

# Hird, Smith have high state hopes

There's no doubt Tim Hird and Jonathan Smith will have the eyes of the state on them Saturday morning at the IHSA State Cross Country Meet in Peoria.

After all, the Alleman and Moline seniors won their respective sectional titles, and will be among the favorites to take home the individual titles in their respective classes.

Only once in Illinois Q-C history has there been an individual state champion, Rock Island's Mario Vesey in 1988. Hird has had his mind made up since last year's state meet that he would do what his brothers Nick (4th place twice) and Nathaniel (5th and 7th) couldn't — win an individual XC title. Smith's chances were born in the summer when the Maroon took a giant step forward in training.

He'll lead the Maroon boys team in what they hope will be a top 15 finish.

It isn't just the two big guns that will be representing the Q-C. Geneseo and United Township have a lot to brag about, too.

The Panthers will be sending sophomore Cody Webster and senior CJ Dundy to race against the state's best in the 3A 3-mile race.

"If Cody can run the same time he did last week, it would push him into the top 25," said UT coach Russ Boore. "If he drops 10 or 15 seconds, the sky is the limit. It wouldn't surprise me to see him slip into the top 15 or top 10. Our expectations are fairly high."

With it not being Dundy's first state experience, that should help the young Webster.

"I would never underestimate CJ," Boore said. "I think for the first couple of miles he'll pull Cody along since he's comfortable running in this race. Hopefully they both explode the last mile and get all-state honors."

And on the Geneseo side, there are a couple of girls who have taken their game to a whole new level. Junior Joann Chenoweth and senior Stephanie Kennett are not only workout partners and captains, but also the Maple Leaf girls representatives in Peoria. They, along with boys

captain Josh Lodge, will toe the line with big dreams.

"There is an opportunity for all of them to earn all-state honors," Geneseo coach Don Fredricks said. "It's a longshot, but they're going in knowing that it's a possibility and that's exciting."

Fredericks also licks his chops at the hopes of inclement weather that might frighten not so tough runners.

"The worse the weather, the better for our kids," Fredericks said. "They eat that stuff up. At this time of the year there aren't many athletes in the state where everything's perfect for them (with illness, injury and training), but we're pretty close."

Alleman's Kathleen Hogan slipped into the final qualifying spot at the East Peoria regional, and is hoping to duplicate last year's all-state performance.

Sherrard's Shelia Pettie is the only small-school representative in our area. The former runner-up has been looking like she's in championship form as of late, with a regional win and a third place finish with a solid time at the Elmwood-Brimfield sectional. The 1A field is dominated by very young talent, so Pettie's experience may help her back into the top 25. If she can recapture the spark that drove her to a 17:24 in her first trip downstate, anything's possible.

# Pettie caps great career

## with 12th-place finish

PEORIA — For Shelbie Pettie, her final three-mile race at Peoria's Detweiller Park was one of reflection.

It's been a long time, a lot of miles and a lot of hardship since Pettie first toed the line and came in second to Carthage's Katelyn Bastert during Bastert's four-year dominance.

Back then, Pettie was the new kid on the block and raced the course in a dizzying 17:24.

Fast forward three years and Pettie has had to overcome phenomenal odds, in-

cluding a torn ACL, to even make the State Meet as a senior.

She made sure she went out in style.

Pettie finished 12th in the 1A race, earning her third All-State medal in as many races.

"This was a very emotional race for me," a reflective Pettie said. "I'm thankful to God that I got the opportunity to run here again."

And while she isn't the same person she was three years ago, the fight hasn't gone anywhere.

► **Titans take 10th:** Behind freshman Ciara Marlow's All-State finish in 20th, the Monmouth-Roseville

girls made it three straight seasons with a top-10 finish. Marlow passed more than a half dozen harriers in the final half-mile to capture her first state medal.

"This was more than I thought it would be," Marlow said of her sensational freshman campaign.

Marcella Gillen and Mandy Champion packed up to go sub-20 minutes, while Chelsea Langford and Bethany Corbin rounded out the Titans' scoring, all running under 21 minutes.

► **Geneseo girls lead 2A locals:** Joann Chenoweth and Stephanie Kennett had a plan and, boy, did they stick

to it. The pair of Maple Leafs ran shoulder to shoulder through the first 2.5 miles, and finished only a second apart, and were just 10 seconds away from All-State.

