Former Tiger races to win at Engel meet

CEDAR FALLS — Cedar Falls took home a pair of seconds in the varsity team events at the Rich Engel Classic Thursday.

But a former Tiger ran away with the individual title.

As a sophomore, former Cedar Falls Tiger Dan Chenoweth's best finish was 10th at the state cross country meet. Returning home as a senior, Chenoweth claimed the individual title in the boys 5K competition, with a time of 15 minutes, 40 seconds. Chenoweth's time put him 53 seconds ahead of second-place Josh Boersma of Ankeny.

"It's just something you think about when you're younger, winning your event in your senior year," said Chenoweth. "It was really cool to do that."

"He's (Chenoweth) the most talented runner I've ever coached," said Cedar Falls boys head coach Troy Becker.

Chenoweth is now enrolled at Geneseo (Illinois) High School, which is just east of the Quad Cities. Becker invited Chenoweth and his team out to the Classic this year, and Chenoweth could not refuse.

"He wanted a chance to come back with his team

and show them the Rich Engel Classic," said Becker.

The first thing that the teams noticed when they arrived was the level of talent at the competition. Top teams from all classes took part in the event, including eight of the top 15 teams in the state, along with 11 of the top 25 runners. Many feel this is one of the top events of the season.

"We probably figured that this was going to be a state type meet," noted Charles City head coach Ryan Rahmiller, whose team left with a fourth-place finish.

For the Comets, this was the first time that the entire varsity squad competed together. The second-ranked Comets came in looking to see how much they need to improve.

"It's kind of fun to see where we're at right now," said Rahmiller. "We've got some kids coming along."

A tough competition gets tougher when you have a young team. Becker is trying to replace five starters from last year's state championship team. But Becker has confidence in his young team.

"Everything that we do this year is designed to make this team the best they are capable of being," noted Becker.

Alex Mark finished seventh for the Tigers, with a time of 17:03, and teammate Drew Poland finished right behind him with a mark of 17:04.

"We just ran lights out and got second in a very tough meet," said Becker.

Despite the second-place finish, the Cedar Falls girls have had a tough start to the year. The Tigers returned five of the starters from last year's team, but injuries have sidelined two key runners. Danielle Kelly, a three-year state qualifier, will miss the rest of the season with a stress fracture. State qualifier Sarah Larson is out for the year with a stress fracture as well.

"The kids we've got running are running well," said Cedar Falls girls head coach Bob Schmidt. "It's just unfortunate that we've had to battle through this."

Leah Blanchard and Kelsey Davis have stepped in to fill the leadership void for the Tigers. In the girls 4K event, Davis took home a third place finish, with a time of 15:54, while Blanchard placed sixth, posting a mark of 16:12.

Decorah's Kaia Miller finished in second place with a time of 15:51.

Geneseo boys at Cedar Falls Invite

The Geneseo boys' cross country team held their own Sept. 14 against some of the top teams in the state of Iowa. The Leafs captured third place at the Rich Engel Classic 5K in Cedar Falls, Iowa. Geneseo took third to Cedar Rapids Washington in first and Cedar Falls (two-time defending state champs and Chenoweth's former school).

D. Chenoweth continued his success out on the course with another first-place finish on his old course, taking the tape in 15:40, showing his former teammates that he hasn't lost a step.

"Dan won by quite a bit," Fredericks said. "He just missed the course record and he definitely inspired running on his home course. He got to strut his stuff and he actually got ahead of the pace golf cart and the golf cart couldn't catch him."

Chenoweth was followed by Kotecki in 18th with a time of

17:16; Lodge in 28th at 17:44 and Wyffels in 17:46 for 30th place.

Silver came in with a time of 17:54 for 37th, while Ford crossed the finish line in 18:59 for 85th and Rob Brenny in 99th with a time of 19:27.

"It was a high-powered meet and the guys were fired up," Fredericks said. "And the guys ran tremendous races. We are glad we went and it was worth it."

The next competition for the cross country teams is Saturday, Sept. 23 with the Leafs at the Rock Island Invite at 9 a.m. and the top-7 varsity boys' runners at the Palatine Invite, TBA.

"We will see the best in the state as comparable to the state finals if not better," Fredericks said. "There is tremendous competition at this meet.

"(The rest of the Leafs) will also face a tremendous field at the Rock Island Invite," Fredericks said. "It is a very competitive field. We need to take care of our business and continue to improve."
