

Q-C coaches show cooperation

with joint meet

Saturday's IHSA regional cross country meets at Credit Island Park in Davenport are certainly going to be unique.

Unique enough that long-time Moline coach Jeff Quick sees them as historic, after a fashion.

"I don't think it's ever been done before," Quick said of Saturday's events, which mark the first time that Class A and AA regional meets have been held at the same site.

The meet is being jointly hosted by Alleman and Moline High Schools, with Alleman serving as Class A host and Moline as the AA host.

"We've tossed around the idea for a couple of years now," Alleman coach Mike Ethington said. "We asked the IHSA for permission to do it (a joint meet) earlier this year."

The jointly-run competition also continues a spirit of cooperation between schools and coaches that began at last week's Western Big 6 meet, hosted by Rock Island.

"Mike and I helped (Rock Island coach) Michelle (Menke-Lillis) set up the course last week. This week, Mike and I will set up the course ourselves, and she'll be in charge of entries and results," Quick said. "It showed an ability to work together to run a meet in the best interests of the kids."

Having the same site for both A and AA regional meets certainly made sense from a geographic standpoint.

"Most of these teams are within an hour of the Quad-Cities," Ethington said. "In fact, most are right here. It just makes sense to host a meet here."

Other considerations, too, entered into the decision, which was first pursued by Quick, Ethington, and their athletic directors, Alleman's Larry Schulte and Moline's Todd Rosenthal, in June of this year.

"Our problem was finding a place to race. Many golf courses charge an exorbitant amount of money, so we looked to Credit Island. The cooperation we got from the Davenport Park District was just tremendous," Quick said. "You need to have a site big enough that can handle the number of kids there, plus you need to be able to set up camps and be able to get to shelter, if need be."

The format will be very similar to the upcoming state meet, with A girls leading off Saturday morning, followed by A boys, AA girls and then AA boys.

And, if all goes well on Saturday, it could mean that either the Pioneers or Maroons could be the host team for a sectional meet in the future. Local sites other than Credit Island have not been able to support the number of runners that participate at the sectional level.

And, it wouldn't bother Quick, at least, to move the current sectional site, Illinois Central College in East Peoria, to another location.

"It's terrible. It's not good for the kids at all," Quick said. "The state meet course is a speed course, so why have a course with hills and stuff be the sectional course? If state were on a hilly course, then it might be OK, but as long as Detweiller (Park, in Peoria) is the state course, every course that leads up to it should be a speed course. Every single meet we've run up to that point prepares us for Detweiller."

Credit Island certainly would be included in that group.

And, it's a wide-open course, which also is a plus.

After preview of plaque,

Moline hopes to run to title

Moline cross country coach Jeff Quick opened Wednesday's practice by totting in an unusual exhibit to Wharton Field House, where the Maroons dress and begin practices.

He gave his teams a look at the 2002 regional championship plaque.

"I offered them a chance to touch it before Geneseo comes in and takes it on Saturday," Quick said, perhaps only half-kiddingly.

Deprecating humor aside, it's still very likely that it will be Moliners hoisting the plaques at the end of competition in Saturday's Class AA meet at Credit Island Park (11 a.m. girls start time, 11:35 a.m. boys).

At least that's the way that prospective plaque-taker Don Fredericks, the Maple Leafs' cross country coach, sees it.

"I've seen Moline have a bad day once in a while, but every time they bounce back, and ferociously so," Fredericks said. "They are still the extremely heavy favorite in both races. I fully expect that Moline will bounce back from last week."

Still, the Maroons' runner-up showing at last Friday's Western Big 6 meet in both boys' and girls' competition prompted some heart-to-heart talks in the Moline camp.

"We had a major team meeting on Monday, boys and girls combined," Quick said. "(Friday) was one of the low-

est points in my coaching career. I'm getting down to the end of my tenure (he expects to step down after the 2003-04 season) and I want these kids to have the same kinds of experiences I've had.

"(Assistant coach) Tauwon (Taylor) and I were both all-state, and we did it for Moline. It's a pride thing. We want to be keeping the Moline tradition going."

Still, the Maroons — who hadn't lost to any downstate team before last weekend and who haven't finished worse than second in the Big 6 during Quick's tenure — will be the team everyone shoots at in team competitions.

Quite possibly, it'll be Moline runners that win both individual races as well.

