

LADY LEAFS UPSET DUKES TO WIN NCIC WHILE BOYS 2ND

On Saturday, October 17th the Leafs traveled to Sterling for the NCIC. This officially opened Championship Meet Season. The Leafs toed the line seeded 2nd to Dixon in both the girls and boys races. An added note of interest is this was the final NCIC that Geneseo will participate in since we are leaving (with the entire Reagan side) to form the new Northern Illinois Big 12 starting next fall. Geneseo has been a member of the NCIC for over 60 years. Those teams will include DeKalb, Dixon, Geneseo, Kaneland, LaSalle-Peru, Morris, Ottawa, Rochelle, Sterling, Streator, Sycamore, Yorkville.

The Fresh-Soph girls got things rolling at 10:00 am. Britta Conrad was our only entry in that race and she put forth a tremendous effort. Britta wasn't feeling 100 percent but ran a strong race to grab 3rd overall. Her kick from 300 meters out.....running side by side with a young lady from Hall was amazing. 
