

Girls CC wins home invite

The Geneseo girls cross country team made a strong showing at the Geneseo Invitational on Saturday.

By sticking together on the course they took wins against Rochelle and Streator.

Becky Johnson and Ashley Colo went 2-3 in the race, finishing behind Sarah Nordman of Rochelle. Johnson ran a 21:25 while Colo finished just one second behind her.

Amanda Hoste, Katie Croegaert and Missy Holevoet had times of 22:07, 22:29 and 23:10.

Geneseo swept seven of the top eight places in the fresh-soph race.

Erica Brenny won with a 22:42, followed by teammates

Abbey Schlindwein, Alison Curran, Kayla McVetty, Erin Browne, Holly Hanson and Allie Minnaert.

On Monday, the girls dropped a tight race against Princeton, losing 30 to 29.

Princeton girls swept the top three slots in the race, while Geneseo held down places five through nine.

And though Princeton had a large gap between its third place and fourth place finisher (nearly two minutes and 12 places) it was not enough for Geneseo to overcome.

Geneseo easily handled the two other teams in the dual meet. The Maple Leafs topped Mendota 20-41 and Rock Falls 15 to 48.

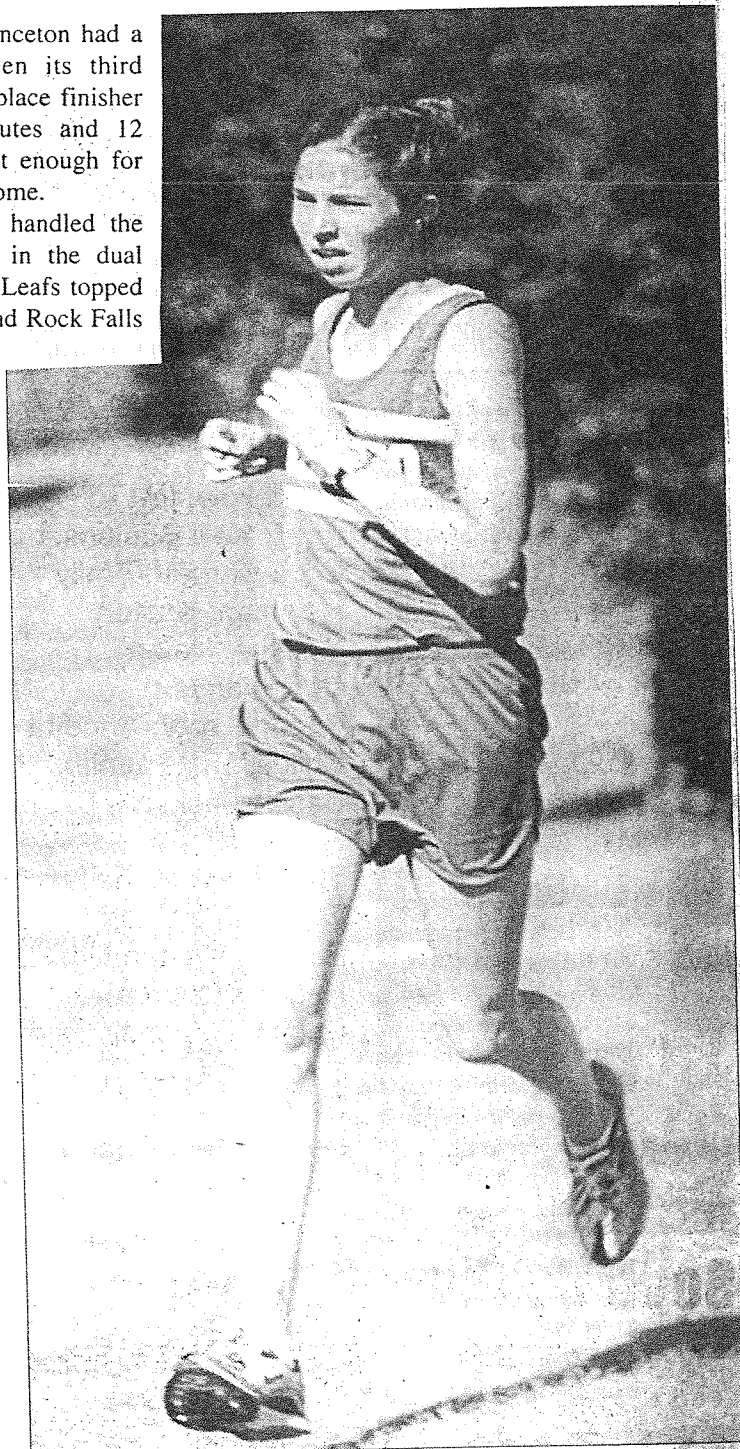

TIME	Girls Varsity.....9:00 a.m. Boys Varsity.....9:30 a.m. Girls Frosh-Soph.....10:00 a.m. Boys Frosh-Soph.....10:30 a.m.
TEAMS ENTERED	Geneseo Rochelle Streator We are limiting the size of the schools in an attempt to create a "middle class" type meet.
COURSE	3.00 Miles for all races. The course is almost entirely on grass and has two substantial hills.
TOURS	The course will be marked with arrows, flags, and cones. Parts of the course are repeated, so allow plenty of time to tour the course. Spikes or flats are allowed.
COACHES REPORT	As soon as you arrive at the meet, coaches should report to the pavilion at the top of the "valley hill" to pick up your team packet.
BOX ASSIGNMENTS	Will be available on race day.
START OF MEET	An air horn will blow 15 minutes before the race is about to begin. A second horn will blow five minutes before the race is to begin.
RESTROOMS	Restrooms are available but there are no dressing facilities.
WATER	Drinking fountains are available in the park.
FINISH	The finish will be the narrow part of the chute.
SCORING	You may enter as many or as few runners as you wish in each race. For the purpose of team scoring, only the top 5 runners of each school will score. All runners will bump.
AWARDS	Team trophies will be awarded to the top 3 teams in each race. Medals will be given to the top 20 finishers in each race. (As the size of the meet grows, this will be increased to medals for the top 25 finishers and 25 ribbons for runners who finish in 26 th to 50 th place.) The awards presentation will take place at the pavilion at the top of the "valley hill".

Leafs boys CC take first place at invitational

The Geneseo boys cross country team placed well in its own invitational over the weekend. And the Maple Leafs followed up their victory on Monday with wins over Mendota, Princeton and Rock Falls.

At the Geneseo Invitational, the varsity and the frosh-soph team swept first place in their events, sweeping Rochelle and Streator.

Justin Trujillo placed first in the varsity race, followed by his teammate Kyle Fluck. Trujillo's time over the three miles was 16:45, three seconds better than Fluck.

Christian Rowlands placed fourth in the race with a time of 18:13, and Nathan Schlindwein and Brad Mattan went 7th and 8th with times of 18:37 and 18:44 respectively.

Geneseo's team score of 22 bettered Rochelle's 49 and

Streator's 52.

In the fresh-soph race Geneseo dominated the race, taking the top nine spots.

Sophomore Bill Barton won the race with a time of 19:13, followed by Jordan Wildermuth, Justin Ogilvie, David Cross and Jeff Williams.

T.J. Lyttles and Pete Nelson rounded out the top nine for the Maple Leafs.

On Monday, Senior Kyle Fluck had a very strong performance with a 16:09.

Justin Trujillo, Christian Rowlands, Nathan Schlindwein and Steve Loftus rounded out the scoring for Geneseo.

They beat Princeton 16-47, Mendota 16-47 and Rock Falls 20-41.

The race was run at Lake Mendota, the site of the upcoming NCIC conference championship.