"They're the heavy favorite — all capitals, boldface type. The whole nine yards," Fredericks said of the Maroons' boys team. "Obviously, they just had things go south on them Friday night."

After Moline, the metro school with the best chance to advance both boys' and girls' teams to next weekend's sectional meet in Sterling might be the Maple Leafs.

"If we don't get both teams through, we'll be very disappointed," Fredericks said. "We would like to win the meets, of course, but the No. 1 goal is to survive and go on to sectionals."

The Maple Leafs rank a strong second behind Moline in the girls' race, coming off their seventh straight NCIC league championship.

Look for United Township and the Leaf boys to move through to sectionals with top-5 finishes or better on Saturday.

Rock Island's boys might also have the pack strength to qualify, while, on the girls' side, UT and the Rocks could advance if either Galesburg or Rochelle, or both, has a subpar meet.

Out of the area, Dixon's boys are a solid choice to advance as a team, while Sterling's girls should also finish in the top three.

"Ideally, you'd like to get all four metro teams through — us, Moline, Rock Island and UT," Fredericks said. "All of us would like to win, but we'll all pull for each other, too."

Individually, Moline runners Kyle Medinger, Erik Steffens and Drew Patterson will battle with Geneseo's Kyle Fluck and Rochelle's Matt Jacobson for the boys' championship.

"It'll be interesting to see how it plays out," Fredericks said of the individual competition for first. "The horses will be up there for this."


In the girls race, Dixon's Jessica Schauff, who was impressive in nearly breaking 18 minutes at the NCIC meet last weekend, is the favorite.

Any one of five Moline runners — Ashley Hartson, Jenna McAdam, Anne Gloeckner, Brittany Minor and Jessica Griffin — also could challenge, as will Geneseo's Rachel Wyffels and Rock Island's Carmin Green.

Should UT not advance as a team in girls' competition, look for the Panthers' top two runners, April Archibald and Sam Shryack, to advance to sectionals as individuals, as well as Green and

Laura Vandemoortel from Rock Island.

The top five teams and top five individuals not on a qualifying team will advance to the Sterling sectional on November 2 at Woodlawn School in Ster-

Moline's 'Quick Chicks' cruise to crown

Moline senior Jessica Griffin was tired of battling her inner demons before every cross-country race.

Instead, Griffin focused on just having fun in Saturday's IHSA Class AA Moline Regional at Credit Island Park in Davenport.

Class AA girls regional

Having fun on Saturday meant finishing fourth overall — No. 1 among Maroon runners — and leading a pack of "Quick Chicks" to their third straight regional championship. Moline outpointed Geneseo, 36-73, for the title.

Although Griffin finished in the top five at regional for the third time in her career, she still struggled with the ability to stay loose before a meet.

"I haven't been running that well this season," said Griffin, who didn't make all-Western Big 6 at last week's conference meet. "I've put in a lot of miles, but I still let the pressure get to me. Today, I just relaxed and tried to have fun."

The pressure of expectations became more of a burden this season in the absence of graduated Jill Steffens. "Last year, I didn't have pressure to win, because Jill was always there, and she was expected to win," Griffin said.

Saturday, however, all Griffin focused on was leading the Maroon pack. That she did, as four Moline runners — Ashley Hartson (fifth), Jenna McAdam (sixth) and Anne Gloeckner (eighth), along with Griffin — finished in the top 10.

"If we ran to our potential, we could win. My goal was to keep the pack together," Griffin said. "We're really close as a team. We do everything together, and we trust each other. That really helps during a race."

Moline coach Jeff Quick admitted that over-confidence might have hampered his teams at the Big 6 meet last week.

"I told them what to expect, but didn't add any intensity to it. I've been lucky over the years to communicate the need for intensity in the kids' running," Quick said. "I

made the point to them about being more focused and last week I let them all get over-confident."

Geneseo finished well ahead of third-place Sterling, thanks to an individual runner-up finish from freshman Rachel Wyffels. Wyffels became the area's fastest Class AA runner, with the first sub-19-minute time for a three-mile race (18 minutes, 52.25 seconds).

Sophomore Katie Croegaert also finished in the top 10 for the Maple Leafs.

"We've tried to get Rachel to get out a little bit faster, a little bit earlier," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said of his freshman phenom. "She's come up through the pack the last couple of weeks. She ran a tremendous race."

