Varsity Boys and Dan Chenoweth Mine NCIC Gold

On Saturday, October 14th the Leafs traveled to Dixon to participate in the NCIC Finals hosted at Sauk Valley Community College. The Varsity Boys led the charge as they won their 2nd straight NCIC Title. Dan Chenoweth claimed the top spot for the 2nd straight year and was closely followed by Ryan Kotecki (3rd), Josh Lodge (7th), Blake Wyffels (9th), Nate Silver (12th), Chad Ford (19th), and Ryan Brenny (25th.)

The Varsity Girls literally ran wild and just missed upsetting heavily favored Sterling by a scant four points as they finished a strong 2nd. Amy Cosgrove (3rd), Danielle Dewey (4th), Joann Chenoweth (9th), Nicole Carton (13th), Abby Winberry (17th), Eliza Cropp (18th), and Kate Langdon (19th) led the charge.

Pacing the Fresh-Soph Boys to a strong 2nd place team finish were Ian Mattan (6th), Carlisle Evans-Peck (7th), Andrew Kellogg (10th), Andrew Kellogg (12th), Kyle DeFauw (15th), and Alex Strohmeier (18th.)

The Fresh-Soph Girls weren't able to field a full team but Lauren Schroeder (5th) and Liz Hanford (13th) certainly threw out a strong carpe diem as they each ran very strong races.

Pacing the Open Boys to a 3rd place team showing were the strong efforts of Dyson Wake (8th), Eric Windsor (10th), Lucas Cropp (12th), Bryce Borkgren (13th), Jon Cybulski (23rd), and Sammy Reyes (24th.)

The Lady Leaf Open Girls team didn't field a full team of 5 scorers and were led by Rachel Atwell (5th), Kelli Lawrence (8th), and Brittney Kajdacs (11th.)

Geneseo dominates NCIC cross country

DIXON — The Geneseo boys' cross country team can cross out the first item on their to-do list for the postseason.

They wrapped up the NCIC cross country championship by crushing the competition, beating their nearest competitor, Dixon, by a score of 32-60.

It made the Maple Leafs back-to-back winners of the NCIC crown with basically the same team as last year. They were led by the area's top runner, Dan Chenoweth,

who used a different strategy to win this race. In order to put his team in a position to win, Chenoweth stayed back on the first mile and paced teammate Ryan Kotecki. This helped Kotecki finish third and assured Geneseo of the win.

For Chenoweth, the winning time of 15:06 wasn't the fastest of his season, but running nearly a mile into a wind with gusts up to 20 miles per hour, it wasn't all that bad, either.

"The wind really plays into how you run," Chenoweth said. "My main goal today was to help Ryan in that first mile."

This was the first year the NCIC adopted a split conference meet, with the big schools competing in the Reagan Division and the smaller schools in the Lincoln Division. Had the two been combined, the Maple Leafs still would've ended up on top.

Behind Chenoweth and Kotecki were Josh Lodge (7th, 16:46), Blake Wyffels (9th, 16:49), and Nate Silver (12th, 17:08), who all finished in the top 15.

Next on the list for the Leafs is the Galesburg Regional at Lake Storey Park next weekend. Chenoweth tore up Lake Storey earlier in the year, breaking the course record by more than a minute. Geneseo and Chenoweth's goal, though, is a team one, not a personal one.

"I'd like to win the regionals, have the team advance on to sectionals, and hopefully to state," Chenoweth said. "That's the main goal, getting everyone to state. I'll do whatever it takes to make that happen."

► **Maple Leaf girls finish second:** Coach Don Fredericks didn't know quite what to expect out of his girls team, but he knew they were in perfect shape. As it turns out, they almost surprised everybody by taking the team title, falling just four points shy of Sterling.

"Our kids really showed up ready to race," Fredericks said. "That's what you hope and dream for. They're beginning to hit their peak season."

Amy Cosgrove was the highest Leaf finisher, coming in at 20:13, good enough for third place. Teammate Danielle Dewey was right behind her (20:17). While they may not have as high of expectations as the boys team, the Geneseo girls can't be counted out yet.

"From (regionals) on out, it's all about staying alive and moving on to the next level," Fredericks said. "Their goal is to qualify as a team for sectionals, and if they keep improving, they can do that."

Leafs nab second straight NCIC title

The Geneseo boys' cross country team came out at the Oct. 14 NCIC meet with all cylinders firing and proved that they were the best in the conference. The varsity boys defended their conference championship, while the girls and the freshmen/sophomore boys both took second.

"The weather was challenging for all the runners, but I am proud of the kids for stepping up," Head Coach Don Fredericks said. "It was very special. They ran real well and stepped up pretty big."

Dan Chenoweth paced the field in first place for the second straight year, taking the tape in 15 minutes and six seconds, followed by Ryan Kotecki in third at 16:18, and Josh Lodge in seventh at 16:46.

Blake Wyffels placed ninth in 16:49, while Nate Silver came in 12th with a time of 17:08; Chad Ford in 19th at 17:53; and Rob Brenny in 25th at 18:29.

The Lady Leafs were led to their second-place finish by Amy Cosgrove in third with a time of 20:13, and Danielle Dewey in fourth at 20:17.

"Sterling has defeated us strongly before, but our girls showed up ready to compete and Sterling only won by four points," Fredericks said. "I am very proud of their effort. It was a very strong race from the girls. They turned a lot of heads with their performance."

Joann Chenoweth took ninth with a time of 20:43, followed by Nicole Carton in 13th at 20:56; Abby Winberry, 17th at 21:50; Eliza Cropp, 18th at 21:51; and Kate Langdon, 19th at 22:01.

In the boys' freshmen/sophomore race, Ian Mattan led Geneseo in sixth place with a time of 18:52, followed by

Carlisle Evans-Peck in seventh at 18:55.

Andrew Kellogg took 10th in 20:28, followed by Cameron Hodgson, 12th at 20:36; Kyle DeFauw, 15th at 21:22; and Alex Strohmeyer in 21:38 for 18th place.

Racing for the girls' freshmen/sophomore team were Lauren Schroeder in fifth place at 22:03, and Liz Hanford in 13th place at 23:56.

"The freshmen/sophomore squads also ran really well," Fredericks said.

In the mixed open race, Rachel Atwell placed fifth in 23:24; Kelli Lawrence took eighth in 24:11; and Brittney Kajdacs finished 11th in 26:10.

Dyson Wake led the boys in eighth place with a time of 19:25, followed by Eric Windsor in 19:38; Lucas Cropp, 19:55; Bryce Borkgren, 20:14; Jon Cybulski, 26:03; and Sammy Reyes, 26:08.

The Leafs will compete for a chance to advance in IHSA competition when they travel to Galesburg Saturday, Oct. 21, for the IHSA regional meet.

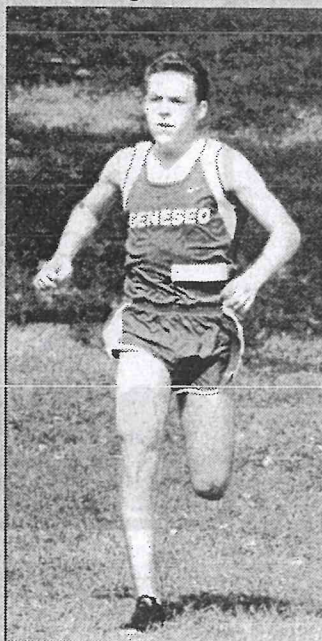
