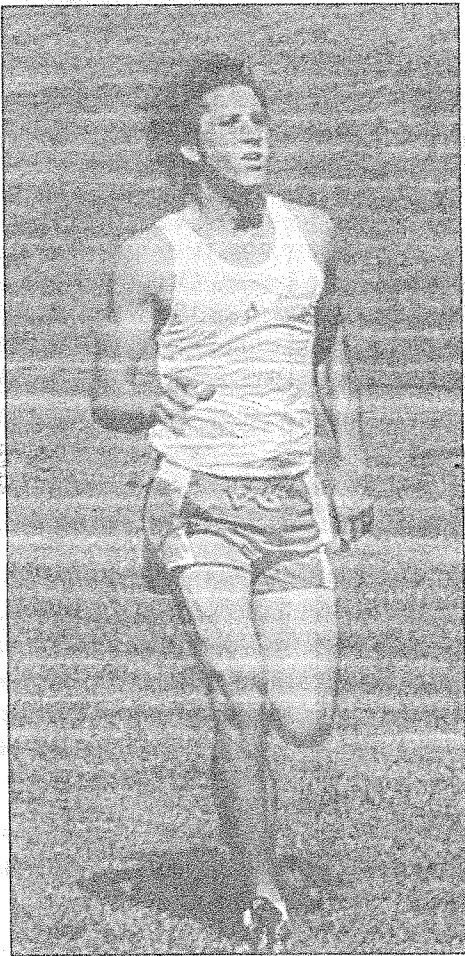
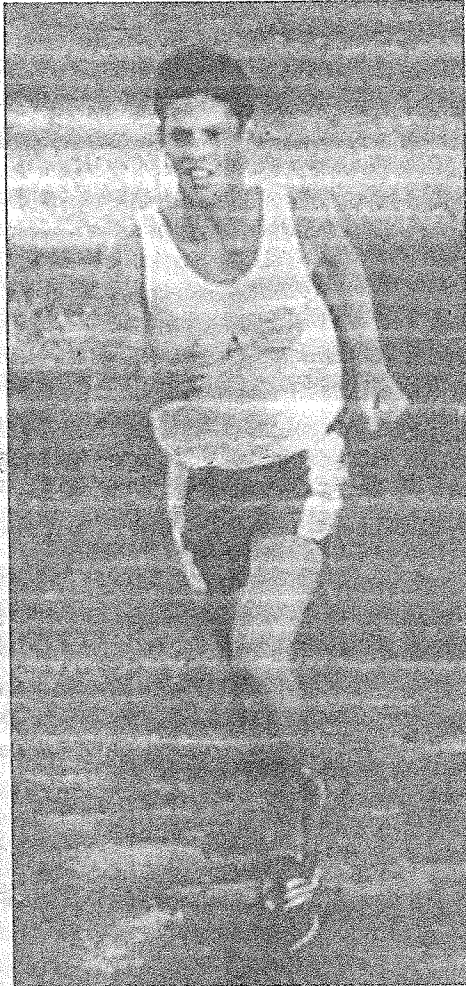

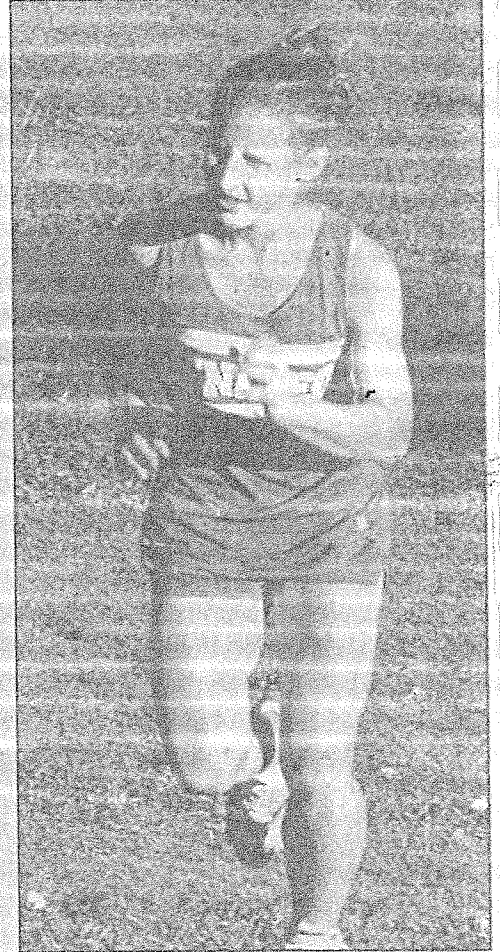

"Schlindwein & Wyffels race to NCIC Titles"

On Saturday (10/16) the Leafs hosted the NCIC Finals. The weatherman added strong 20 mph winds out of the northwest, low 40 degree weather (wind chills in the low 30's), in addition to the already challenging Richmond Hill course. The end result was a day that no competing athlete will ever forget.

