Togetherness carries Geneseo cross country

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From head to toe — bandannas to running shoes — the many girls who make up the Geneseo girls' cross country team are one and the same.

Whether it's showing up for a team photo dressed alike on their own accord, or running together as a team, the Maple Leafs have each other in mind no matter how separated they might be in the three-mile pack.

"Like the Marines," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said, "they never leave a Marine in the field. Somebody goes down, and they

pick that person up. That's what this group does."

Last Saturday epitomized that statement as the Maple Leafs qualified for this weekend's Class 2A state meet for the first time in 11 years.

With their top runner, Emily Ford, feeling ill in the Class 2A East Peoria Sectional, the Maple Leafs banded together to pick up their teammate.

"She was having a bad race," Geneseo senior Joann Chenoweth said. "Once each one of us came up on her, we each picked it up for Emily. To get us to state, we had to pick it up."

That attitude — the

conviction that "team" is the No. 1 priority — is a major reason why Geneseo is back at state. There are no egos within the 11-member team.

"We have absolutely no drama. None," Chenoweth said. "That really helps us because then you can really work together as a team."

One by one, the Maple Leafs passed Ford on the muddy track. They saw their top runner struggling as the race reached the mile mark. As it continued, Ford kept getting further and further behind. The five other runners — Chenoweth, Danielle Dewey, Paige Gatter, Amy Cosgrove and Betsy

Winberry — all picked up their teammate with a late push to the finish.

"They all put their foot on the gas pedal and thought, 'I got to pick up the slack here,'" Fredericks said. "I've been coaching a long time, and I've never seen what happened (last) Saturday. I'm still just blown away by it. It was awesome. It was special."

The moment may have been special, but it was nothing new. The team genuinely cares about each other and won't let anything break the chemistry.

Geneseo girls take 4th at state cross country

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PEORIA — Danielle Dewey finished 24th in the Class 2A Cross Country State Finals Saturday, but the senior's All-State honors seemed to come in second to sharing one final moment huddling with her Geneseo teammates.

The Maple Leafs finished fourth at Detweiller Park, and became the first Geneseo team to finish in the Top 10 at State in 21 years. The Leafs were led by Dewey in a time of 18:38.

"It was rewarding," Dewey said of her last prep cross-country race. "This is the best team I've ever been a part of. It's really hard to say goodbye, but we have track, and we'll be coming back next year to cheer others on."

Geneseo's Joann Chenoweth finished just outside of the Top 25 who earn all-state honors at 33rd place in 19:07. Yet after the race, Chenoweth was ecstatic with how the day unfolded.

"I'm so proud of my teammates," Chenoweth said. "It was so much fun to be here all together. Our goal ever since we were freshmen has been to qualify for state as a team, and we did it. I couldn't have asked for a better team."

Dewey and Chenoweth shared a bittersweet moment after the race when the team came together one last time to huddle.

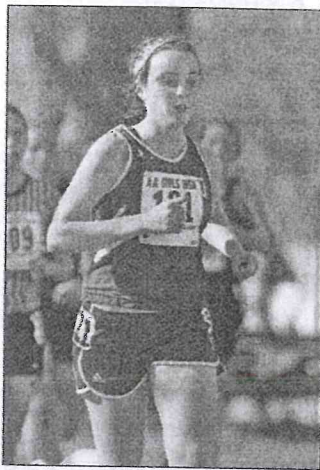
"It hit me that it was my last run on this team," Chenoweth said about the team's tear-filled final farewell. "It was a bitter-sweet moment."

The rest of the Geneseo team stepped up to give their best for the Leafs.

Freshman Emily Ford had a personal-best time of 19:26 to take 53rd. The rest of the Geneseo team that helped bring home the fourth-place team finish were Paige Gatter (58, 19:28) and Jenny Ford (90, 20:03).

In the 3A girls race, Moline freshman Haley Verbeke challenged the veteran field, finishing 35th at 18:12. Her secret to success Saturday was senior teammate Emily Wolbers who finished 82nd at 18:44.

