Geneseo cross-country running strong 'til the end

The Geneseo cross country team ended the week with two successful meets to put the running Leafs in great shape for post season action.

Rock Island Invitational

The Lady Leafs' cross country team led the way for Geneseo last Saturday, Sept. 25 when they won the girls division of the Rock Island Invitational at

Credit Island Park.

Geneseo took first place out of eight teams with 62 points followed by Rock Island with 66, United Township 81, North Scott 95 and Pleasant Valley 113 points for a fifth place finish.

Junior Rachel Wyffels and freshman Eliza Cropp represented Geneseo in the top ten finishers in the three-mile race. Wyffels placed sixth in 19 minutes and 36.27 seconds while Cropp finished eighth in 20:06.31. Seniors Katie Croe-

gaert came in 14th for the Leafs in 20:35.01, Allison Curran in 20:42.79 for an 18th place finish and Erica Brenny finished in 21st with a 20:48.03 time.

Sophomore Nicole Carton finished in the girls freshmen/sophomore race with a time of 21:49 for a fifth place finish while teammate Kelli Lawrence finished seventh with a time of 21:57.

"It was nice to see the girls get a chance to shine," Head Coach Don Fredericks said. "The girls ran a tremendous

race. It was neat to see the girls have that success."

The boys team faced some tough competitors during their race last Saturday, coming in seventh place with a combined team score of 142 points. The Bettendorf squad claimed first place honors, Pleasant Valley second, United Township third, Davenport Central fourth and North Scott sixth.

Senior Nathan Schlindwein was the first Leaf harrier to cross the line, clocking a 15:39.79 for a sixth place finish. Others finishing for Geneseo were senior Bill Barton in 25th place with a 16:53.87 final time, junior Pete Nelson in 17:31.88, senior Jordan Wildermuth in 17:35.42 and junior Scott Mattan with a 17:35.93 final time for the day.

The Leafs frosh/soph team claimed third place honors with a team score of 84 for the invitational with sophomore Nate Silver leading the way in 16:59 for an eighth place finish followed by sophomore Blake Wyffels in 15th place with a 17:22 time, sophomore Erik Kowitz in 17:26 for 17th place and freshman Ryan Kotecki in 22nd with a 17:52 finish time.

LaSalle-Peru Meet

The Geneseo cross country team swept its triangular meet Tuesday, Sept. 28 when hosting Kewanee and LaSalle-Peru at Richmond Hill.

The varsity boys, girls and frosh/soph boys all claimed first place honors with the varsity harriers combining for a total of 19 points, the girls a 22 and the frosh/soph boys with 19 points for the day.

The girls team continued its success out on the course with six girls finishing in the top ten

out of 19 runners on Tuesday. Wyffels grabbed a first place finish in 20:22 followed closely by Cropp in 21:05 to claim third place. Croegaert, Curran and Brenny claimed the fifth, sixth and seventh positions in 21:44, 22:14 and 22:32 respectively. Claiming tenth place for the Lady Leafs was freshman Rachel Atwell, crossing the line in 23:22. Carton followed shortly behind Atwell in 24:25 to claim 12th place while teammate sophomore Gina McCoy placed 14th with a finishing time of 25:43.

"The Kewanee girls team is very good and are state ranked this year. Our girls did real well against them," Fredericks said. "The girls are on a nice roll and I am proud with how they have been competing."

"We look to be a very competitive and strong girls team in the end," Fredericks said. "We will make a run at it and hopefully qualify for state."

Schlindwein continues to set the pace for the boys varsity team, coming in first out of 26 harriers in the boys race with a time of 16:47. Geneseo also claimed spots three to eight with Barton leading the way at 17:55 for the third place finish followed by Silver in 18:07, Wyffels 18:17, Nelson in 18:19, Mattan with a 18:23 and Wildermuth in 18:26. Kowitz also broke into the top ten with an overall time of 18:46 for a tenth place finish.

Others contributing to the Leafs' win were seniors TJ Lyttles in 11th place with a 18:54 final time, Dave Cross in 19:20, juniors Dustin Brewer and Caleb Diericx with only one second separating the two in 19:52 and 19:53, respectively. Junior Justin Heaton came in at

19:57, while teammates juniors Wes Stahl, Ben Arnett and Ben Hansen also completed the course for the Leafs.

