

Mock meets make Maroons sectional favorites

Moline cross country coach Jeff Quick knew who to go to in figuring out who might pose the biggest threats to his Maroons at Saturday's IHSA Class AA sectional meet in Sterling.

He called upon junior Ted Nocella, one of Moline's top five boys' runners, and Nocella came up with the legwork.

"These kids are smart enough to be able to figure these things out," Quick said. "They can go on the Internet and be able to tell almost right away how they're going to match up next week."

Now Quick can tell you, with some help from his junior math whiz, that he expects Normal Community — both their boys' and girls' teams — to pose the biggest challenge on Saturday.

Quick and Nocella are just a part of a phenomenon that starts to occur among coaches and participants at this time of year.

After the regional meets are concluded, teams and individuals — and certainly their coaches — that have moved on to sectionals check where they stand by putting together a "mock meet," which determines sectional standing based on regional times.

Quick's, and Moline's, situation is a little bit different.

"We've run all these teams already," Quick said of the 20 teams that qualified for sectional in both boys' and girls' competition. "That's why we go where we do, to get an idea of what we're going to face this weekend."

If you go to the Class AA sectional

■ What: IHSA Class AA sectional cross country meet.

■ When & where: Saturday at Hoover Park, behind Woodlawn School, in Sterling. The girls race is scheduled for 10:30 a.m., with the boys scheduled for 11:30 a.m.

■ Directions (from Quad-Cities): Take I-88 to IL-40 exit (Sterling-Rock Falls). Follow IL-40 toward Sterling. Turn right at first one-way, which is IL-2, just across

the Rock River. Follow to Woodlawn, turn right at Woodlawn (McDonald's is nearby). School is about a mile down the road on the right. Prepare to park on the road, especially if you are a late arrival.

■ At stake: Five teams and seven individuals from non-qualifying (possibly as many as 10, depending on who finishes in the top 10) advance to next weekend's state meet at Detweiller Park in Peoria.

In fact, the way the regionals fed into Saturday's sectional meet didn't surprise Quick much at all.

"The only thing that came in as a surprise was Bloomington," Quick said of his team's prospective competition.

And, both past experience and last weekend's regional numbers tell Moline that it should be favored to win both the boys' and girls' team competitions, although the Maroons will get a challenge from Normal Community.

East Peoria, too, could be a threat to the Maroon girls, but not necessarily based on the way they ran at regionals.

"We were at a meet earlier in the year where East Peoria put four runners ahead of our first," Quick said. "It depends on which team shows up."

The same could be said for the Maroons, who rallied well from a disappointing showing at the Western Big 6 meet two weeks ago with resounding team victories at Credit Island Park last weekend.

"The conference meet taught us not to assume anything," Quick said of Moline's first downstate loss of the season. "Instead of remember the Alamo, for us it's remember the Big 6."

Looking good for Leafs

The raw data also looks good for Geneseo. After finishing second to the Maroons in both the boys' and girls' regional meets, the Maple Leafs might very well send both teams to state, if they can duplicate times similar to their regional effort.

Coach Don Fredericks said that his teams aren't seeded to make it to state, but research done by The Dispatch and The Rock Island Argus showed that the Leafs were seeded third in boys' competition, and just one point out of fifth in girls'.

He cautioned that trying to figure out seeds based solely on regional times can be deceiving.

"It can make you over-confident if it ranks you highly, and at the same time, it can make you feel like the challenge is just insurmountable if it ranks you low. We give the kids a realistic goal," Fredericks said. "(Working up a mock meet) told us that we're in the ballpark. Things can happen to get the Maple Leafs in the state finals. But we're going to have do some good things and we're going to need a little help."

Should Geneseo not send its teams to state, the Leafs might very well end up sending senior Kyle Fluck and freshman Rachel Wyffels as individual qualifiers.


Fluck, in particular, continues to get stronger as the weather gets colder.

"Kyle has a tremendous amount of momentum working for him right now," Fredericks said. "We're really excited about that."

There will be a strong Quad-Cities flavor in the meet Saturday. Four metro boys teams — the Maroons, Leafs, United Township and Rock Island — are represented, as well as two girls teams (Moline and Geneseo) and individual qualifiers Carmin Green of Rock Island and Sam Shryack and April Archibald of United Township.