"Our kids really showed up today. We held out one of our varsity runners (Kayla McVetty, with a knee injury), but she'll be back next week. Ashley Colo (the Leafs' team leader) also geared it up."

Rock Island's Carmin Green and United Township's Sam Shryack and April Archibald qualified as individuals for next week's sectional meet at Sterling. Dixon's Jessica Schauf, also an individual qualifier, was the regional champion, finishing in 18:31.56.

Moline boys run with more intensity this time

Moline junior Mike Verre doesn't have the charismatic finishing kick of senior teammate Kyle Medinger. Nor does he possess the same degree of team leadership of senior co-captain Drew Patterson. Or the emotion of junior Erik Steffens.

What he showed Saturday at Credit Island Park in Davenport, site of the IHSA Class AA Moline cross-country regional, was the nagging injuries that have bothered him most of the season are no longer an issue.

In finishing third overall, Verre led the Maroon pack to the finish line and served as evidence that Moline is back, if it ever left its traditional position of leadership among area cross-country teams.

The Maroons outscored Geneseo for first place, 30-70. Four area teams moved on to next weekend's Sterling Sectional, as United Township took fourth (87 points), and Rock Island edged Galesburg for fifth, 132-151.

"It means a lot of things," Verre said of being the top Moline runner. "I have to credit the guys for encouraging me and keeping me going. Everyone on our team just pulled their own weight out there."

Verre also suggested Saturday's team performance might have been Moline's strongest of the season.

"One of the boys said the other

day that he thought we were so sure that we were going to win (the Western Big 6 meet) and we didn't put forward our best effort. Today was a good effort," Maroons coach Jeff Quick said. "We were just more intense. We ran with more purpose."

Geneseo senior Kyle Fluck also ran with a great deal of purpose on Saturday. After tailing Medinger for the race's first 1.5 miles, Fluck took the lead and was never headed, winning the individual title in 15 minutes, 22.21 seconds.

"My goal was to hang with the Moline guys early and stay close to Medinger," Fluck said. "In the second mile, it looked like he was fading, trying to hold on to the lead. I went for it, and threw it down."

Fluck defeated NCIC rival Matt Jacobson of Rochelle by 18 seconds for the title.

In taking second, the Leafs overcame a season of finishing behind Dixon, which wound up 14 points back of Geneseo.

United Township took fourth behind a ninth-place finish from Matt Simmons and top-15 runs from Kyle Cameron and Joey Ashcraft.

Rock Island's first runner was Andy Parer in 20th place, but the Rocks' pack strategy paid off with a sectional berth, as No. 5 runner Alex Seiver was just 32 seconds behind Parer.

Moline boys, girls move on

STERLING — Taking third place at Saturday's IHSA Class AA Sterling Sectional cross country meet produced some very different reactions among the members of the Moline boys' and girls' teams, as well as Maroons coach Jeff Quick.

But the bottom line is this — Moline will be sending both teams to next weekend's state meet, to be held in Peoria's Detweiller Park. Only one other school in attendance at Hoover Park, boys and girls champion Normal Community, is able to say that.

"Of course we would have liked to win, but I'm not going to be crying about not going," Quick said of his teams' effort. "It's just one of those things. As a coach, you want to see your kids run to their fullest potential. I just wish that, at some point, everyone can see how good we really are."

For the Maroon girls, third place is way better than not going to state at all, like last year.

"Last year, I was sick and finished 92nd, and we didn't go to state. We were so psyched to go and wound up being really disappointed," said senior Jenna McAdam, Moline's No. 2 runner on Saturday. "This year, I wound up 19th and we're third, so that's better. Being a senior, that just puts more motivation in me to go harder next week."

McAdam had a lot to do with the Maroons' third-place finish. After staying in the pack for quite a while, she made a late

charge to crack the top 20.

"I didn't want to go out too fast, but when I started to pass people, it really got me motivated," McAdam said. "This is one of the hardest sectionals in the state to get out of. We'll just have to keep motivating each other this week."

As it turned out, Moline was only two points behind runnerup Metamora, finishing with 110 points. Normal Community was first with 83.

The other two team qualifiers were Normal West (129) and East Peoria (175). Normal West's Meghan Braffet was the individual champion, winning the race by 38 seconds in 17 minutes, 53 seconds.

The Maroon boys were extremely close to pulling off a championship, even though senior co-captain Drew Patterson has only been able to run on race days and junior Erik Steffens was battling a severe cold.