Team-wise the Leafs raced to the following team finishes:

Varsity Girls: 2nd; Varsity Boys: 2nd; Frosh-Soph Boys: 1st; Open Girls: 1st; Open Boys: 1st.

Earning All-Conference Honors at the Varsity Level were: Nathan Schlindwein (1st); Rachel Wyffels (1st); and Eliza Cropp (12th.)

Frosh-Soph boys that earned a top 15 finish were: Erik Kowitz (3rd); Ryan Kotecki (6th); Bryce Borkgren (7th); and Dan Morgan (14th.)

Cracking the top 15 in the Open races were:

GIRLS: Rachel Atwell (2nd); Alexis Minnaert (3rd); Nicole Carton (5th); Kelli Lawrence (7th); and Gina McCoy (12th.)

Geneseo's Schlindwein, Wyffels run to titles

GENESEO — Under the North Central Illinois Conference system, each school gets to host the league's cross country meets every 12 years. So, the next time that Geneseo hosts, in 2016, athletic director Travis Mackey's five-year-old daughter will be a senior at J.D. Darnall High School.

Knowing that probably gave Leafs runners Nathan Schlindwein and Rachel Wyffels some added incentive to take home individual titles on the Richmond Hill Park track in Geneseo, a difficult, hilly course on Saturday morning.

"Last night, we watched the movie 'Rudy' and there's a line in it that says, 'This is our place, no one's going to push us around,'" Schlindwein said.

And Schlindwein and Wyffels didn't let anyone push them around. Though Schlindwein, a four-year varsity runner for Geneseo, had to overtake Dixon's Christian Clark down the stretch, both came home with wins and both led their teams to second-place team finishes.

The individual victories resulted in Wyffels' second consecutive NCIC title after finishing third as a freshman two years ago, and Schlindwein's first title after finishing fifth at last year's meet in Sterling.

"They carried the day for us," Maple Leafs coach Don Fredericks said of his two champions. "This is a very special meet for me, because it's the last time each year that the whole team gets to compete together. Hosting makes it even more special. For

Nathan and Rachel to win varsity titles on their home course, it's something they'll never forget."

Schlindwein was certainly pumped after his win, raising his right fist with an emphatic "Yes!" as he crossed the finish line to win by six seconds over Clark.

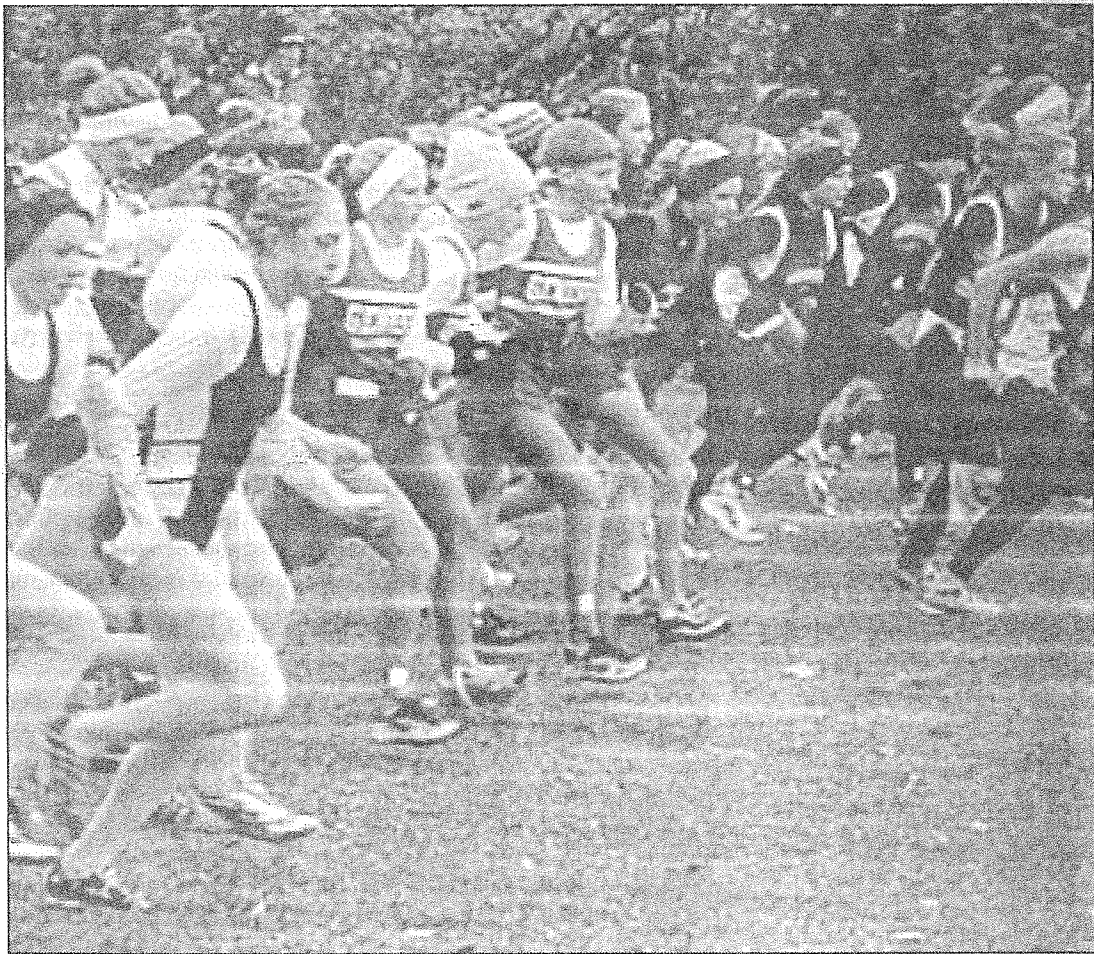
"I had tears in my eyes as I came toward the finish," Schlindwein said. "I'd never trained hard in the summer until this year. I put 500 miles in over the summer, so all the hard work paid off. It's awesome."

