Geneseo CC opens with Alumni Race

The Geneseo Cross Country team fell in their first match-up at the Sterling Mile Relay after opening the season with the annual Alumni Race last week.

Sterling Mile Relay

Both cross country squads opened their regular season at the Sterling Grass Relays. The girls finished with a final team score of 28, while Sterling won by one point with a 27. The boys ended with 30 points, but Sterling squeezed out a five-point victory with a 25.

It is very early in the season and this is a new format for the invite, Head Coach Don Fredericks said. In this type of race, each group ran six miles with each person switching roughly every mile.

"Sterling is certainly a favorite on the girls side and, possibly, on the boys side," Fredericks said. "They are very strong teams. And there was lots of great sportsmanship. It was a great way to start the season."

In the girls' race, the team of Rachel Wyffels and Eliza Cropp placed second with a final time of 39 minutes and 21 seconds, followed by Sally Collis and Ruthie Lile in third with a time of 42:08. Elaina Boone and Rachel Atwell finished in fifth place, crossing the finish line in 43:30; teammates Abby Winberry and Stephanie Kennett completed the race in 44:44.

Others finishing the race were Kayla McVietty and Kelli Lawrence in 45:59, Kirsten Keener and Kate Langdon in 51:04, and Sarah Rudy and Liz Hanford in 53:44.

Placing second in the boys' race and first for the Leafs, was the team of Nate Silver and Dan Chenoweth with a

final time of 32:29, followed by Blake Wyffels and Ryan Kotecki in third with a time of 33:58. Pete Nelson and Josh Lodge completed the race in 36:00 for seventh place, while teammates Lucas Cropp and Bryce Borkgren came in eighth in 36:20.

The team of Scott Mattan and Jesse Cross took the 10th place spot in 36:49, while Erik Kowitz and Eric Windsor crossed the finish line in 38:17. Caleb Diericx and Justin Heaton raced to a 13th-place

finish in 39:06, followed by Jaran Heaton and Jake Rathman in 39:59. Zach Saigh and Dyson Wake rounded out the finishes for Geneseo in 41:49.

"The runners enjoyed (the race)," Fredericks said. "They were tired and shot at the end, but it was a great workout.

"Everyone ran great and it will be interesting to see how things end up," Fredericks said. "And the competitive situation (for spots) is going to help out a lot."

Alumni Race

The Geneseo Cross Country team hosted its annual Alumni Race, Aug. 25 at Richmond Hill Park. The race is a two-mile run for the high-school team and open-race adults, and a one-mile race of the middle-school runners and younger. The entry fee was one used t-shirt in good condition, for the prize table, and two to three canned goods to be donated to the Geneseo Food Pantry. T-shirts were awarded to all finishers.

"We were very satisfied and it was a great way to start the season," Fredericks said. "We were very pleased and it was a lot of fun."