Champion Normal Community finished just 12 points ahead of the Maroons, 122-134, with Belvidere sliding just inside the Maroons with 131, good for second place. Rockford Jefferson and Rockton Hononegah each scored 156 points to take the final two team slots.

The Maroons' No. 1 runner, eighth-place senior Kyle Medinger,

didn't take much cheer from finishing close to the winners.

"We just need more of a team effort next week. We've got to run together better. If we see somebody fall back, we've got to make sure to pick them up. We only have one more week at this," Medinger said. "If we can get everyone healthy, and everyone comes together as a team, we might be able to surprise some people (at state)."

Moline will be the only local school sending full teams to Detweiller Park.

Geneseo finished seventh in both boys and girls competition, but did move three individuals on to state.

"I can't ask for anything more than my teams gave me today," Maple Leafs coach Don Fredericks said. "They ran their best races at conference, then improved on that last weekend at sectionals, and did even better than that today."

United Township's boys team wound up 13th on Saturday, with a team score of 301. The Panthers' No. 1 runner, Matt Simmons, completed a very strong season with a solid 15th-place finish in the individual race, crossing the finish line in 16 minutes, 17 seconds. He was only eight seconds out of qualifying for a state berth.

Rock Island's boys team finished 18th as a team, with a team score of 459. Troy Whitcanack (81st overall) was the Rocks' first runner. In the girls meet, Galesburg finished 17th, with Ashley Johnson crossing first in 47th place.

The Moline Maroons took first place with a team score of 36, compared to the Leafs' 73.

Freshman Rachel Wyffels led the Leafs with a runner-up finish behind Dixon's Jessica Schauff.

Wyffels finished the three mile race in 18 minutes,

52.25 seconds for the Leafs.

"I was very pleased with the effort of the team," said Leafs coach Don Fredericks.

"Wyffels just ran a tremendous race. That was the best race of her life, and her first time under nineteen minutes," Fredericks added.

Leafs sophomore Katie Croegaert finished ninth with a time of 19:32.82.

"Katie Croegaert had a great race also," Fredericks noted.

Coach Fredericks added that he was happy with everyone on the team.

"All of our kids really

showed up," Fredericks said.

"We held out Kayla McVetty with a knee injury, but she'll be back this weekend for Sectionals."

"We just didn't want to take any chances with her," Fredericks added.

Also for the Leafs, Becky Johnson took 16th place with a time of 19:56.06, and Amanda Hoste took 22nd place with a time of 20:18.31.

Ashley Colo finished 24th for the Leafs with a time of 20:28.32, while Allie Minnaert took 34th, finishing

in 21:19.01.

Abbey Schlindwein rounded out the scoring for Geneseo with a 45th place finish with a time of 22:28.70.

Moline, Sterling, Galesburg and Rochelle also qualified as a team for next weekend's Sterling Sectional.

"Some of the other girls were a little under the weather, but second place to Moline--hey, we'll take it," Fredericks added.

Next, the Maple Leafs will run at the Sterling Sectional on Saturday at 10:30 a.m. at the Woodlawn School.



Fluck runs to regional crown

Leafs take second as team, Sterling Sectional this weekend

What started out as a battle of the Kyle's turned into a no contest last Saturday at the Class AA Boys Moline Regional at Davenport's Credit Island Park.

Early in the race Kyle Medinger of Moline held a small lead over the Leaf's Kyle Fluck.

That lead would only last half way through the race though, as Fluck turned it on and won the race convincingly.

Fluck finished in 15 minutes, 22.21 seconds for the regional championship.

"It feels really good to be regional champ," Fluck said.

"I didn't know if I could pull it off, but I did," he added.

At the half way point, Fluck passed Medinger for good.

"He (Medinger) began to

fade, so I took off," Fluck said.

At race time, the temperature was only 48 degrees outside, but that didn't matter to Fluck.

"I kind of like the cold weather," Fluck added.

At the two mile mark, Fluck took off his stocking hat and threw it down.

"That was kind of my sign for throwing the hammer down," Fluck said.

Fluck topped Rochelle's Matt Jacobson by 18 seconds.

Geneseo placed second overall as a team to Moline 30-70.

"Kyle Fluck ran a great race, just a very impressive run," Coach Don Fredericks said.