Wyffels advances to state meet

Freshman finishes ninth overall, Leafs take seventh as team

Placing ninth at the Sterling Sectional is a pretty big accomplishment for any high school harrier.

But doing it as a freshman—that is even more impressive.

That feat was accomplished by Geneseo's Rachel Wyffels last weekend at Woodlawn Park in Sterling.

By placing ninth, Wyffels qualified to run at the state meet this weekend at Detweiller Park in Peoria.

"Rachel had the race of her life--she just ran awesome," Coach Don Fredericks said.

"She got out early, put herself in the top ten, and then just hung on," Fredericks added.

Wyffels finished the 3.04 mile course in 19:01.

The Leafs freshman stayed towards the front of the pack throughout and at the mile mark moved up from twelve to ninth.

From that point on, Wyffels held onto the ninth place spot and cruised to the finish line.

Wyffels said that the weather didn't affect her last week, but she hopes it's a little warmer this weekend.

"She ran with a lot of composure and confidence, as a freshman. It was very inspiring and I'm excited about her opportunities," Fredericks added.

Like the boys team, the Leafs girls team took seventh place.

Katie Crogaert finished

42nd for the Leafs with a time of 19:57, while teammate Becky Johnson took 59th with a time of 20:14.

Ashley Colo finished at 60th with a time of 20:16 and Amanda Hoste finished at 69th with a time of 20:33.

Also for the Leafs, Abbey Schlindwein took 96th with a time of 21:08, while Allie Minnaert finished 104th with a time of 21:19.

Fredericks added that he was pleased with the way all the girls ran.

"I'm proud of all of them, they really fought every step of the way," he added.

Wyffels will run at the Class AA State meet this Saturday at 11 a.m. at Detweiller Park in Peoria.

"I'm really excited about going to state," Wyffels said.

"I just hope I can make the top 100," Wyffels added.

Coach Fredericks summed up his feelings on the Sterling Sectional.

"Both teams ran exceptionally well. We went to the meet with the expectations of both teams qualifying. That didn't happen, so we're a little disappointed.

"But at the same time, I'm very proud, both teams left it all on the course, they ran as hard as they could."

"I'm extremely proud of both teams, they just came so close. I think we mixed it up real well with the bigger schools," Fredericks added.

Fluck, Trujillo going to state

Leafs take seventh place at Sterling Sectional last weekend

Geneseo's Kyle Fluck and Justin Trujillo have done it.

It would be qualifying for the IHSA State Meet this weekend at Peoria's Detweiller Park.

Fluck took home fourth place and Trujillo placed tenth at the Sterling Sectional last Saturday at Woodlawn Park to advance to state.

"I'm just happy that I advanced," Fluck said.

"I was satisfied, but I wasn't. I didn't feel the greatest, and I think I went out a little too quickly," Fluck added.

Fluck noted that he was sick Thursday with a head cold.

After his quick start, Fluck fell back to eighth place at the two mile mark.

After seeing several people pass him, Fluck picked it up and finished the race strong.

"Kyle really fought hard, a

couple of guys passed him coming out of the woods, and you could just see it in him, he turned it on and had a great kick," said Coach Don Fredericks.

Despite being a little sick Fluck finished the 3.04 miles in 15:48.

Fluck expressed his pleasure at making state.

"It's been a goal since I started running cross country," he said.

"I just missed it last year, so it's really a cool feeling to finally be there my senior year," Fluck added.

Fluck has some other motivation going into this weekend.

"It's really a goal of mine to beat my brother's time and place," Fluck added.

Justin Fluck finished 42nd at the State Finals in 1999.

Trujillo, a junior, also expressed his pleasure at mak-

ing it to state.

"It was very surprising," Trujillo said.

"I've never been to state in anything else before, and this is only my third year of running," Trujillo added.

"I didn't want Kyle going by himself," Trujillo joked.

At the end of the race, Trujillo passed five or six runners in order to qualify. He beat Bloomington's Andy Kubiak by three seconds.

With a mile to go, Trujillo said he was in twentieth place at best. At that point, he turned it on and gave it everything he had.

"He had a tremendous kick, he made up about 15 seconds in 400 meters," Fredericks said.

"We've worked so hard as a team, and I just wanted it so bad," Trujillo said.

As a team, the Leafs placed

seventh.

Also for Geneseo, Christian Rowlands finished 33rd with a time of 16:39, while Nathan Schindlein finished in 17:08, good for 65th.

