.

On the boys' side, team advancement honors will be up for grabs, as Moline, United Township, Geneseo, Pekin, Normal Community, Pontiac, and Belvidere all expect to contend for the coveted invitations to next weekend's state championship meet.

The Moline Maroons possibly could have the most balanced team as their top five

Steffens lone AA girls' state cross country qualifier

EAST PEORIA — As if Jill Steffens needed any more motivation to run well at state next weekend, the Moline senior had six more reasons unexpectedly crop up Saturday.

Steffens booked a return trip to state, but her six cross-country teammates did not follow suit, as pre-race favorite Moline finished a disappointing eighth in the Class AA East Peoria Sectional.

Even Steffens didn't live up to expectations, entirely, on the hilly, 2.68-mile Illinois Central College course. She failed to win medalist honors for just the fourth time in 13 races, finishing fifth behind some competition she'd already beaten earlier this season.

"I'm thankful I have a second chance to rebound from a bad day. It's devastating my team does not," Steffens said after finishing 31 seconds off the winning pace of 16:10 set by East Peoria's Rachael Lowe. "Now, I'm not just running for myself next weekend, I'm running for them, too."

"I don't know what happened. Maybe the pressure got to us because everybody was pointing to us. I don't know. I just know personally when the gun went off, I tried to go with Lowe and my legs just wouldn't move. I couldn't run like I'm used to."

Dirto for her teammates.

"We just didn't fire on all cylinders," Moline coach Jeff Quick said. "We easily had our worst race of the year at the worst time of year, for several reasons."

For starters, the Maroons were missing seventh-runner Jessica Conklin because of a family emergency. Injuries this season left the cupboard bare of replacements.

Thus, Moline had six runners where most teams had seven, with the top five counting.

Of those six Maroons, though, two were hurting — Jenna McAdam was run-

ning with her asthma acting up and Anne Gloeckner competed with a case of stomach flu. McAdam finished 106th (92nd in the team race) and Gloeckner was a second back in 108th (93rd) to round out Moline's scoring.

"We might have overcome one of those problems," Quick said, "but not all three."

Jessica Griffin, last week's regional runner-up and an all-state hopeful like Steffens, also finished a disappointing 17th and missed advancing as an individual by 11 seconds.

"We worked so hard this year, we've never been more ready for this," Steffens said dejectedly. "We qualified for state as a team my freshman and junior years, and we were five times the team this year. We finished second last year at the sectional on this same course, and we don't even make it out this year? It just doesn't add up."

Hence, Steffens will be the lone local representative at Detweiller Park next Saturday.

Moline had 232 points to finish well behind the five advancing teams — Metamora (73 points), East Peoria (148), Freeport (170), Belvidere (172) and Peoria Notre Dame (195).

NCIC champ Geneseo (12th at 287) and United Township (15th at 344) also failed to advance as a team, and did not have any individual qualifiers.

Ashley Colo, a regional medalist for the Leafs last week, finished 48th while running sick, which didn't help Geneseo's team chances.

"It wasn't because of a lack of effort; we just picked a bad time to have a bad race," Geneseo coach Don Fredricks said. "It's very disappointing for our girls, especially our seniors — Jann Johnson, Jenny Mosher and Karin Skelton. The others will come back next year and have a chance to redeem themselves; our seniors will not."

Christine Cooney, an all-Western Big 6 performer, was UT's highest finisher, coming in 37th place.

"Our goal program-wide was to do better at sectional than we did last year with better teams, and for the most part we did that," said UT coach Kevin Stuckwisch. "We were 11th last year in the boys and finished 10th this time. We were 14th last year in the girls and finished 15th. We knew we'd have to run (personal-records) to finish in the top five. That we didn't doesn't take away from a great effort by our kids this season."

Rock Island's Erin Copen (67th) and Galesburg's Ashley Alvarez (65th) and Samantha McCoy (80th) also failed to advance.

Taghon runs into UT record books with sectional win

He's first Panther to win cross country sectional; Moline second in team race

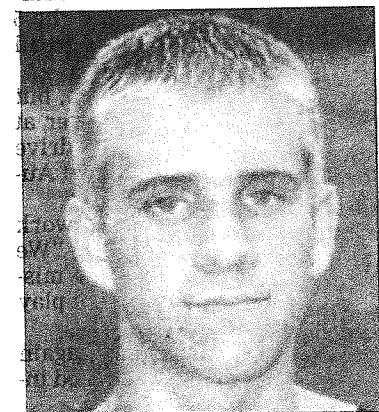

EAST PEORIA — Gatorade — it's not in Brian Taghon, at least not anymore before races.

And, since offering a negative answer to the "Is it in you?" question posed in the sports drink's commercials, the United Township senior has proven to be absolutely unbeatable in cross country.

Taghon extended his winning streak to eight straight races Saturday, outstriking Rockton Hononegah's Wolfgang Luethy in the final 150 yards to capture the championship of the Class AA East Peoria Sectional.

An 11th win in 12 outings this season made Taghon the first Panther to ever win an individual sectional crown, and allowed him to advance to next Saturday's state meet along with the Moline team.