"She's just a true inspiration to me," Verbeke said of Wolbers' guiding hand. "Throughout the year, she's just made me get better and better."

In 1A, Monmouth-Roseville fell a little short of its expectations of a top 15 finish with a 17th-place standing. The team was led by junior Ciara Marlow's 97th-place finish in 20:34.

"We're proud just to be here and compete with all these athletes," senior Marcela Gilen said after finishing 106th at 20:48. "Personally, I thought we could have done a little bit better."

Webster at the wire

After Cody Webster finished the 3A Cross Country boys State Finals here Saturday, he raced over to the awards podium at Detweiller Park almost as fast as he sprinted through the 3-mile race.

Webster crossed a crowded finish line and none of the Panther faithful could tell if the junior came in 25th place to earn

the final All-State honor spot or if Webster would be on the outside looking in at 26th place.

A single second would be the difference.

Webster stole the final All-State 3A honor in a photo-finish, crossing the finish line at 15:01 in a race in which the

Moline Maroons team claimed the 22nd team score.

This All-State honor is something Webster has had his eye on since the beginning of the season. Coming into the state meet, Webster hoped to break into the top 20. But a wave of relief rolled over his face when told he had claimed the final All-State spot.

"Yeah, it was definitely my goal at the beginning of the season to get top 25," Webster said. "My other goal was to run a 14:40, but obviously you couldn't do that today with the hot weather. But still I am happy with my time."

The hot weather — temperatures approaching 70 degrees — surprised everyone, and the sun beat down hard on UT's black spandex uniforms. A red-faced Keith Sands finished 118th at 15:54. The Panther sophomore had to fight to the finish, and led him to consider a different strategy for next year.

"Get out front fast," Sands said. "There's pushing and shoving, and people don't even care. They'll do whatever it takes. That's what I got to do."

Moline was led by Alek Stojanovic, a junior, and senior Michael Castel, finishing 31 and 32, respectively, within a second of each other at 15:07 and 15:08. Moline's team placing was a spot better than last year. Rounding out the Moline team was Aaron Peck (160, 16:12), Luke Padesky (179, 16:28), Seth Williams (181, 16:29), Alex Timm (201, 16:55) and Ian Miller (213, 17:59).

"It's nice to see the Quad-Cities do well," Moline coach Tauwon Taylor said. "I'm proud of the way my kids ran."

The Maroons are looking to raise the bar and break into the Top 20 here next year.

"We all want to come back," said Williams, a junior. "We're losing a couple of good runners (Castel, Timm and Miller). I think some people are going to step up and we're all going to train really hard to get back here."

"In my last four years of running, every year I thought the team was tight," Chenoweth said. "But this year, the team is 10-times tighter than any year before."

That's what makes it OK for Ford, a wide-eyed freshman, to claim the top spot on the team ahead of four seniors.

"I want her to do well," said Dewey, who finished second in last month's NCIC meet and sixth at sectional. "I want the team to do well, and I want each individual to do their best. ... I want what's best for everyone."

The all-for-one, one-for-all mentality has provided positive results. In the last three weeks, the Maple Leafs have come together during the most critical part of their season. They won the NCIC championship by nine points over Dixon and had all five runners finish in the top 10.

"It shocked us seeing that we could really do this, and it shocked others," Dewey said. "It showed that we can really make a difference and that we do have strong runners."

Geneseo didn't stop there, winning the Class 2A Galesburg Regional a week later by a 15-point margin over Dixon. The Maple Leafs were consistent again, having

each runner finish among the top 14.

The sectional wasn't as easy, but they found a way to qualify for state. Despite their top runner being ill and another one competing without cleats, the Maple Leafs were the only team to have three girls in the top 15 on their way to a third-place finish.

