Steffens lone AA girls' state cross country qualifier

EAST PEORIA — As if Jill Steffens needed any more motivation to run well at state next weekend, the Moline senior had six more reasons unexpectedly crop up Saturday.

Steffens booked a return trip to state, but her six cross-country teammates did not follow suit, as pre-race favorite Moline finished a disappointing eighth in the Class AA East Peoria Sectional.

Even Steffens didn't live up to expectations, entirely, on the hilly, 2.68-mile Illinois Central College course. She failed to win medalist honors for just the fourth time in 13 races, finishing fifth behind some competition she'd already beaten earlier this season.

"I'm thankful I have a second chance to rebound from a bad day. It's devastating my team does not." Steffens said after finishing 31 seconds off the winning pace of 16:10 set by East Peoria's Rachael Lowe. "Now, I'm not just running for myself next weekend, I'm running for them, too.

"I don't know what happened. Maybe the pressure got to us because everybody was pointing to us. I don't know. I just know personally when the gun went off, I tried to go with Lowe and my legs just wouldn't move. I couldn't run like I'm used to."

Ditto for her teammates.

"We just didn't fire on all cylinders," Moline coach Jeff Quick said. "We easily had our worst race of the year at the worst time of

year, for several reasons.'

For starters, the Maroons were missing seventh-runner Jessica Conklin because of a family emergency. Injuries this season left the cupboard bare of replacements.

Thus, Moline had six runners where most teams had seven, with the top five counting.

Of those six Maroons, though, two were hurting — Jenna McAdam was run-

ning with her asthma acting up and Anne Gloeckner competed with a case of stomach flu. McAdam finished 106th (92nd in the team race) and Gloeckner was a second back in 108th (93rd) to round out Moline's scoring.

"We might have overcome one of those problems." Quick said, "but not all three."

Jessica Griffin, last week's regional runner-up and an all-state hopeful like Steffens, also finished a disappointing 17th and missed advancing as an individual by 11 seconds.

"We worked so hard this year, we've never been more ready for this," Steffens said dejectedly. "We qualified for state as a team my freshman and junior years, and we were five times the team this year. We finished second last year at the sectional on this same course, and we don't even make it out this year? It just doesn't add up."

Hence, Steffens will be the lone local representative at Detweiller Park next Saturday.

Moline had 232 points to finish well behind the five advancing teams — Metamora (73 points), East Peoria (148), Freeport (170), Belvidere (172) and Peoria Notre Dame (195).

NCIC champ Geneseo (12th at 287) and United Township (15th at 344) also failed to advance as a team, and did not have any individual qualifiers.

Ashley Colo, a regional medalist for the Leafs last week, finished 48th while running sick, which didn't help Geneseo's team chances.

"It wasn't because of a lack of effort; we just picked a bad time to have a bad race," Geneseo coach Don Fredricks said. "It's very disappointing for our girls, especially our seniors — Jann Johnson, Jenny Mosher and Karin Skelton. The others will come back next year and have a chance to redeem themselves; our seniors will not."

Christine Cooney, an all-Western Big 6 performer, was UT's highest finisher, coming in 37th place.

"Our goal program-wide was to do better at sectional than we did last year with better teams, and for the most part we did that," said UT coach Kevin Stuckwisch. "We were 11th last year in the boys and finished 10th this time. We were 14th last year in the girls and finished 15th. We knew we'd have to run (personal-records) to finish in the top five. That we didn't doesn't take away from a great effort by our kids this season."

Rock Island's Erin Copen (67th) and Galesburg's Ashley Alvarez (65th) and Samantha McCoy (80th) also failed to advance.

EAST PEORIA — Gatorade — it's not in Brian Taghon, at least not anymore before races.


And, since offering a negative answer to the "Is it in you?" question posed in the sports drink's commercials, the United Township senior has proven to be absolutely unbeatable in cross country.


Rock Island's Will Moeller (87th in 17:29) and Galesburg's Bill Johnson (79th in 17:19) also failed to book solo trips to state.


EAST PEORIA CAMPUS MAP