Moline just missed its first boys' sectional crown since 1995, finishing two points behind champion Belvidere in the team race.

"I used to drink Gatorade all the time," Taghon said after a five-second victory on a hilly, 2.95-mile course at Illinois Central College. "But, in the only race I haven't won this year, I suffered side cramps the last mile at the Peoria Woodruff Invitational (on Sept. 8) and had like 10 guys pass me. We couldn't figure out what happened for sure, so I switched to drinking just water before races and that's worked so far."

Like his pre-race liquid of choice, Taghon did his best work Saturday running downhill. In fact, the winning burst followed the last of several inclines.

"I was really struggling up that last hill, but I managed to stay with (Luethy), and then I knew I had him," said Taghon, who won in a time of 15:24.

"To me, (Luethy) was the favorite coming in, but I thought I

had a better kick. So, my plan was to take advantage of all the downhill for speed, and attack him then, and it worked out perfectly in the end for me."

Moline's strategy of a pack mentality was almost as effective.

From Mike Verre's 20th-place finish (16th in the team chase) to fellow sophomore Alex Hutchins' 37th-place showing (31st in the team race), the Maroons had their five scoring runners cross the line 23 seconds apart.

After Verre (16:20), Kyle Medinger (16:26), Erik Steffens (16:35), Mike Barrett (16:36) and Hutchins (16:43), Moline also had No. 6 Craig Frederiksen (17:00) finish ahead of Belvidere's fifth runner.

However, the Bucs (117 points) managed to edge the Maroons (119), thanks to Belvidere's top two runners finishing fifth and sixth individually.

Verre blamed himself for not finishing higher. Moline coach Jeff Quick quickly rejected that claim, noting there was not much more a group featuring four sophomore and a freshman could have done.

"It's disappointing to the kids because we were so close, but it's not the first time it's ever happened to me, and I can tell you from experience it's not the end of the world," Quick said about settling for second.

"All that matters is that we made it to state with a very young group. That's cause for celebration. Not many teams get to go where we're going. All we have to do is look into the faces of our girls' team to remember how special it is to qualify." Favored to win the girls race — which preceded the boys' title chase — Moline finished a disappointing eighth and didn't advance.

"That takes away something from this. It's hard to celebrate with them not going," Verre said. "We'll be excited when we get there next weekend. It'll be fun at state. But, it's not the best feeling right now."

Rockton Hononegah (132), Rockford Jefferson (133) and Pekin (176) were the other schools advancing to state.

United Township (10th at 252) and NCIC champ Geneseo (12th at 274) missed advancing as teams. Geneseo was also shut out in qualifying individuals to state, with Kyle Fluck coming closest — finishing 16th overall and six seconds from a qualifying spot.

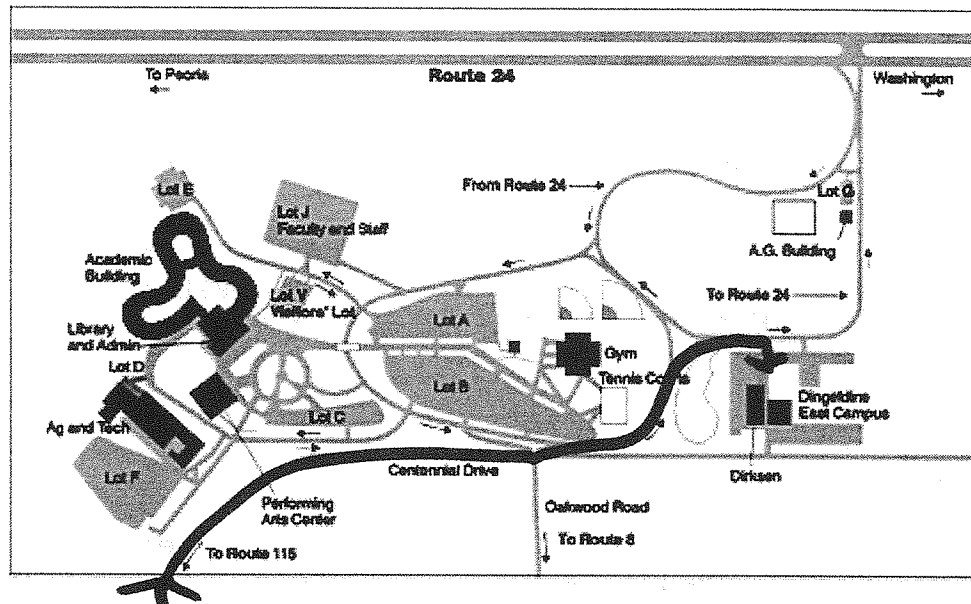
Rock Island's Will Moeller (87th in 17:29) and J. Galesburg's Bill Johnson (79th in 17:19) also failed to book solo trips to state.

"We're a young team and we wanted that state experience because it's priceless, but it's not for a lack of trying that we didn't get there," Geneseo coach Don Fredricks said.

"(Fluck) barely missed, but I had a smile on my face and a tear in my eye because he gave it his all. He'll be better because of this next season. We'll all be better. The future looks bright for us."