"From top to bottom, all seven guys ran really strong," Fredericks added.

"Justin Trujillo had been battling a head cold all week and before the race, he wasn't sure if he could even line up for us.

"But he ends up getting fifth place and probably the best race of his life," Fredericks added.

At the NCIC meet, Dixon took first, narrowly edging the Leafs.

This time around, Geneseo placed 14 points ahead of the Dukes.

Trujillo placed fifth overall for the Leafs with a time of 16:07.03.

Christian Rowlands finished twelfth overall with a time of 16:34.48.

Also for Geneseo, Nathan Schlindwein took nineteenth with a time of 16:58.74, while teammate Brad Mattan finished 33rd with a time of 17:34.56.

T.J. Lyttes finished 41st with a time of 17:54.22, and Steve Loftus took 52nd place with a time of 18:18.48.

Besides Moline and Geneseo, United Township and Rock Island will also move on to the Sterling Sectional next weekend.

Moline is led by Medinger, junior Mike Verre, senior Drew Patterson, and junior Erik Steffens.

Coach Fredericks encourages everyone to come over to Sterling Saturday morning before the football game and cheer on the cross country team.

Fluck, too, is ready for this weekend.

"I know it's going to be a tough race for the individual championship, but I think I can get at least top five."

The Leafs will run at the Sterling Sectional on Saturday at Woodlawn. The boys will run at 11:30 a.m. after the girls race.

Fluck tosses hat in ring as contender

STERLING — When his trademark Geneseo Maple Leafs stocking cap comes off, it's go time for senior Kyle Fluck and danger time for anyone in front of him.

"I threw my hat to my brother with a little over a half-mile to go, and then I just went for it," Fluck said of his fourth-place individual finish at Saturday's IHSA Class AA sectional meet at Hoover Park in Sterling. "I had a head cold on Thursday and I'm still a little sick today, but I dug deep and pulled it out."

The finish sends Fluck to next weekend's state meet in Detwiler Park in Peoria. But as impressive as Fluck's showing was, equally impressive were the efforts of schoolmates Justin Trujillo and Rachel Wyffels.

Trujillo, a junior, finished 10th in the boys race and Wyffels, a freshman, was ninth in the girls race. Both of them will join Fluck as individual state qualifiers next weekend.

"There's a lot of schools who would like to have that kind of 1-2 punch at the top," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said of his Nos. 1 and 2 boys runners.

Fluck went out with the pack of runners that trailed wire-to-wire race winner Trent Hoerr of Morton. But, in the race's second

mile, Fluck dropped back a bit, to eighth place.

His state berth would still have been assured with that finish, but that wasn't where he wanted to end up, especially after NCIC rival Matt Jacobson of Rochelle, who Fluck had beaten each of the past two weeks, passed him.

"That blew me away when he passed me. I went out fast, and I got a little ahead of myself,"

Fluck said. "During the second mile, I was just trying to hang on."

And Trujillo needed that kick, which came thanks to his middle-distance speed on the track, in order to nab the last individual state berth. He beat Bloomington's Andy Kubiak by three seconds, but had to sprint past "at least five or so' runners in the last 200 meters to do it.

"I wasn't going to let Fluck go by himself," Trujillo, still in a bit of shock after the race, said of qualifying. "I was praying the whole time I was out there, that I could make it to state."

Trujillo was in the 20-30 range

with about a mile to go, and made a furious charge to get into the state field.

Called "The Phenom" in Geneseo for the past two years now, a soft-spoken Wyffels proved she could hold her own against some of the state's best runners.

"From the beginning, I thought it was something that maybe I could do, but I wasn't sure if it would come true," Wyffels said of earning a state berth. "I'm really happy. I'm excited about going to state."


The spectacle of the sectional meet, which typically puts 160 runners on to the field of competition, with drums playing throughout the race, didn't faze the Geneseo freshman. She stayed with the group of runners trailing eventual winner Meghan Braffet of Normal West, and moved up from 12th at the mile to her eventual ninth-place spot.

"I thought that was pretty cool," Wyffels said of the atmosphere of the race. "But when I was out there, I didn't think much about it."

Other individual sectional qualifiers didn't fare so well on Saturday. Rock Island's Carmin Green completed her high school career with an 80th-place finish in the girls race, while April Archibald was 90th and United Township's Sam Shryack 97th.




Way to go Geneseo harriers!