"That's how it's been all season; we push one another," Chenoweth said. "When I'm having a hard part, I just stay with Steph, and when she's struggling, she knows to just keep up with me. To finish like that, I wouldn't want it any other way."

Alleman's Kathleen Hogan wasn't able to duplicate the run she had last year when she finished 15th, this time finishing 46th. A year ago, she covered the three miles

# Moline boys' state finish

## not what was hoped for

PEORIA — The Moline Maroons' first dip into the IHSA's 3A State Meet didn't exactly go as hoped, but it was a learning experience well worth the trip.

The Maroons, led by East Peoria Sectional champ Jonathan Smith, finished 23rd, a position not indicative of the way they've run this post-season.

"We may not have finished as high as we wanted, but we finished the season on a high note," Moline coach Tauwon Taylor said. "The beauty of this is that we have five guys coming back next year who were in our top 9. Now they know what it looks like."

And in the world of 3A cross country, that's half the battle. To earn all-

State honors, a time of 15:01 was needed, which would've been close to Smith's fastest time all season. It was one of the closest races in recent memories, with less than a minute separating first and 120th.

"I knew it was going to be fast, but I thought maybe with the conditions (snowing and windy) it'd be slower. It wasn't," Smith said. "It didn't really phase me at first, and when I came through the second mile under 10 minutes, I knew I was going fast."

Smith hit a wall on the third mile, and his breathing was harder than usual. He drifted from 20th position all the way back to 44th, but it left him wanting more.

"I caught a couple people at the end, but it didn't really play out how I had wanted," Smith said. "I had a great year, though, and I couldn't be

happier about it, and hopefully it's an example to the younger kids of what you have to do to be successful as a team."

Smith's teammates — Nic Mizeur, Alek Stojanovic and Michael Castel — all finished in under 16 minutes.

► **Lodge has solid day to finish career:** The lone Maple Leaf boy toeing the line, senior captain Josh Lodge, raced to a repeatable and solid finish of 60th in the 2A race, crossing the line in 16:01. As predicted by Geneseo coach Don Fredericks, there wasn't much difference between 25th and 60th, as only 25 seconds separated Lodge from earning all-State honors.

► **UT boys on either end of emotional spectrum:** A year ago, CJ Dundy couldn't have been more upset with how he had performed at

the State Meet. "I was going to enjoy it this year," a smiling Dundy, a senior, said after running faster (15:17) than he did the year before. "During the race, I just kept thinking to myself, 'I did it again and proved everyone wrong who didn't think I could.'"

And that positive attitude is something Dundy will more than likely be sharing with sophomore teammate Cody Webster who was unsatisfied with his first taste of state racing.

Webster, coming off a sub-15 performance a week ago, ran 15:28 and finished 81st.

"I was really nervous up at the line and when I finished I was just really upset at the time," Webster said. "Now I can't wait til next year. I want to be back here and be in the top 10."

### **Leafs Have Strong Showing in State Finals**

On Saturday, November 8th, the Leafs traveled to Peoria to participate in the IHSA State Cross Country Finals. With both teams barely missing qualifying last weekend the team was represented by the threesome of Joann Chenoweth, Stephanie Kennett and Josh Lodge. The last several years the state meet has been greeted with amazingly mild weather. Not in 2008. A high of 37 with strong winds and a strong wind chill factor made for a challenging day of running. These three came ready to roll.

The Girls AA race went off at 11:00 am. Joann and Stephanie got out well and settled into the top 50 running side-by-side. They rolled through the mile in sub 6 and inching forward through the field for the remaining two miles demonstrating savvy racing tactics. They powered down the homestretch and both ran themselves into the top 30, barely missing All-State Honors. Not too bad of a performance for their first state finals. Way to Lead by example. Their teammates were all over the course and vowed to be toeing the line themselves in the fall of 09. Our East Peoria Sectional was well represented as the qualifying teams placed 3-4-5-6-12. The Lady Leafs WERE at least at top 15 team if not a top 10 team. Hopefully, the IHSA will expand the A and AA fields to 25 next fall to be equal to that of the AAA division. GREAT EFFORTS LADIES.