Coach Fredericks issued a challenge to the boys team which is to work on closing the gap between Schlindwein's finishing time and the rest of the Leafs and the boys rose to the challenge, Fredericks said. "I like what I am seeing. It is neat to see them take the challenge and make an effort to reach the goal."

Kotecki led the frosh/soph boys team, placing first out of 11 runners in 19:39 for the day. Freshman Bryce Borkgren followed closely behind Kotecki for a second place finish of 19:58. Freshman Jaran Heaton and sophomore Dan Morgan claimed spots four and five in 20:46 and 21:23, respectively, for the day while teammates sophomores Dyson Wake, Rob Eberhardt, Zack Saigh and John Thompson along with freshman Brandon Huttenlocher all crossed the line to claim places seven to 11 for the Leafs.

With the conference meet about only two weeks away, there is going to be a real war amongst the boys team to see who will crack into the starting line-up for the NCIC race, Fredericks said. "We are going to load the varsity team so we can make a run at the conference title."

"This is a very exciting time of the season and I am very excited and optimistic of what the team can do," Frederick said. "The best is yet to come."

Geneseo will be in action when they travel to Freeport for their next competition this Saturday, Oct. 2. The Leafs will also compete in the Sterling Invite next Saturday, Oct. 9.

Bastert surprises Rock Island field

Davenport North coach Jill Lafrenz looked at the field for Saturday's Rock Island Invitational and told No. 1 runner Annie Ripslinger that she should have a great chance of winning her second straight cross country meet.

That's because Pleasant Valley's Kelsey Bulat, arguably the state's top runner through the midpoint of the season, and United Township's Brooke Ashcraft were out with injuries.

Lafrenz didn't account for the short sophomore in the royal blue Carthage uniform in the far left box at the starting line.

Because Carthage has no team, Katelyn Bastert had the small box all to herself.

Bastert had won Illinois Class A titles in cross country and track and field (3,200 and 1,600 meters) by obscene margins during her freshman year. She made it look easy again, winning at Credit Island Park in 17 minutes, 1.43 seconds — nine seconds quicker than her state championship time last fall and 1:53 ahead of runner-up Ripslinger.

"I have a good friend who runs for Sterling, and I remember her telling me, 'There's this Carthage girl, this Carthage girl,' " Ripslinger said. "I'm just going to try to block that out (her distance from Bastert) because I had a good race today. At least I'm never going to have to run against her again. I'm just going to try to forget her."

Shortly after the gun fired, Bastert had no company. Ripslinger opened her own big margin over third-place Tari Fisk of United Township.

Bastert, who also plays volleyball for Carthage and was missing the first matches of a tournament, said Credit Island is similar to the state meet course in

Peoria — without the acorns — and that she has gotten used to running solo.

"I like it," she said. "If someone's right on my heels and I hear it, that's too close to me."

Bastert came to the Quad-Cities because of the lack of meets near Carthage, a town just west of Macomb. Without a coach, her father, Andy, makes race arrangements.

"He plans my races, and I just jump in the car and run," Bastert said.

Blake Schlotzhauer, Davenport Central's Las Vegas import, won the boys race in 14:46.27. He has not lost since the Cedar Rapids Invitational, almost three weeks ago. A week ago he got revenge on the first person to beat him. At Credit Island he got revenge on the last person to beat him.

Schlotzhauer set a brutal first-mile pace and held it throughout, beating Kyle Cameron of United Township by 16 seconds and Pleasant Valley's Kenny Slocum — who had beaten him by 15 seconds at the Pleasant Valley Invitational — by :35.

"I knew I had to get out fast and do my thing," Schlotzhauer said. "This was a completely different course, and I think (he and Slocum are) two completely different types of runners. I like a boring course where I can just concentrate on running fast."

Cameron passed Slocum at the 2-mile mark to finish with a 16-second personal best of 15:02.04.

"I couldn't tell you," Cameron said of the secret to his breakthrough. "I woke up this morning, I had a cramp in my calf and I said, 'This is a great way to start the day.'"

