




Ford, Gatter move

on to state finals

Geneseo High School's Emily Ford and Paige Gatter were the lone Geneseo runners to advance to the IHSA State Finals.

The girls placed 12th and 15th, respectively, at the Oct. 30 East Peoria Sectional. Ford crossed the finish line in 18 minutes and 29 seconds, followed by Gatter in 18:34.

"Emily maybe went out a little too aggressive, but you have to love her drive," said head coach Don Fredericks. "She went out with the lead pack with some of the top runners in the state. The field was loaded. She fought really hard, but dropped from the lead pack. She ran a really strong race.

"Paige has been running great the last couple of weeks and she has taken it to a new level. She was in a position where she was not going to quite get to state, but exploded at the end. I don't know how she did it. I am really happy for both of them."

Others racing for the Lady Leafs, who took 10th

place overall, were Morgan Kelly, 67th, 20:05; Dani Manna, 73rd, 20:17; Jenny Ford, 100th, 21:09; Jessa Coulter, 102nd, 21:14; and Sarah Dellett, 104th, 21:23.

"Obviously, the goal is to qualify so it still stings a bit, but the girls had a great season," said Fredericks. "Everyone of those seven girls will be back next season."

The boys' team was unable to advance anyone on to state as the team took 12th overall.

Kyle Reiling led the team in 25th place with a time of 16:02, followed by Jordan Starkey, 46th, 16:24; and Thomas Sigwalt, 58th, 16:38.

"Jordan was not 100 percent, but gave it a good run and Kyle has come on and been our top runner the last two weeks," said Fredericks. "The Big 3 (Starkey, Reiling and Sigwalt) never clicked on the same day this year, it is frustrating for everyone involved when things don't pan out. It was a great group of kids that put in a lot of work. The stars didn't line up this year."

Branden Smith finished in 75th, 17:08; Marcus Gagnon, 80th, 17:11; Daniel Hanford, 99th, 17:35; and Mitchell Lamb, 101st, 17:39.

"All-in-all I was proud of them," said Fredericks. "I love this part of the season, but I also hate it. It is unfor-


tunate we are in a brutal sectional."

Ford and Gatter will race in the IHSA State Finals in Class 2A at 11 a.m. Nov. 6 at Detweiller Park in Peoria.

"The course should be really fast and that is exciting," said Fredericks. "We can only control what we

do so we are going to have the girls rested and ready to chase some all-state hardware.

"When we draw up a season plan the goal is to be the best at the end of the season and the goal is for them to run their best on Saturday."



FORD AND GATTER QUALIFY AS TEAMS COME UP SHORT

On Saturday, October 30th, the Leafs traveled to East Peoria to participate in the IHSA Sectional finals. The top 20 teams from our sectional qualified for this event and the competition was brutal as expected. Both girls and boys team faced the same daunting task...beat at least one of the five competing teams that are currently ranked in the top 9 in the entire state.

However, just past the 1 1/2 mile mark reality caught up with the fast starting Leafs (and head-cold-battling Starkey and Sigwalt.) In the end, Kyle Reiling just missed qualifying by a mere 8 seconds and recorded a very respectable 28th place finish. Jordan Starkey and Thomas Sigwalt gave it their all and placed 49th and 61st place overall. Gutsy effort for running sick. Branden Smith reclaimed the Number Four man position (81st place) with Marcus Gagnon running to a strong 87th place finish. Daniel Hanford and Mitchell Lamb closed the team efforts with strong 108th and 110th place finishes. In the end, the team placed 12th overall. UT's Webster wins Class 3A sectional title; Alleman boys reach state finals

United Township senior runner Cody Webster is one step away from a state title.

Webster outlasted Edwardsville junior Garrett Sweat to win the Class 3A Normal West Sectional at Maxwell Park on Saturday. Webster ran a 14:45 and used a late charge in the last 200 feet to beat Sweat by a second.

He enters next Saturday's state meet at Detwiler Park in Peoria with the top time in Class 3A.

"Cody has one of the best kicks in the state," UT coach Russ Boore said. "Sweat is one of the best runners in the state and Cody just blew by him like he was standing still."