Brad Mattan crossed the line at 17:52, good for 112th place and Tony Lyttles finished in 18:33 as the 141st runner to cross.

Also for the Leafs, Steve Loftus finished in 18:50 for 149th place.

"The benefit of qualifying for the state finals, as far as experience, is priceless," Fredericks said.

"This will help all three of their careers down the road," he added.

Fluck and Trujillo will run at the State Meet this Saturday morning at Detweiller Park in Peoria.

Race time will be 12:15 for the boys.






Awards ceremony:



Geneseo's Kyle Fluck is no fluke

His last name is pronounced "fluke."

Yet, Geneseo's Kyle Fluck is no fluke when it comes to cross-country success.

Instead, this week's Metro Pacesetter is finally realizing his potential after overcoming obstacles including the expectations left behind by his brother, former Geneseo running star Justin Fluck.

"To watch his development and growth has been very satisfying," longtime Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said about Kyle, his state-bound senior. "We all learn as we go, and he's come a long way for a kid who was ineligible as an eighth-grader."

Fluck said he missed competing in his final year of junior high because of inattention to his schoolwork. The same problem plagued his running — the talent was there, but Fluck didn't truly begin applying himself until late last season. And, even then, his summer workout regimen left a lot to be desired.

The real turning point, though, came this year at mid-season, when Fredericks' frustrations

finally boiled over, not wanting Fluck to accept mediocrity.

"I usually have a joking attitude and naturally take things lightly," explained Fluck, who has turned around his academics to the point of posting a respectable grade-point average (2.7) and ACT college entrance exam score (22).

"Well, I caught coach on a bad day in practice, and he really chewed me out, and told me what he felt. He told me as a team leader I was not getting it done. He let me know individually I could do a lot better for myself.

"He apologized to me later, but he didn't need to. He set me straight, and from there, I was a lot more serious about things."

The focused Fluck has won six races — including the conference and regional meets, defending his NCIC title. Fluck also qualified for state last weekend, overcoming a serious head cold to finish fourth at the sectional, and take aim at his brother's state-bests for time (15:16) and place (42nd).



"I'm blown away," said Fluck, who missed qualifying for state last year by a mere six seconds. "I look back and know I've made a lot of mistakes, but I've learned from every one of them."

"I look back at the races I've won and the times I've run, and I never thought any of this was possible. But, all it took was confidence."

Fluck lacked that key ingredient for much of his high-school career.

"I never thought I was good enough. I doubted myself," said Fluck, who claims to be running better because of the orthotics learned to battle a back injury last year.

"I always thought Coach had

too much confidence in me. I wanted to believe what he said, but I didn't think I could live up to the expectations, and that got me down."

Fluck also felt insecure as a freshman and sophomore, competing against older teammates with the memory of his brother looming.

"I definitely felt the pressure coming into high school," Fluck said. "I knew people expected me to have the talent my brother had, but I doubted what people were saying. It was intimidating trying to live up to the expectations."

Fluck made the task all the more difficult by being admittedly lax in his off-season workouts.

The maddening thing is, Fluck has made late-season runs without the off-season dedication, showing he's got plenty of talent. Besides his NCIC title last season in cross country, Fluck finished second (1600) and

third (3200) at last spring's league track meet.

"I saw all of that potential, but was afraid it would go untapped," Fredericks said. "Over the summer, we didn't see him a lot again for workouts. We set a goal for 500 miles and he fell way short of that."

"He was not even in our 400 (mile) or 300 (mile) Club, so he was nowhere near the base we like to see to start the season. He started the year so far behind (teammate Justin) Trujillo (who did run 500 miles last summer),

that Kyle was not able to see him early on in practice runs."

Fluck eventually made up the ground, and passed Trujillo, but wishes he'd been less obstinate about the off-season.

"I can't help but wonder now how much better I'd be if I'd worked hard before the season," Fluck said. "I've always had trouble running on my own. It's hard to get going in the summer when you're in relax mode."

"But, this season changed that for me. If I compete in college, running in the summer won't be a problem for me now. And, I'm definitely running more before track."

That lack of off-season commitment strained Fluck's relationship with Fredericks for a long time.

"But, now, I can go to him and tell him what I'm feeling or ask his advice about something," Fluck said. "I know it's been frus-
