Leaf girls wins 7th straight NCIC cross-country title

MENDOTA Freshman Rachel Wyffels ran the fastest time for the Geneseo girls' cross country team Saturday at Lake Mendota, but it was those behind her who came up biggest.

As important as Wyffels' third-place showing at the North Central Illinois Conference was, it was the ability of the Maple Leafs' "Gang of Four" that kept Geneseo's string of conference championships going.

The Leafs' No. 2 through 5 runners - sophomore Amanda Hoste, freshman Kayla McVietty, sophomore Katie Croegaert and junior Becky Johnson — all finished within seven seconds of one another, allowing Geneseo to overcome challenges from Sterling and Princeton and win its seventh straight girls title.

"The plan was to have Rachel lead and those girls just lock on to each other, and they fought to stay together," Leafs coach Don Fredericks said. "That made it seven in a row for us. We've had a few nailbiters in there, but we're pretty proud of that streak,'

On the boys side, senior Kyle Fluck repeated as the NCIC's individual champion, but the Leafs couldn't overcome five top-16 runs from Dixon. The Dukes outpointed Geneseo, 50-57, for the team title.

Fluck and junior teammate Justin Trujillo went out early, along with Rochelle's Matt Jacobson and Dixon's Kel Bond. At the mile mark, Fluck took control of the race and was never challenged, winning by 17 seconds over Jacobson.

"At the mile mark, I just started taking it, and I felt Jacobson go with me. I was able to run my own race, though," Fluck said. "It feels good (to defend), but it's not the same feeling as last year. Last year, I came out of nowhere and we won as a team."

Trujillo faded back slightly, but he and teammate Christian Rowlands both earned all-NCIC honors with at least a top-15 finish. Trujillo was fifth and Rowlands seventh in what was one of Rowlands' strongest races of his career.

In the girls race, Wyffels never could get close to co-leaders Rebekah Faber of Princeton and Jessica Schauff of Dixon. but broke away from the next trailing pack with about a mile and a half to go.

"It went pretty well. I was just trying to pass some people and then I got into third," Wyffels said of her race.

Then, the Leafs' pack secured the victory once Wyffels opened up the possibility.

"Our tradition is always in the back of our minds when we run. We didn't want (last year's) seniors to look down on us, Hoste, who wound up as the pack leader on Saturday, said. 'So when one of us got a surge, the rest of us went with that person. We just fed off that energy."

Remarkable. That word could be used to describe the feat the Geneseo girl cross country team pulled off last week. The team ran to their seventh straight NCIC title last weekend at Mendota.

Freshman Rachel Wyffels finished third overall for Geneseo with a time of 19:04.96 in the three mile.

As impressive as Wyffels time was the performance the other Leafs turned out.

Amanda Hoste, Kayla McVietty, Katie Croegaert, and Becky Johnson finished 12 through 15 overall to give the Leafs enough points to top Sterling and Princeton.

"Our guys made a courageous effort to take second place," Fredericks said.

"We were only seven points behind Dixon, which is very close," Fredericks added.

Fluck won the race convincingly, winning by 17 seconds over Rochelle's Matt Jacobson. Justin Trujillo finished fifth overall and Christian Rowlands placed seventh for the Leafs. For finishing in the top fifteen, both are also all-conference.

Fluck's winning time was 15:47.38, while Trujillo finished in 16:23.55.

Rowlands finished the three miles in 16:51.01.

Also competing for the Leafs were Brad Mattan, who took 20th place with a time of

17:40.13 and Nathan Schlindwein, who took 24th with a time of 17:53.68.

Steve Loftus placed 30th with a time of 18:09.55 and Cody Haars rounded out the Leafs scoring with a 46th place finish with a time of 18:42.38.


In a dominating performance, the Leafs won four out of five conference titles.