Webster, the Western Big 6 Conference and regional champion, was one of four runners in the class to break 15 minutes, and three ran at Normal West. Sweat ran a 14:46 and O'Fallon senior Michael Scolorici ran a 14:48.

"It's the strongest and fastest sectional we've ever been to in my nine years at UT," Boore said.

The Panthers finished fourth in the sectional with 145 points and qualified for state. Senior Keith Sands (15:25) finished 10th. UT received top 40 finishes from Tyler Rasso (34th, 16:03) and Austin Webster (39th, 16:04).

This is the 10th time the Panthers have qualified for state, and the first since 2004.

Moline (176 points) took sixth and missed qualifying for state by 14 points.

"I knew that we were on the bubble," Moline coach Tauwon Taylor said. "We came limping into this season with all the aches and pains. We fought through that, but we just came up short."

Senior Alek Stojanovic was the lone Moline state qualifier. He finished 15th after running a 15:34.

▶ Alleman boys' advance in 1A: The Pioneers took third in the Class 1A Elmwood Regional to advance to state for the first time since winning the 2004 Class A state title.

"They're all very excited," Alleman coach Doug Burke said. "It's another opportunity to race and an acknowledgment to all the hard work they've put into this season."

Senior Matt Billingsley (16:02) and sophomore Ethan Adlfinger (16:04) were fourth and fifth, respectively. Sophomore Liam Otto was 10th after running a 16:23.

The Pioneers were the only team with three top 10 finish-

Junior Joe McLaughlin (32nd, 17:09) and senior Austin Teel (62nd, 17:57) also placed for Alleman.

"We're hopeful, if not expecting, to have a top 10 finish," Burke said. "We're confident."

Monmouth-Roseville's Gatlin Marlow (10th) and Mercer County's Sam Whan (14th) were the only local Class 1A qualifiers.

▶ Geneseo, Rock Island boys shut out in 2A: A tough field at the Class 2A East Peoria Sectional produced no local advancers. Neither Geneseo nor Rock Island had any individuals qualify for the state meet.

Geneseo's Kyle Reiling (25th, 16:02) and Rock Island's Eric Ikundrio (47th, 16:24) were the top finishers for their respective teams.

▶ Verbeke third at Normal West: Moline sophomore Haley Verbeke qualified for the state meet for the second consecutive season after taking third in the Class 3A Normal West Sectional. Verbeke ran a 17:52. Normal West's Emily Brelsford won the title with a 17:19.

As a team, the Maroons had 151 points and were three away from a state trip.

"Every one of those girls will be back next year," Taylor said. "I think that (finish) will leave a little sour taste in

our mouths and that means that we will work a little bit harder for this upcoming season."

▶ Ford, Gatter advance in 2A: Geneseo's Emily Ford and Paige Gatter both qualified for state. Ford (18:29) was 12th and Gatter (18:34) took 15th at the Class 2A East Peoria Sectional. As a team, the Maple Leafs were 10th.

"They ran great," Geneseo coach Don Fredericks said. "Obviously, we were hoping to get the team through. We were, in my opinion, the toughest sectional in the state. It was a rugged sectional."

Rocky finished eighth and were led by Celeste Arteaga's 30th-place finish.

"We came away from the race running our best," Rocky coach Tony VanDeWalle said. "We had seven or eight PRs. The girls are already excited about next year."

▶ Biddle takes ninth at Elmwood: Mercer County junior Miranda Biddle was the only local Class 1A qualifier after taking ninth at the Elmwood Sectional.

Biddle qualified for state for the first time with a 19:17. Top-ranked El-Paso Gridley sophomore Julie James won the title with an 18:07.

As a team, Alleman took sixth missed qualifying by 13 points. The Pioneers' top finishers were Andria Mendoza (29th, 20:25) and Anna Wetherell (30th, 20:29).

"The other five teams ran a little faster," Burke said. "We had a great pack, but we didn't move that pack far enough to get the fifth spot. It's an improvement over last year, but we came up short."