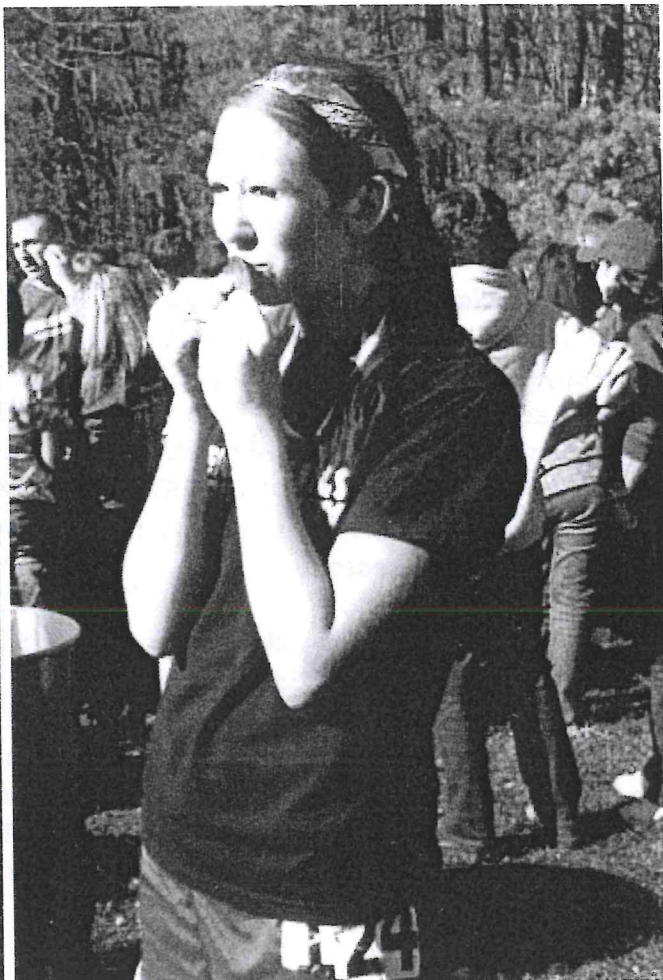

LADY LEAFS MAKE HISTORY WITH 4TH PLACE FINISH

On Saturday, November 7th the Lady Leafs traveled to Peoria's Detweiller Park to participate in the IHSA State Cross Country Finals. The last time the Lady Leafs qualified for the State Finals was 1998. Emily Ford was 3 YEARS OLD. Geneseo has had several near misses over the past 11 years including last year's heartbreaking 6th place sectional finish. This year's team refused to miss out on the fun.

The Lady Leafs toed the starting line at 10:30 am ranked 18th in the state. Demonstrating how little respect the team was given Dixon was ranked at 17th. Dixon didn't qualify for this year's state finals. The Lady Leafs were picked to beat just two teams in the meet. Needless to say, the Lady Leafs toed the line with a lot of motivation to show the State pollsters just how wrong they were about the Lady Leafs of Geneseo.

At the gun the team reacted nicely and rolled through the first 600 meters which is slightly downhill. Senior Danielle Dewey led the charge and settled into the top 25 early with dreams of All-State running through her head. Joann Chenoweth, Emily Ford, and Paige Gatter had similar goals and weren't far behind Dani. Behind them Jenny Ford was running the race of her life slightly ahead of Seniors Betsy Winberry and Amy Cosgrove who eventually just had a bad day. Roaring up the final

