■ **Princeton Invite:** Led by top 10 finisher Katie Croegaert, Geneseo dominated the girls' competition, winning the team title with 51 points to outdistance runner-up Princeton (100).

Croegaert came in sixth with a clocking of 20:08, nearly two minutes behind first-place Rebekah Faber of Princeton (18:21). Teammates Ashley Colo (11th, 20:47) and Becky Johnson (12th, 20:48) narrowly missed top 10 placings.

Orion tallied 240 points to place seventh, led by Kristin Peterson's 20th-place run of 21:10.

In the boys' competition, Dixon tallied 56 points to take first. Geneseo was third with 96 points, nine behind runner-up Rockford Christian. Sherard placed fifth with 141 points.
