Lady Leafs, Lodge to face cross country sectionals

The Lady Leaf cross country team continues on its roll as they emerged with the regional championship at the Oct. 20 IHSA Regional meet at Rock Falls. The Lady Leafs advanced to the sectional meet as a team, along with lone Leaf runner Josh Lodge.

"We are thrilled, regional

champs is obviously a tremendous accomplishment," head coach Don Fredericks said. "We are very proud of the girls and it was a tremendous team effort."

Leading the pack of Geneseo runners were Danielle Dewey and Joann Chenoweth. Dewey cracked into the top 5 with a fifth-place finish in 19 minutes and 18 seconds, while Chenoweth

followed not far behind in sixth place, crossing the finish line in 19:20.

"Those two (Danielle and Joann) attacked the race and ran strong the whole way," Fredericks said. "It was a starstudded field and the competition was fierce. They both ran phenomenal races."

Stephanie Kennett raced to a

14th-place finish in 19:53, while Eliza Cropp came in 22nd at 20:27. Lauren Schroeder took 24th with a time of 20:29, followed by Amy Cosgrove in 32nd at 20:57 and Betsy Winberry in 43rd at 21:52.

"Stephanie did a great job and has been a great addition," Fredericks said. "Eliza and Lauren both ran strong races, while Amy, who has not finished several races due to illness, had a big break-through. Betsy also ran a real strong race, one of her best races."

The Leaf runners just missed

qualifying as a team, placing sixth, while the top 5 teams advance to sectionals.

"It was a big disappointment to not qualify for sectionals," Fredericks said.

Lodge was the only Geneseo runner to advance to sectionals, placing 14th overall in 16:24.

"Josh ran a strong race and the field was loaded with several all-staters," Fredericks said. "He is going to gain a lot of experience (at sectionals), but it will be an uphill battle and he is capable of popping a big race."

Chad Ford came in second for the Leafs and 34th overall with a time of 17:27, while Carlisle Evans-Peck took 39th in 17:47.

Chris Bisom finished the race in 41st place at 17:50, followed by Robbie Brenny in 45th with a time of 18:00. Eric Windsor took 46th in 18:04, while Ryan Kotecki placed 47th at 18:23.

The girls' squad and Lodge will compete in the Belvidere sectional meet Oct. 27 at Belvidere High School. The girls' race will begin at 10 a.m. and the boys' race will start at 10:45 a.m.

"All the girls are coming on and I like their chances for sectionals, but we are in the toughest sectional in the state," Fredericks said. "But I wouldn't bet against our girls, they are on a roll."

Cropp leads Geneseo past Alleman for girls' 2A regional title

ROCK FALLS — Eliza Cropp had a smile from ear to ear, and

After the senior co-captain found out her time was good enough for fourth on the team. and it gave the Geneseo Maple Leaf girls the Class 2A cross country regional title, all of Cropp's problems faded away.

After struggling earlier in the fall with shortness of breath and lack of energy, Cropp only recently was diagnosed with anemia.

That's what made Saturday's victory — Geneseo's first regional crown since 2004 — all the more sweet.

"That's the biggest I've ever seen her smile," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said. "It's pretty special to see her be a factor as a senior in the team score. She's been an inspiration to all the girls for never losing hope.'

In fact, the team score was so close, no one had any idea who the winner was until the scores were posted. It showed Geneseo with 71 points to Alleman's 75. It was the first time all season the Maple Leafs have gotten the better of the Pioneers.

The reason the team score was so close was that the first two runners to break the tape were Alleman girls.

Kathleen Hogan and Caitlin you think it's going to." Bull had a plan in mind for how Saturday's race would play out. After the first mile, they realized it worked even better than they had hoped.

"Our plan was to push each other and push the pace and see how far out we could get," Hogan said. "We got pretty far actually."

Hird, Alleman advance; Geneseo denied at Class 2A regional

ROCK FALLS - It was heartbreak for one team, and a breath of relief for another at the boys IHSA Class 2A Rock Falls cross country regional.

outran Tim Hird Sycamore crew, winning the 3mile race in 15:13, nearly 10 seconds ahead of the next closest competitor.

Thanks to his big finish, the Pioneers are moving on to the Bellville Sectional, taking the fourth spot.

While Alleman celebrated, anguish was the mood of the day in the Geneseo camp. The Maple Leafs finished just 20 points away from Rock Falls, the

fifth and final sectional qualifier.

Hird's run was complemented fellow Pioneer. Brian McGuire, who finished sixth.

"Tim was the most relaxed I've ever seen him in any race,' Alleman coach Tony Vandewalle said. "He is a top contender in the state right now."

Sycamore took the team crown as expected, getting all five runners in the top 13.

For Alleman, which has been hampered by some nagging injuries the last couple weeks, escaping from the regional was a step in the right direction, and it buys the Pioneers another week to try and get back to full strength.

"Everyone went away happy,

and when you get out of a regional meet it's a good feeling," Vandewalle said, "They're hungry for more and they want to better themselves at section-

For Geneseo, the disappointment was felt throughout the Maple Leaf camp -including Josh Lodge, who did move on individually after a 14th-place

"Josh is 100-percent a team guy, and was pretty devastated when he found out the team didn't qualify," said Geneseo Don Fredericks. "The top four teams were head and shoulders above us, so it basically came down to us and Rock Falls, and our guys were racing them. But you have to give it up to Rock Falls, because they had their best race of the season and they're the fifth best team in the region.'

The gap between Alleman's fourth-place finish and Dixon's runner-up finish was just 22 points. Josh Lopez was the third Pioneer finisher, coming in 19th place, while Marco Torrez and Ricky Mendez packed up 10

With all of the teams experiencing the 2A class for the first time, the Belvidere Sectional will be tough to get out of, and if the Pioneers want to reach their goal of making it to state as a team, they'll have to hope they heal their bumps and bruises before next Saturday.