Mr. Lodge powered off the starting line at high noon and roared into the top 25 by the half mile in the frigid weather. Josh rolled past the mile in 4:58 and the two mile mark in 10:18 (a new P.R.) as the early pace was beginning to take its toll. Josh held onto the top 35 past the 2 1/2 mile mark but then he ran out of gas in the last 600 meters of the race. He fought every step of the way, desperately trying to limit the damage as the flood gates of runners passing were wide open now. Josh came across the line in a very respectable 60th place and his head held high with pride. He has dreamed of this day for last four years. He was also proud to see his good friend Tim Hird win the individual race and the Dixon Dukes win an exciting 3 point team battle. The East Peoria Sectional dominated the state finals placing all 5 teams in the top 10 (1-3-4-9-10.) GREAT EFFORT JOSH.

# at state finals

Geneseo's Joann Chenoweth, Stephanie Kennett and Josh Lodge battled with the best in the state at the 2A IHSA Cross Country State Finals Nov. 8 at Detweiller Park in Peoria.

"They ran awesome," said head coach Don Fredericks. "To say they ran well would be the biggest understatement of the year. They ran phenomenal."

In the girls' race, Chenoweth crossed the finish line in 18 minutes and 38 seconds for 28th place, while teammate Kennett was one second behind in 30th with a time of 18:39. The girls placed in the top 30 out of 167 runners.

"The top 25 earn all-state honors, which is not an easy thing to do and Joann and Stephanie just missed it," said Fredericks. "They were never more than a step apart from each other. They both ran a really intelligent race. By far the best race they have run in their life."

Lodge was the lone representative in the boys' race for Geneseo and in the field of 175 he came in 60th with a time of 16:01.

"Sixty is not bad, a lot of kids were weeded out and it was his goal to run in the state finals," said Fredericks. "And maybe he went out too aggressively because it caught up with him at the end."




"All-in-all, these teams go down as one of my favorite teams. They had a lot of desire and cared about each other and worked together. They were fun to be around."



Dixon claims first boys state title

PEORIA - A mere five feet before the finish line, Dixon senior Kasey Ferrigan glanced over each shoulder.

With no one in sight, Ferrigan coasted into the chute at Detweiller Park for a second-place finish in the Class 2A state cross country meet in a time of 15 minutes, 2 seconds.

"I actually knew that there wasn't anybody around me," Ferrigan said. "I was looking for Matt (Logan) and Kyle (Boone). I told them before the race that when I finished I better be able to see them coming when I looked back."

"I didn't get that good of a look so I didn't see them then. But they were there."

They sure were. Boone came in six spots later at 15:20 and Logan in 11th at 15:22.

Everything, including the big brown and gold Class 2A state championship trophy, fell into place from there for the Dixon Dukes.

"We knew that we had to place our first three in before Belvidere North's first guy to try and have a shot," Ferrigan said. "We came very close to that and it still worked out."

Only Belvidere North's Anthony Gedwill was able to sneak in front of Logan at the end to keep that from happening.

Dixon still won by three points with a score of 94 to claim the school's first boys team championship in any sport.

"It's great to be able to beat a team that is as good as they are," Logan said. "All season long, though, we had no doubt that we could do this. We had a few injuries and things but we got through it."

While the big three of Ferrigan, Boone and Logan did their job of putting Dixon in position to win, it was newcomers Zach Payne and Eric Dewey that slammed the door.

"We got Zach to come out this summer and had him running every day and I think he was really wondering what he was doing all that work for," Dixon coach Evan Thorpe said. "He wasn't used to this. But I think he understands now and if he keeps it up, he'll be a big-time runner."

Payne, a freshman, went under the 16-minute mark for the first time with his time of 15:56.

Dewey was spectating last year by the time the Class 2A meet started. He was running for Polo then in the Class 1A meet. A transfer in schools last winter and a year training with the Dukes put him in a spot he didn't expect.

"I never thought I'd be a part of team championship," Dewey said. "This year was completely different. The competition was harder, but it's just awesome to be here."

In the Class 1A race, the Newman Comets made the most of their first appearance at state with a seventh-place finish with 208 points. Dylan Reyes led Newman by placing eighth in 15:31.

"I knew there were going to be a lot of good guys here, I just had to run my race," Reyes said. "I think I was able to do that and I am really proud of what I was able to do and what the team did today."

Bureau Valley edged Newman with a sixth-place finish at 201 points. Oregon's Ryan Creegan placed 39th in 16:06.