Geneseo won the girls team title and Bettendorf edged Pleasant Valley for the boys crown.

Credit Island provides runners great racing

Geneseo cross country coach Don Fredericks felt good enough — while basking in the glow of his girls' success Saturday — to join his team in a victory hot dog.

UT's Kyle Cameron and Tari Fisk weren't exactly sure why they felt so good after both finished in the top three in their respective races at the Rock Island Invitational, but neither was about to argue with either the feeling or the results.

Davenport Central's Blake Schlotzhauer was just happy to run a humidity-free race on a flat track. That was enough to feel good about.

And Carthage's itinerant wunderkind, sophomore Kate-lyn Bastert? How would you feel after obliterating your competition — again — after your parents briefly got lost getting to Davenport's Credit Island, site of the race? Answer: probably pretty good.

And that was pretty much the general vibe around the three-mile Credit Island friendly confines, as Saturday's pleasant, muggy-free day allowed many runners to drop time and set new personal bests. In the varsity races, Bettendorf and Geneseo won the boys and girls team titles, respectively.

Girls race

Fredericks felt particularly gratified — especially after watching his team battle through injuries and illnesses prior to Saturday's race — to see them still pull out a tight victory over Rock Island, 62-66.

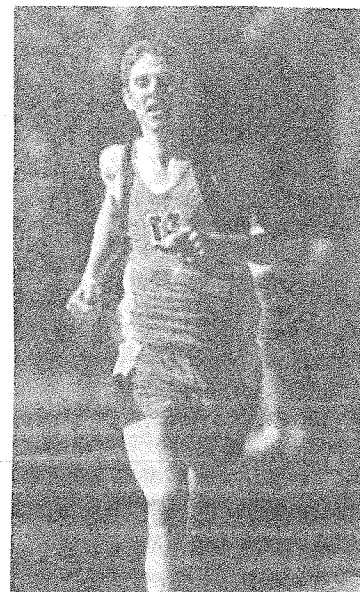
"This has been a very challenging season for us," he said of his team, which was able to put its Nos. 1 through 5 runners in a pack spanning just one minute and 12 seconds. "We believe we have a very solid girls team, but one that doesn't have a lot of depth. We still weren't 100 percent today, but it's nice to see some smiles."

That's what UT's Fisk was wearing after cranking out a third-place finish with a time of 19:18.58, a personal-best, to help lead the Panthers to third as a team.

"I was really surprised; I never thought I could run this fast. Usually I'm around 21 (minutes) so I felt really good," Fisk said. "We've been training really hard, so when we come out here, it's like nothing. It seemed really easy."

And that is what Bastert made running three miles look like. The Carthage sophomore, who runs alone and has her parents drive her to meets, beat her competition literally out of sight, finishing 1:53.68 ahead of the runnerup. Her time of 17:01.43 — which made many observers speculate on whether it was a meet or course record — would have placed her 27th in the boys varsity race.

"It does (remind Bastert of the state meet course, Peoria's Detweiller Park); the only thing is that there's acorns to look out for here," Bastert said of Credit

Island. "I just try to keep my mind on the race, pick a good stride and then pick a song and sing it in my head."

Boys race

Cameron ran with Geneseo's Nathan Schindwein for the first mile or so in fourth place, then charged ahead and picked off Bettendorf's Jason Henderkott and Pleasant Valley's Kenny Slocum to finish in 15:02.04, his fastest time ever for three miles.

Cameron woke up Saturday with leg cramps, but battled his way through for the second-place finish.

"I'm ecstatic; I never expected to do this this early. My goal was to go 15:15 at state, so to go 15:02 here, I'm overwhelmed," Cameron said of his finish, which helped UT finish highest among Illinois metro teams (third). "I caught (Slocum) at the second mile. He was slowing me down, so I went past him. But Central was flying. I didn't think he'd go out like that."

"Central" was Schlotzhauer, a recent transplant from Nevada who finished fifth in its Class 4A state meet a year ago. He finished nearly 16 full seconds ahead of Cameron, in 14:46.27.

"I know my kick isn't my strongest asset, so I'll take the lead and do the work instead. I don't care," Schlotzhauer said. "I'd much rather lead and not worry about trying to catch somebody at the end."