homestretch, the Lady Leafs unleashed the beast and showed tremendous passion and purpose. Danielle Dewey held off a huge pack of All-State hopefuls to hang on to her top 25 position and earn All-State Honors with an amazing 24th place finish. Dani has battled severe cramping in her glut's, lower back, and hamstrings all season long and has had the most inspirational season this coaching staff has ever seen. Not far behind was Joann Chenoweth who was flying. Jo's last 3/4 mile was head-turning as she placed a strong 33rd just missing All-State honors for the 2nd year in a row. Things got even better as Emily Ford and Paige Gatter blazed across the line in 53rd and 58th places respectfully. Things were looking good for the Lady Leafs at this point. Jenny Ford and Betsy Winberry sealed the deal with strong 90th and 107 place finishes. Only Amy Cosgrove had an off day but she gave it everything she had. Additional points of interest include that 4 of the top 5 teams in the state finals came from the East Peoria Sectional. Last year's East Peoria Sectional resulted in 5 of the top 8 teams. Also, Yorkville's 2nd place girls team returns all 7 runners and will join Geneseo in the newly formed Northern Illinois Big 12 Conference. Additional state powers include Dixon (Boys state champs in '09 while their Girls were 4th), Sycamore (Boys State Champs in '07 and top 10 last 3 years) and Kaneland (Boys top 5 in '09.) The conference will be a state powerhouse. The conference will include the following teams: DeKalb, Dixon, Geneseo, Kaneland, LaSalle-Peru, Morris, Ottawa, Rochelle, Sterling, Streator, Sycamore, Yorkville.

Lady Leafs nab fourth in state

The Geneseo girls' cross country team capped off its successful season with a historic fourth-place finish at the

IHSA State Cross Country Finals Nov. 7 at Detweiller Park in Peoria.

"It is too bad the season has to end because it has just been incredible," said head coach Don Fredericks. "Each week

you think that is as high as they can go, but then they find new peaks. We were ranked 18th in the last poll and got fourth. The girls knocked off a plethora of state powerhouses."

This is the highest place finish for a GHS girls' cross country team since the 1984 fifth-place finish.

"This is the highest finish for any sport in Geneseo besides football," said Fredericks. "This is big stuff. What these girls have accomplished is tremendous."

On an unseasonably warm day for November, the Lady Leafs hit the course with the best in the state to compete for the ultimate prize. And the Lady Leafs who have seemed to surprise everyone around the state continued to turn heads on Saturday.

"To be honest everything didn't go perfect. If someone is not 100 percent the others pick up the slack because that is just how this team is," said Fredericks.

Leading the way for the Lady Leafs was senior Danielle Dewey, who earned All-State honors with her 24th-place finish with a time of 18 minutes and 38 seconds.

"Danielle was 18th with a mile to go with a big pack of girls behind her and I didn't know if she could hang on to get All-State, but by golly she did," said Fredericks.

Senior Joann Chenoweth

was not far behind taking 33rd in 19:07, while freshman Emily Ford came in 53rd in 19:26.

Sophomore Paige Gatter earned a 58th-place finish with a time of 19:28, followed by sophomore Jenny Ford in 90th at 20:03.

"If I had to pick one kid that ran out of her mind, went nuts and had a monster race that was Jenny Ford," said Fredericks. "She took 1:00 off her fastest time this year. That is jaw dropping. I have never seen that in a state meet."

Rounding out the effort were seniors Betsy Winberry in 107th at 20:34 and Amy Cosgrove, 155th in 21:54.

"We were hoping to be in the top 10, but to find out we got fourth, the girls went nuts," said Fredericks. "It was awesome."

Winning the 2A state title was Springfield High School, followed by Yorkville in second, East Peoria, third and Geneseo in fourth.

"This was really special and I told the girls this is something they will never forget," said Fredericks. "I am so proud of them and this is awesome."

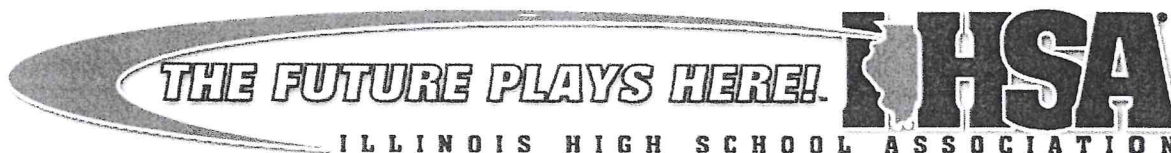