Wyffels led from the front almost immediately, and was never seriously challenged, beating late-charging Kate Gillespie of Dixon by more than five seconds.

"I tried to get someone else to block the wind for me (early), but after that I just tried to stay at the front," Wyffels said. "We were kind of hoping to get (team) conference back, but I guess I'm all right with taking second. I'm just going to try to get enough rest and see where the rest of the season goes."

Kewanee's girls finished third as a team, led by junior Shea Boehle's fourth-place finish. Boehle was joined by senior teammate Karyssa Martin (15th) on the all-NCIC list. The Boilermaker boys ran incomplete at the varsity level, though senior Colt Smith made the all-conference team by finishing seventh.

Cross country takes second in conference meet

The Geneseo varsity boys and girls cross country team placed second in the NCIC meet last weekend, Saturday, Oct. 16 at Richmond Hill. The boys finished with a combined team score of 76, 44 points behind first place team Dixon with a 32. The girls finished the meet with a team score of 70, 18 points behind first place Sterling.

The Leafs claimed the first place spots in both races with senior Nathan Schlindwein winning the boys' three mile race in 16 minutes and 45.50 seconds while junior Rachel Wyffels won the girls three mile race in 20:07.49.

Crossing the finish line next for the Leafs in the boys' race were sophomore Justin Goodrich in 19th place with a final time of 18:16.50, junior Scott Mattan in 20th in 18:20.67 and senior Jordan Wildermuth in 18:24.21 for a 21st place finish. Sophomore Blake Wyffels followed in 23rd place with a 18:32.85 final time while sophomore Nate Silver came in 27th in 18:50.51 and junior Pete Nelson in 19:02.05 for a 34th place finish.

Other Lady Leafs contributing to the second place finish were freshman Eliza Cropp in 12th place with a time of 21:27.14 followed by seniors Alison Curran and Erica Brenny in 17th and 18th place with times of 21:45.48 and 21:50.43, respectively. Senior Katie Croegaert came in 23rd for Geneseo finishing with a 22:19.30 while teammates junior Sally Collis came in 31st in 23:03.32 followed by sophomore Abby Winberry in 35th in 23:30.98.

In the boys' freshmen/sophomore race, the Leafs took first place with a team score of 34, 20 points ahead of the second place team, Ottawa. Sophomore Erik Kowitz led Geneseo with his third place finish in 18:42.93 followed by freshmen Ryan Kotecki and Bryce Borkgren in sixth and seventh place in 19:27.77 and 19:40.26, respectively. Others contributing to the victory were sophomores Dan Morgan in 20:14.23 for 14th place, Jesse Cross in 20:31.05, Lucas Cropp 20:56.07 and Dyson Wake 21:16.50.

Both the girls and boys' teams won the junior varsity

race with the girls finishing with a 26 and the boys a 15.

The Lady Leafs finished with four girls in the top ten, freshman Rachel Atwell in second place with a time of 23:09.33 followed by senior Alexis Minnaert in 23:13.18, sophomore Nicole Carton in fifth in 23:42.60 and Kelli Lawrence seventh in 24:07.78. Sophomore Gina McCoy just missed the top ten finishing 12th in 25:24.79.

The boys team had six runners in the top ten, five claiming the top five places. Senior David Cross led the way in first with 19:02.49 followed by juniors Ben Arnett in 19:44.39, Caleb Diericx 20:07.57, Justin Heaton 20:10.11 and Dustin Brewer in 20:43.58 to take second through fifth places. Junior Wes Stahl also placed in the top ten in seventh place with a time of 20:51.43 while teammates junior Mark Lindell finished in 17th place in 22:50.39, sophomore Zach Saigh in 23:07.07 for 20th and freshman Brandon Huttenlocher in 23rd with a 23:41.61 final time.
